

# Former Prime Minister of India, Dr. Manmohan Singh passes away

New Delhi, Dec. 26

Former Prime Minister of India and veteran Congress leader, Dr. Manmohan Singh passed away at the age of 92. He breathed his last on Thursday night while undergoing treatment at AIIMS, New Delhi. President, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, and several others cutting across party lines have condoled his death.

President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu in her condolence message on X, said, "Dr. Manmohan Ji was one of those rare politicians who also straddled the worlds of academia and administration with equal ease. In his various roles in public offices, he made critical contributions to reforming Indian economy. He will always be remembered for his service to the nation, his unblemished political life and his utmost humility. His passing is a great loss to all of us. I pay my respectful homage to one of the greatest sons of Bharat and convey my heartfelt condolences to his family, friends and admirers".

In his condolence message on X, Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar said, "Deeply pained to learn about the passing of Dr. Manmohan Singh Ji, former Prime Minister and a



distinguished economist who transformed India's economic landscape. A Padma Vibhushan awardee and architect of India's economic liberalisation in 1991, he boldly steered our nation through a critical transition, opening new pathways for growth and prosperity. As the Vice-President of India, I had the privilege to engage in meaningful, insightful interactions with Dr. Singh

at his residence. His profound understanding of economy, gentle demeanor and unwavering commitment to India's progress will forever be etched in my memory. In Dr. Singh's passing, India has lost a leader of towering intellect and a statesman par excellence. His legacy will forever guide Bharat's growth trajectory. My heartfelt condolences to his family and countless admirers in this difficult hour".

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in his condolence message on X, said, "India mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished leader, Dr. Manmohan Singh Ji. Rising from humble origins, he rose to become a respected economist. He served in various government positions as well, including as Finance Minister, leaving a strong imprint on our economic policy over the years. His interventions in Parliament were also insightful. As our Prime Minister, he made extensive efforts to improve people's lives".

India's fourteenth Prime Minister, Dr. Manmohan Singh is rightly acclaimed as a thinker and a scholar. He is well regarded for his diligence and his academic approach to work, as well as his accessibility and his unassuming demeanour. Dr. Manmohan Singh was born on September 26, 1932, in a village in the Punjab province of undivided India.

In 1971, Dr. Singh joined the Government of India as Economic Advisor in the Commerce Ministry. This was soon followed by his appointment as Chief Economic Advisor in the Ministry of Finance in 1972. Among the many Governmental positions that Dr. Singh has occupied are Secretary in the Ministry of Finance; Deputy Chairman of the Planning Commission; Governor of the Reserve Bank of India; Advisor of the Prime Minister; and Chairman of the University Grants Commission.

In what was to become the turning point in the economic history of independent India, Dr. Singh spent five years between 1991 and 1996 as India's Finance Minister. His role in ushering in a comprehensive policy of economic reforms is now recognized worldwide. In the popular view of those years in India, that period is inextricably associated with the persona of Dr. Singh.

In his political career, Dr. Singh has been a Member of India's Upper House of Parliament (the Rajya Sabha) since 1991, where he was Leader of the Opposition between 1998 and 2004. Dr. Manmohan Singh was sworn in as Prime Minister on 22<sup>nd</sup> May after the 2004 general elections and took the oath of office for a second term on 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2009. Dr. Singh is survived by his wife Smt. Gursharan Kaur and three daughters.

### Illegal transportation of boulders detected

Continuing its efforts to curb down illegal quarrying, the District Administration of South Andaman conducted a surprise check in the quarry area of Brookshabad village to ensure compliance with transportation regulations for quarry materials.

During the inspection,



revenue authorities checked the valid transit passes of trucks transporting boulders and two trucks, bearing

Registration Numbers AN01P9982 and AN01Q7670, were found to be transporting boulders without valid

transit passes.

In accordance with the law, both vehicles were immediately seized. Additionally, proceedings to levy penalties under the applicable provisions have been initiated against the offenders.

## ANPCC urges general public & industrial stakeholders to responsibly manage and dispose of waste generated in domestic and industrial setups

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 26

The Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC), Department of Science and Technology, Andaman and Nicobar Administration has urged the general public and industrial stakeholders to responsibly manage and dispose of waste generated in domestic and industrial setups in accordance with the Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. Effective waste management is critical to maintaining the pristine environment of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and ensuring the health and well-being of the community.

For domestic setups, residents have been requested to segregate waste at the source and hand over to the Municipal authorities for proper processing and disposal. Industries operating in the region have been mandated to follow best practices for waste management by implementing waste segregation, recycling and safe disposal protocols. All industrial units must ensure compliance with environmental regulations, including obtaining necessary consents from ANPCC for waste generation and treatment. Hazardous industrial waste should be disposed of through authorized agencies and untreated waste water must not be discharged into the environment. Industries have also been encouraged to adopt cleaner technologies and reduce waste generation at the source.

The public have been urged to avoid open dumping and burning of waste, as these practices can lead to air, water and soil pollution.

