

## Highlights of Lok Sabha General Election 2024 held in A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Dec. 30

Along with the rest of India, the Election machinery in this UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands successfully conducted the General Election to the Lok Sabha in the first phase on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2024, with the counting of votes held on 04<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

Soil testing is a critical component in agricultural productivity and environmental management. It helps determine the nutrient content, composition, and other characteristics such as the pH level and contamination levels of the soil. This information is essential for farmers and agronomists to make informed

decisions about soil management and crop production.

The Govt. of India mandates recognizing the Government Soil Testing Laboratory through the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) and aims to uphold the standards of soil testing laboratories, thereby supporting agricultural and environmental

management with high-quality and reliable soil analysis. NABL ensures that the laboratories have infrastructure and processes, so that the test results and reports issued by soil testing laboratories maintain the quality of soil data used for Soil Health Cards.

The Soil Testing Laboratory (STL), Goal Ghar, Sri Vijaya Puram under Directorate of Agriculture,

satisfactorily participated in the Proficiency Testing (PT) program conducted by accredited PT provider as per ISO/IEC 17043 and test parameters covered in the last one-year in PT programs were considered for recognition and accordingly, have achieved recognition for Eight parameters from NABL. 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## Implementation of NTEP activities in PHC Kadamtala & PHC Baratang reviewed

The District TB Officer (DTO), N&M Andaman, Dr. Prabir Kumar Palit, along with his team conducted a site visit to PHC Kadamtala to monitor and supervise the implementation of National Tuberculosis Elimination Program (NTEP) activities. During the visit, the DTO inspected the laboratory facilities and engaged in discussions with the MO (I/c) regarding the increase of sputum referrals for presumptive TB examinations.

Later, awareness-cum sensitization program on Tuberculosis was held in the Conference hall of PHC Kadamtala. The program was conducted to educate health officials and the general public about TB, covering various



aspects of the disease. During the programme, Dr. Prabir Kumar Palit provided a refresher training session focusing on symptoms of Tuberculosis, modes of transmission, prevention strategies, Nikshay Poshan Yojana and role and responsibilities of Nishay Mitra.

A total of 54 participants attended the program and the program concluded with an interactive doubt clearing session, during which, attendees had the opportunity to ask

questions regarding TB, its management and preventive measures. The DTO addressed various concerns raised by the public, ensuring that misconceptions were clarified and accurate information was provided.

The DTO also visited the designated Microscopy Center at PHC Baratang and reviewed the microscopy lab to ensure quality and reliability in TB diagnostics, a press release from DTO, N&MA said.

## Australia registers 184-run victory over India in Melbourne test

Melbourne, Dec. 30

In Border-Gavaskar Trophy Cricket, Australia registered a 184 run victory over India on the fifth and final day of the fourth test in Melbourne. With this loss, India has thin chances for reaching the World Test Championship Final. India bundled out at 155 runs in their second innings while chasing a target of 340 runs. Yashashvi Jaiswal fought a lone battle, scoring 84 runs before a

controversial dismissal.

For Australia, Pat Cummins and Scott Boland took three wickets each while Nathan Lyon scalped two. Cummins has been named as the player of the match. He scored 49 runs and clinched 3 wickets in first innings, also hitting 41 runs in the second innings. Earlier, Australia were bundled out for 234 runs after resuming their second innings at the overnight score of 228 for 9 this morning.

Indian pacer, Bumrah took a five wicket haul.

In the first innings, Australia opted to bat and scored 474 runs supported by Steven Smith's 140. In reply, India managed to score 369 runs shouldered on Nitish Reddy's fighting knock of 114. Australia now leads the 5-match series 2-1. The 5<sup>th</sup> Test of the Border Gavaskar Trophy, a must-win match for India's WCT Final hopes, will be played in Sydney from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of January.

- ♦ The Shompen tribe resides in the dense tropical rain forest of the Great Nicobar Islands, Nicobar District took part in the election process for the first time cast their votes and were very happy to have exercised their democratic rights. Out of the 84 Shompen tribe, 8 Shompens exercised their franchise while out of the 68 Onges, 63 persons cast their vote. Similarly, 33 out of 39 Great Andamanese of Strait Island exercised their franchise, a press release from Dy. CEO, A&N Islands said.

This will boost the laboratory's capabilities and Administration's commitment in its role in advancing agriculture standards and practices in these Islands.

During this financial year of 2024-25, MoA&FW, INM Division has allotted a target of 10,000 Nos. of soil samples from various villages of all the zones. Accordingly, a zone-wise target has been allotted, and staff have been authorized for the collection of soil samples through the SHC Mobile app in the farmers field. In a press release, the Department of Agriculture has requested the farmers to contact the Zonal Agriculture Office to get their soil collected and analyzed to obtain the Soil Health Card with proper recommendation.

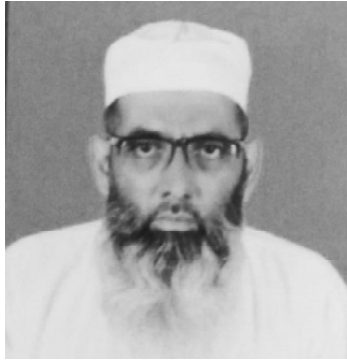

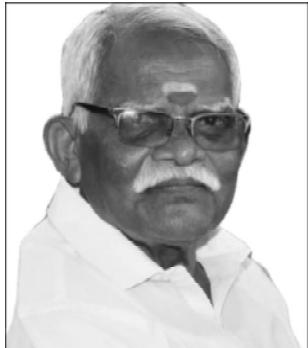
