## MP holds Press Conference

### Joint inspection of NH-4 from Baratang to Diglipur will be taken up from Dec. 2: MP

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 30

A joint inspection of the National Highway from Baratang to Diglipur will be taken up soon by a Joint Team of NHIDCL and team of Member of Parliament, A&N Islands to speed up the NH-4 construction and to complete other allied work required at NH-4 so as to provide relief to the commuters. This decision was taken in a review meeting held by NHIDCL, informed the Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray while interacting with mediapersons at 'Praja Niwas' here today.

Addressing a press conference, the MP informed that he recently



met the Hon'ble Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Shri Nitin Gadkari, and apprised him of the current condition of the NH-4 which requires immediate attention. The MP said that the team of NHIDCL & the team of Member of Parliament will start their visit on Dec. 2 onwards and submit a detailed report after inspecting the entire stretch to speed up the construction work. The MP further stated that he also met the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and informed him about the current situation of NH-4.

The MP further informed that upon his request, six key State Highways in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands were accorded in principle approval for declaring the same as National Highways (NH) in 2017. He said, during his meeting with Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Shri Nitin Gadkari, the MP requested him to renew the proposal of upgradation of the said 6 roads. The MP further urged the Minister to direct the A&N Administration to expedite the preparation and submission of the DPRs to the Ministry for early

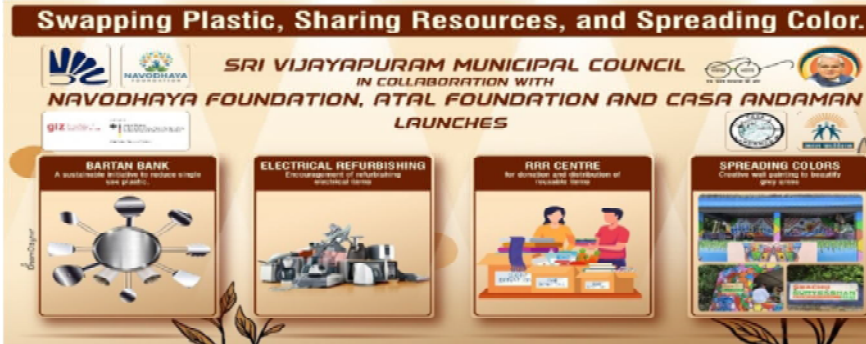
Passengers those who are holding the tickets of MV Campbell Bay for the above sailings are advised to cancel their tickets and get full refund.

with Benchmark Disability as an individual with not less than 40% of a specified disability.

> The Act increased the reservation for Persons with Disabilities in government jobs from 3% to 4%, and in higher education institutions from 3% to 5%.

> PwDs are entitled to equal opportunities, accessibility, and inclusive education up to the age of 18 years in special or regular schools.

The dignitaries emphasized the importance of ensuring dignity, respect, and equal opportunities for children and persons with disabilities, fostering an inclusive and equitable society. Smti. Amudha, teacher of the school, also addressed the participants and elaborated on various legal aspects related to child rights and the rights of persons with disabilities. Her insightful points further enriched the discussions during the awareness camp.

sanction and execution. He expressed the hope that some breakthrough in this project is expected soon. The roads which were considered for NH up-gradation are (1) Jetty Hut Bay RK Pur to VK Pur (SH - 1) in Little Andaman - 22 kms (2) Swaraj Dweep jetty to Ramnagar beach (SH -4) - 11 kms (3) Govindnagar junction to Kalapathar (Swaraj Dweep)- 09 km (4) Shaheed Dweep Jetty to Sitapur (Shaheed Dweep) - 04 kms (5) Kalara junction to Ramnagar (SH-14), Diglipur - 20 kms (6) Diglipur Bazaar (NH4) to Hatilevel (SH-15) - 24.70 kms.