In light of the growing concern regarding cigarette and bidi butt litter, ANPCC also highlights the importance of their proper disposal. Cigarette and bidi butts, though small in size, pose a significant environmental threat due to their non-biodegradable components and toxic chemicals. Local authorities have been requested to include the provisions in Municipal Bye-laws to prohibit smoking in public areas and workplaces and to impose fines for littering cigarette butts. Commercial establishments, particularly those with designated smoking zones, must provide

adequate arrangements for the collection and disposal of cigarette and bidi butts in a manner that minimizes environmental impact.

The ANPCC emphasizes that collective effort is vital to achieving a clean and sustainable environment. The cooperation of every individual and organization in adhering to waste management guidelines is crucial for preserving the unique biodiversity of A&N Islands. By reducing, reusing, and recycling waste, we can minimize our ecological footprint and contribute to a greener and healthier future. Together, let us pledge to protect our environment and ensure a sustainable legacy for generations to come, a press release from ANPCC said.

# India is a global leader in 'disaster warning' systems, catering to other nations as well across the world

## Union Minister of State (I/C) S&T highlights India's Progress in Ocean Research and Disaster Preparedness at INCOIS

New Delhi, Dec. 26 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology; Earth Sciences and Minister of State for PMO, Department of Atomic Energy, Department of Space, Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr. Jitendra Singh, while commemorating the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 2004 Indian Ocean Tsunami at INCOIS (Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services), said that India today has emerged as a global leader in "disaster warning" and his catering to other nations as well across the world.

The Minister recalled that the INCOIS was conceptualized following the tragic Tsunami of 2004 and after 2014, with an unflinching support and priority received from Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, it made rapid strides to be recognized as the world's most state-of-the-art institute of its kind.

Dr Jitendra Singh lauded PM Modi's path breaking ocean initiatives including the 'Deep Sea Mission' which he had announced in his Independence Day address.

He also highlighted India's quantum progress in ocean research and disaster preparedness.

The Minister emphasized the nation's emergence as a global leader in providing world-class disaster warning systems, underscoring the pivotal role of scientific advancements in fostering safety and sustainability.

Reflecting on the catastrophic tsunami that claimed over 230,000 lives worldwide, including 10,749 in India, Dr.Jitendra Singh remarked on the invaluable lessons learned and the transformative policies that followed. "The tragedy served as a catalyst for establishing institutions like

INCOIS, which now stands as a testament to India's commitment to safeguarding lives and livelihoods," he said.

India's Tsunami Early Warning System, lauded internationally, was showcased as a cornerstone of the nation's disaster preparedness.

The Minister also noted ongoing collaborations with UNESCO and the Tsunami Ready Initiative, which aims to bolster community resilience across vulnerable regions. He cited the recognition of 24 Indian communities under this program as evidence of a community-centric approach.

Dr. Jitendra Singh underlined the growing significance of oceanic exploration in India's journey toward becoming "Viksit Bharat". With a 7,500-kilometer coastline and abundant marine resources, he advocated for their sustainable exploration and conservation. "Our deep-sea mission and initiatives like BioE3 [Biotechnology for Environment, Employment, and Economy] are creating an ecosystem that will not only enhance biodiversity but also contribute to national prosperity," he said.

Looking ahead, the Minister expressed optimism about concurrent breakthroughs in space and marine missions, envisioning an India that leads globally in both realms. "We are planning to deploy an Indian in the deep sea and another in space, possibly by 2026, marking a historic milestone," he announced.

Dr. Jitendra Singh's remarks also celebrated the synergy between policy and science, attributing the rapid advancements in sectors like space and oceanography to the Government's proactive support.

Dr. Jitendra Singh also

highlighted India's proactive role in international collaboration through INCOIS, which hosts a UNESCO Category 2 Training Centre. This center acts as a hub for capacity building and knowledge sharing on ocean-based disaster management. He noted INCOIS's active involvement in the Ocean Decade Tsunami Programme, which aims to achieve 100% tsunami-ready communities globally by 2030. "Through initiatives like these, we are not only strengthening global partnerships but also paving the way for resilient coastal communities worldwide," he remarked.

Additionally, the Minister underscored the need to integrate tsunami warnings with other ocean-related hazards, such as storm surges and high waves, into a comprehensive multi-hazard early warning system. He emphasized that such advancements would sustain India's tsunami warning capabilities while addressing the growing complexity of oceanic risks. "This forward-looking approach will ensure that we continue to safeguard lives and livelihoods against a wide spectrum of potential disasters," he added.

In concluding, the Minister reiterated INCOIS's integral role in India's Vision 2047. "By exploring untapped resources and ensuring disaster readiness, INCOIS is a vital contributor to building a self-reliant and resilient India," he affirmed.

The event, attended by Dr. M. Ravi Chandran, Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences, and eminent scientists and policymakers, served as a platform to celebrate two decades of achievements while charting a path forward for holistic and sustainable development.


