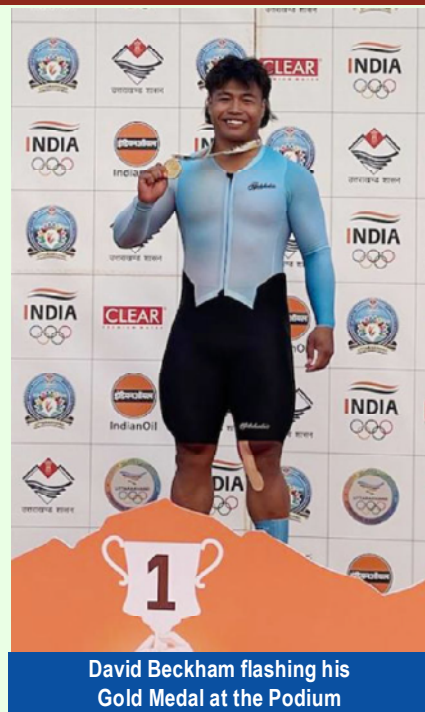

In yet another stellar performance by the cyclists of the Islands, David Beckham, the ace rider, clinched a magnificent Gold medal today in the 1000 mtrs Time Trial Individual men, creating a new national record with an impressive time of 01:07:871 minutes. Showcasing his exceptional skill and determination, Beckham powered his way to victory, leaving his competitors far behind. This is Beckham's third Gold in the 38<sup>th</sup> National Games.

Adding another Gold today, the A&N Islands is currently in 16<sup>th</sup> position in the medals tally, with a total of 7 medals which includes 4 Gold, 1 Silver

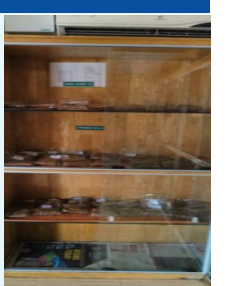