Referring to meeting today with the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, the Member of Parliament said that he has put forth a series of issues concerning the Islanders for its speedy redressal. The issues brought to the notice of the Chief Secretary includes constructing Urmilapur Bridge & Nishchintapur Bridge, to bring ANIIMS under the purview of AIIMS, New Delhi, appointment of specialist Doctors at District Hospital Nicobar & Mayabunder, CHC Kamorta, CHC Rangat & Diglipur from RML, Hospital & Safdarjung Hospital on a rotational basis for 3-3 months, providing DAP Urea to farmers, adequate power & funds for PRIS for taking up development projects for the benefit of the rural populace, conducting DPC and State Plan Board Meetings at the earliest for preparation of a good & meaningful budget for the islands, preparing a practical Circle Rate, pursuing the 50MW LNG Power Plant with the Power Ministry at the earliest, issues related to water, power, petrol and LPG in Nicobar District, Petrol & LPG shortage in Little Andaman, Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep, Katchal, Kamorta and Campbell Bay and replacement of Log Cutting machine at Chatham Saw Mill.

The MP further informed that two works under the PMGSY-II scheme has been awarded in North & Middle Andaman and under PMGSY -III 200 km road will also be awarded soon. He urged the PRI members to send their demands for PMGSY-IV for the benefit of the people of their respective villages.

(SVPVC), who delivered a keynote address emphasizing the critical role of waste collectors in achieving sustainable waste management and improving urban sanitation. Senior officials from PBMC, Shri Avinash Kumar Singh, Superintending Engineer, Sanitary Officer, Sr. Sanitary Officer & Junior Engineer (SBM-MIS) also addressed the gathering, reinforcing the Council's commitment in supporting and integrating informal waste collectors into the formal waste management system.

Shri Pradeep Dadlani, Director of Sycom Projects Consultants, presented the findings of assessment survey conducted among waste collectors in the city. He highlighted the benefits of good waste management practices and discussed opportunities for improving their livelihood, health, and access to educational facilities for their families. The training covered regulatory frameworks, Government schemes, and procedures to access benefits, with a focus on financial literacy. It also highlighted occupational health, safety protocols, and waste segregation practices, along with guidance on forming Self-Help Groups (SHGs) and utilizing local resources like Anganwadis and Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs).

The event witnessed active participation from over 66 Safaimitras, who engaged in group discussions to address challenges related to gender, financial issues, and market linkages. The second session of the training program will be held on December 2, 2024, at the Prothrapur Community Hall, Ward No. 23, from 10.30 am to 1 pm. This initiative aims to empower waste workers, enhance their quality of life, and promote sustainable waste management practices in Sri Vijaya Puram, a press release from SVPVC said.

Medicine, who elaborated on this year's theme. Dr. Subrata Saha, Project Director, ANACS, delivered a comprehensive review of regional initiatives addressing HIV/AIDS in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The next session, led by Dr. Mitesh Behari, Consultant Psychiatrist, focused on the mental health challenges faced by HIV-affected communities. Dr. Sneha K., Assistant Professor, Department of Microbiology, shared valuable insights into community-based HIV testing strategies.

Subsequent sessions explored technical aspects such as the latest Antiretroviral Therapy guidelines presented by Dr. Sivaram Appavoo, Consultant in General Medicine, and the complexities of managing HIV and TB co-infection, discussed by Dr. Natraj M., Associate Professor, Department of TB & Chest, ANIMS. Each session included interactive Q&A discussions, creating an engaging platform for knowledge sharing and practical takeaways.

This year's theme emphasized empowering individuals to demand their health rights while promoting a stigma-free and equitable healthcare environment. Such programs are pivotal in spreading awareness, encouraging early detection, and destigmatizing HIV/AIDS. By engaging diverse healthcare professionals and students, the CME reinforced the collective responsibility to eliminate AIDS as a public health threat, a press release ANIMS said.

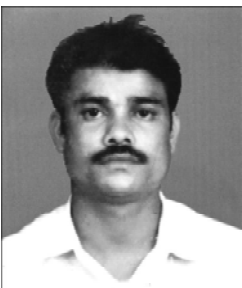

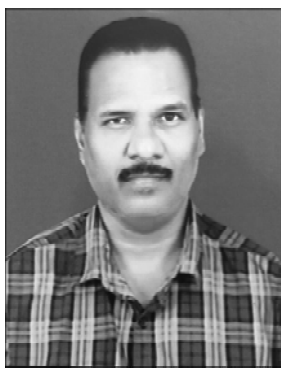
