Middle class is always in PM Modi's heart: HM

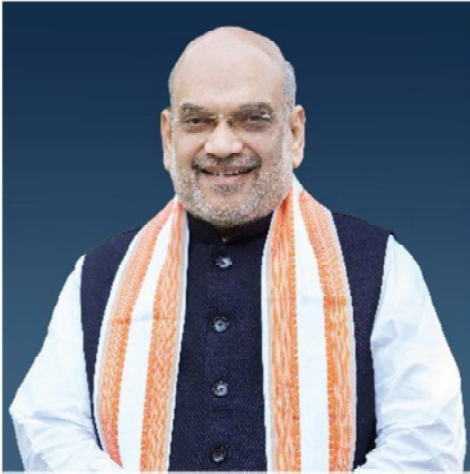
New Delhi, Feb. 2 (PIB)

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah hailed Union Budget 2025 as a blueprint for the Modi Government's vision for building a developed and premier India in every sector. Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah congratulated Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi and Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman for this inclusive and farsighted budget.

In a series of posts on X platform, Shri Amit Shah said that Union Budget 2025 as a blueprint for the Modi

Government's vision for building a developed and premier India in every sector. He said that this budget, encompassing every sector from farmers, poor, middle class to education of women and children, nutrition, and health, as well as startups, innovation and investment, is the roadmap for Modi Ji's vision of an AatmaNirbhar Bharat.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said, the middle class is always in PM Modi's heart. The Budget announced zero income tax till Rs. 12 Lakh Income. The proposed tax exemption



will go a long way in enhancing the financial well-being of the middle class, he added. Shri Amit Shah said, the budget reflects the Modi Government's commitment to the welfare of farmers. He said, the announcement of the Prime Minister Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana aims at increasing production capacity in the 100 lowest crop productivity districts,

benefiting nearly 1.7 crore farmers. Additionally, Pulses Self-Reliance Mission and Cotton Productivity Mission will promote the prosperity of farmers and enhance nutritional security.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said, from budget to the Cabinet, farmers are at the core of the Modi Government's schemes and policies. He said, in order to achieve self-reliance in urea production, the Government has decided to set up a urea plant in Assam with a capacity of 12.7 lakh metric tons in Budget

2025. Along with this, the decision to increase the loan amount under the Kisan Credit Card (KCC) from Rs. 3 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh will provide significant relief to farmers.

Shri Amit Shah congratulated MSME sector for the doubling of the credit guarantee cover, adding Rs. 1.5 lakh crore. He said this will scale up start-ups and foster manufacturing hubs. Shri Shah said that the budget's focus on footwear, leather and toy manufacturing industries will spur jobs in the grassroots, advancing PM Modi Ji's

Samudrayaan Mission gets Rs 600 Crore allocation in Union Budget



New Delhi, Feb. 2

India's ambitious mission to send scientists to explore the depths of the ocean in specially-designed submersible Samudrayaan got a boost with Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman allocating Rs 600 crore for the Deep Ocean Mission. The mission involves mapping deep ocean floors and developing technologies like a manned submersible with 6000 m water-depth rating. It also involves exploration of deep-sea mining for

sustainable utilisation of deep-sea bioresources and developing engineering designs for offshore thermal energy-driven desalination plants.

India plans to send a manned-submersible, developed by the Chennai-based National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT), up to a depth of 500 metres in the ocean later this year, and gradually explore the seabed at the depth of 6,000 meters next year.

All Ration Card Holders of the UT who have their family members migrated to foreign countries for seeking job or are serving in other countries or have acquired foreign citizenship or have got Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card have been requested to inform the Department of CS&CA and get their names deleted from their Ration Cards immediately, failing which, strict action as per the provisions of PDS Control Order, 2015 shall be taken against the card holders without any further notice, a press release from Deptt. of CS&CA said.

