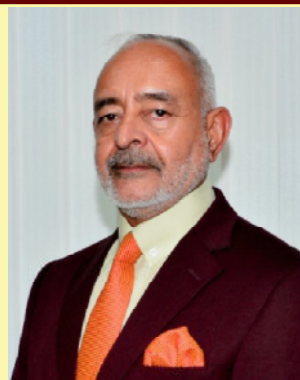

### MP urges for urgent repair of road from Junglighat School to Burning Ghat

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 19 Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, has raised the concerns regarding the deteriorating condition of the road stretch between Junglighat School and Burning Ghat via Ayush Hospital in Junglighat. In a communication addressed to the Secretary (PWD) and the Chief Engineer, APWD, the Member of Parliament has urged for immediate repair and renovation of the road, citing the

hardships faced by daily commuters. He further pointed out that the absence of proper drainage facilities from the market area to Burning Ghat, leading to severe water logging during the rainy season, causing further damage to the road infrastructure. Therefore, he urged to ensure that necessary drainage provisions are made along with the road repairs to prevent future deterioration, a press release from MP Office said.

## Pahargaon Police cracks gold jewellery theft case; two arrested

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 19 Police Station Pahargaon has successfully solved a gold jewellery theft case with the arrest of two accused and the recovery of stolen ornaments worth over Rs. 1.5 lakhs. On Feb.4, 2025, an FIR was registered at PS Pahargaon following a complaint regarding the theft of gold ornaments from a residence in Mahaveer Nagar. A dedicated team was formed under the leadership of Inspector Mohd Elias, SHO, PS P a h a r g a o n , comprising of PSI Animesh Ram, IO of the case, HC/Limbu, PC/Rahul Kumar Maurya and PC(D)/ Nuka Raju. Through meticulous analysis of CCTV footage and gathering of local intelligence, the team identified and apprehended Sajahan Sekh, S/o Shri Subidali Sekh, 37 yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o Hatpukuria, Bhaleya, South 24 Parganas, Canning-I, West Bengal now at Barood Godown near Firing Range, Birdline and recovered the part of the stolen gold ornaments from him. During interrogation, he further revealed that he had purchased the part of the stolen gold ornaments from the thief namely Zakir Hussain. Further investigation led to the arrest of Zakir Hussain, S/o Shri Sekh Hasem, 27 yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o near Office of Andaman Tour For You, Mahaveer Nagar and the recovery of the remaining stolen gold ornaments, a press release from SSP (SA) said.
