43rd Ind-Indo CORPAT: Significant milestone in bilateral maritime cooperation Successfully completes harbour and sea phases

The 43rd India-Indonesia Coordinated Patrol (IND-INDO CORPAT) commenced on Dec.10, 2024 at Sabang Port, Indonesia, marking a significant milestone in bilateral maritime cooperation. The Opening Ceremony featured the arrival of Indian Naval Ships INS Kesari and LCU 57, which were warmly received in a traditional manner by the Commander Maritime Security Task Force Indonesia (CO MSTFI). IN ships remained at Sabang from Dec. 10-12, 2024, while Indonesian (IDN) Units

visited Sri Vijaya Puram from Dec. 16-18, 2024 for the harbour phase. This phase involved the reception of IN Units at Sabang and IDN Units at Sri Vijaya Puram, followed by official calls and the closing ceremony. Additional activities included cross-training between IN and IDN Units and engaging sports fixtures.

The sea phase saw dynamic joint exercises between INS Kesari, LCU 57, KRI Bung Karno-369, IN Dornier, and Indonesian aircraft MPA CN235, covering joint patrolling of the International Maritime

District Administration, SA imposes Rs.124 Crore penalty for illegal extraction of minor minerals

Stakeholders urged to adhere to rules and regulations to ensure sustainable and lawful use of resources

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 18

The District Administration, South Andaman, has taken strict action against the illegal extraction and transportation of minor minerals in violation of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Mineral Rules, 2012, and the Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation, 1966.

A case was registered and notices issued to the defaulter. However, he failed to

appear before the authorities or justify his actions. Consequently, a penalty of Rs.1,24,88,000/- has been imposed on the quarry operator for the illegal extraction and transportation of minor minerals, calculated as per Section 34 of the A & N Islands Minor Mineral Rules, 2012, and Section 201(6) of the ANI Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation, 1966 and

instructed to deposit the penalty amount with the Cashier, District Office, South Andaman, within seven days of receiving the order. Failure to comply will result in the penalty being recovered as arrears of land revenue, and necessary entries will be made in the Record of Rights (RoR) of the violator's landholding.

A&N Traffic Police holds meeting with garage owners regarding traffic congestion due to abandoned vehicles**Garage owners directed to remove unused/abandoned vehicles on road side/footpath within one month**

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 18

In order to ensure and improve road safety, A&N Traffic Police has conducted a meeting with garage owners under the chairmanship of Shri Ajay Kr. Rai, Dy. SP (Traffic) to discuss the issues of traffic congestion due to abandoned vehicles.

During the meeting, the following key directives were issued which are as under:

- **Removal of Abandoned Vehicles** - All garage owners have been directed to remove their unused/abandoned vehicles on road side/footpath within one month.
- **Scrapping of Unclaimed Vehicles** - Vehicles that remain unclaimed for extended periods or owner refuses to claim, should proceed for scrap or processed legally.
- **No Roadside**



Repairs - All vehicle repairs, maintenance and mending work must take place within the confines of the garage and not on public roads.

- **RC Verification** - Garage owners must ensure that the vehicle's Registration Certificate (RC) is verified before undertaking any major repairs that might change the identity of the vehicle.

- **Prohibition on Unauthorized Modifications** - Unauthorized modifications to vehicles that could compromise road safety are prohibited.
- **Handling of Stolen**

Vehicles - Garage owners are required to immediately report any suspected stolen vehicles that are brought for repairs or modification. These vehicles should not be worked on unless cleared by the Police and garage owners should cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies in tracking and recovering stolen vehicles.

The Traffic Police will be closely monitoring compliance with these issues and will take necessary action against those who do not adhere to the directions, a press release from SP (Traffic) said.

AND, WHEREAS, Steel Bailey Bridge located on State Highway-14 (SH-14) at Nabagram is the only connectivity to Kalighat and Ramnagar area;

AND, WHEREAS, it has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that despite warning boards, heavy loaded vehicles are plying on the road which can cause danger to human life and safety of the passengers;

AND, WHEREAS, the Executive Engineer, CD, APWD, Diglipur has informed the undersigned vide Letter No. RR-DB/CD/DP/2024-25/5220 dated 14.12.2024 that repairing work of that Bailey bridge shall be undertaken on 19th December, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **Kamaleshwar Rao S, IAS** Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Diglipur, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under **Section 163 of BNSS, 2023**, do hereby order the **closure of the road** passing through the Bailey Bridge on SH-14 at Nabagram on **19.12.2024** for a period of one day and prohibit any individual residing in Nabagram Village and the general public from using the Bailey Bridge on SH-14 at Nabagram in the interest of public safety and to facilitate immediate repair work.

AND, ALSO, during this closure, no vehicular movement, except emergency vehicles, shall be permitted over the said bridge.

The Executive Engineer, APWD, Diglipur, is directed to ensure the repair work is completed within the stipulated period and communicate its reopening promptly.