SVPMC introduces user charges and strict penalties for proper disposal of Construction & Demolition Waste Establishes C&D Waste Storage Units

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb 2

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVPMC) has introduced user charges and strict penalties for the proper disposal of Construction and Demolition (C&D) waste in accordance with the Solid Waste (Handling and Management) Bye-Laws, 2017. Under the provision of the Bye-Laws, all C&D waste generators must store C&D waste separately and contact SVPMC's Control Room No.: 03192-231179. SVPMC will ensure waste pickup within seven days of generation and transport it to a designated Storage-cum-Transfer Center.

To facilitate this, SVPMC has established C&D Waste Storage Units controlled by concerned Road works Junior Engineers at Anarkali (Ward Nos. 01-08), AIR Road (Ward Nos. 01-08), VIP Road (Ward Nos. 10-13), Dairy Farm (Ward Nos. 09, 14-16), and Dollygunj



(Ward Nos. 17-24).

To streamline the process, SVPMC has set user charges at Rs.900 per cubic meter/ton for collection and transportation, while violators who fail to properly segregate and dispose of C&D waste will face a penalty of Rs.5000 per ton.

Residents can request waste pickup via an online form (<https://forms.gle/hUkAPfGVEsrfixCT8>) or visit SVPMC's official website (<https://pbmc.gov.in/>), or by

calling the SVPMC Control Room at 03192- 231179. Upon receiving a request, the concerned Road Works Junior Engineer will arrange for collection, and payments will be facilitated through a PoS machine issued by the Revenue Officer, SVPMC.

To ensure compliance, SVPMC's Sanitary Inspectors will monitor adherence to these regulations and impose spot fines for violations. If a waste generator fails to comply, SVPMC may issue a notice and require the clearance of waste at designated locations or payment for its removal. SVPMC has urged all citizens to adhere to these guidelines and contribute to maintaining a cleaner and a more sustainable Sri Vijaya Puram. vision of a Viksit Bharat. Union Home Minister said, the UDAN scheme is proving to be beneficial in providing air connectivity to new cities and promoting affordable transportation. Shri Shah said, in Budget 2025, the scheme will be expanded with 120 new airports to be developed across the country. He said that this will increase the capacity to accommodate an additional 4 crore air passengers and further enhance transportation in remote areas.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi gives new wings to the dreams and aspirations of our youth in the Union Budget 2025. He said that the goal to add 75,000 medical seats in five years, accommodate 6,500 more students in 5 IITs, and grant 10,000 research fellowships through IITs and IISc will fuel the growth engine of our nation with the technological prowess of our youth. Shri Amit Shah said that in order to further enrich the scientific mindset and aspirations for research among the youth of the country, Budget 2025 is extremely significant. Home Minister said that the decision to establish 50,000 Atal Tinkering Labs in Government schools over the next five years will promote innovation among the new generation. He said that the announcement to set up 5 National Centres of Excellence for skill enhancement of the youth is commendable.

Shri Amit Shah said, in Budget 2025, the announcement of making books available in digital format in Indian languages through the 'Bharatiya Bhasha Pustak Yojana' will breathe new life into Indian languages. This decision will prove to be crucial in connecting the new generation with Indian languages and making education more inclusive. Union Home Minister said, the Union Budget 2025 breathes new energy into life and development in cities through the Rs. 1 lakh crore Urban Challenge Fund. Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said, Budget 2025 equips our maritime and shipping industries with the winning edge. He said, with the Rs. 25,000 crore Maritime Development Fund and the extension of the exemption of BCD on raw materials, components, consumables, or parts for the manufacturing of ships for another ten years, these sectors are poised to dominate the competition in the global markets. Shri Amit Shah said, the Budget 2025 brings the healing touch to the lives of the ailing by providing full exemption from Basic Customs Duty on 36 lifesaving drugs & medicines and proposing Day Care Cancer Centres in all district hospitals in the next 3 years and 200 of them in 2025-26 alone. Union Home Minister said, Budget 2025 is also a new opportunity and means for the prosperity of gig workers. He said, now, gig workers will not only receive an identity card by registering on the e-Shram portal, but they will also get benefits of health facilities.
