## Election Commission of India publishes Final Voters list for Andaman & Nicobar Islands after completion of SIR process

### Total electorate in A&N Islands as on 21.02.2026 is 2,58,040; Electors advised to verify their names in the Electoral Roll

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 21

As per the directions of the Election Commission of India, a Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral Roll-2026, with reference to 01.01.2026 as the qualifying date, was conducted in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands from 27.10.2025 to 21.02.2026. The Final Electoral Roll has been published on 21.02.2026.

The revision exercise involved 100% physical verification of electors through enumeration forms delivered and collected personally by Booth Level Officers. This comprehensive exercise has resulted in the identification and deletion of a substantial number of ineligible electors, including deceased persons, electors who have permanently shifted to other States/UTs and cases of duplicate enrolments.

The draft roll was published on 23.12.2025 after the Enumeration Phase under SIR. Out of the 3,10,404 electors enrolled in the Electoral Roll as on 27.10.2025, a total of 64,014 ineligible electors have been removed from the draft roll. Subsequently, the statutory period for filing Claims and Objections was conducted from 23.12.2025 to 22.01.2026, during which 16,919 were added and 5,269 ineligible electors were deleted. Accordingly, the Final Electoral Roll-2026 has been published on 21.02.2026 with an updated and validated list of eligible electors.

First time electors in the age group of 18-19 years and existing electors who have shifted to Andaman & Nicobar Islands and applied for corrections will be issued EPICs through the BLOs to their residential address.

Those who have completed 18 years as on 01.01.2026 and failed to apply for inclusion during the Special Intensive Revision and the prospective electors completing 18 years on 01.04.2026, 01.07.2026 and 01.10.2026 can apply online through <https://voters.eci.gov.in> or ECINET mobile App or through the Booth Level Officer (BLO)

concerned.

Electors are advised to verify their names in the Electoral Roll and if required, submit applications for inclusion (Form-6), Correction (Form-8) or deletion (Form-7) through online or offline modes.

Appeals under section 24 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950: An appeal shall lie from any decision of the ERO to the District Magistrate u/s 24(a) of the RP Act, 1950 and a second appeal under Section 24(b) against the decision of the first Appellate authority shall lie to the Chief Electoral Officer, in the manner prescribed under Rule 27 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960.

### Let Every Drop Count: Appeal for Responsible Water Use in Sri Vijaya Puram

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 21

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council is presently facing a shortfall in potable water availability, which is expected to become more challenging in the coming days due to seasonal and operational constraints. Ensuring safe drinking water for every household remains the highest priority of the Municipal Administration.

In this context, the cooperation of all residents is earnestly sought to conserve water so that essential needs such as drinking, cooking, and basic domestic use can be met equitably across all 24 Wards.

As a temporary but necessary measure, citizens are requested to avoid the following non-essential uses of potable water with immediate effect:

- Washing of cars, bikes, and other vehicles
- Cleaning of premises, roads, and compounds using hoses/pipes
- Watering of lawns, gardens, and ornamental plants
- Use of drinking water for construction works, including curing.

- Reuse water from washing vegetables and utensils for cleaning or flushing.
- Check taps and pipes regularly and report leaks immediately.

These small acts of conservation, when practised collectively, can save significant quantities of water each day and help ensure that no household is left without basic water supply.

The Municipal Council appeals to hotels, commercial establishments, institutions, and bulk consumers to adopt water-saving practices and use alternative sources such as reused or non-potable water wherever possible.

SVPMC assures the public that multiple measures are being taken simultaneously, including improving distribution efficiency, controlling leakages, and augmenting supply wherever feasible. Regular updates will be shared to keep citizens informed.

Water is a shared resource and a shared responsibility. With public cooperation, Sri Vijaya Puram can overcome this challenge together, a press release from SVPMC said.

Experts explained how mangroves act as natural bio-shields against coastal erosion, storm surges, and rising sea levels, while also serving as breeding and nursery grounds for numerous marine species. The programme also functioned as a platform to promote sustainable eco-tourism practices that balance visitor engagement with environmental protection.



A good gathering of people, including nature enthusiasts, tourism stakeholders, PRI members, and local residents, actively participated in the event. **National launch of Access Pass for Fishing in India's Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) opens new horizon in Marine Fisheries sector**

**Access Passes issued free via ReALCRaft Online to empower Fisheries Cooperatives & FFPOs, promote sustainable harvesting of high-value fishes & boost seafood exports**

New Delhi, Feb. 21 (PIB)

India is endowed with a vast and diverse marine resource base, supported by a coastline of approximately 11,099 km and an Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of about 24 lakh square kilometres. At present, most Indian fishing activity remains limited to 40-50 nautical miles from the coastline, while the vast EEZ, extending from 12 to 200 nautical miles remains significantly under-utilised, despite scientific assessments indicating substantial potential for high-value oceanic resources, particularly tuna and tuna like species.

Recognising this opportunity, the Government of India announced in the Union Budget 2025-26 an enabling framework for the sustainable utilisation of fisheries resources in the EEZ and high seas, with special emphasis on the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep, which together account for 49% of India's EEZ with an estimated marine fisheries potential of 2.48 lakh tonnes.

In pursuance of the Budget announcement and to provide a robust legal and institutional framework for fisheries in the EEZ, the Government of India notified the Sustainable Harnessing of Fisheries in the Exclusive Economic Zone Rules, 2025, on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2025, under the Territorial Waters, Continental Shelf, Exclusive Economic Zone and Other Maritime Zones Act, 1976 (80 of 1976). The Rules constitute a landmark policy initiative aimed at promoting responsible and sustainable utilisation of marine fisheries resources in the EEZ, while ensuring conservation of marine ecosystems, compliance with international obligations and enhancement of fishers' livelihoods.

**Access Pass under the EEZ Rules**

The Access Pass is a key instrument under the EEZ Rules to empower Indian fishers to sustainably harvest high-value oceanic resources. It aims to:

- > Support the transition from near shore to deepsea fishing,
- > Promote fisher organisation into cooperatives and FFPOs,
- > Enhance incomes through higher catch, better prices and export-compliant practices such as traceability and certification.

To further boost the Marine sector and sustainably harness the EEZ, Hon'ble Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying & Panchayati Raj, Shri Rajiv Ranjan Singh, launched the Access Pass for Fishing in India's EEZ for all 13 coastal states and UTs from KCC Ground, Veraval, Gujarat on 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2026. During the launch, Hon'ble Union Minister FAHD Shri Singh handed over the Access Passes to 37 Fishermen representing 24 Fisheries cooperative societies from all Coastal States/UTs of India.

During the national launch of the Access Pass initiative held yesterday in Veraval, the Hon'ble Union Minister handed over passes to selected fishermen from 13 coastal States/UTs. The beneficiaries included Chandra

**WHAT IS ACCESS PASS ?**  
An Access Pass is a mandatory permit required for vessels to engage in fishing activities in the exclusive economic zone (EEZ).

**WHO NEEDS AN ACCESS PASS?**

- Required only for:**
  - All Mechanized Vessels
  - Motorized Vessels (24m and above OAL)
  - Pole and line Vessels
- Not Required for:**
  - Motorized Traditional Vessels (<24m OAL and not engaged in Tuna Fishery)
  - Non-motorized traditional vessels

**APPROVAL PROCESS FOR ACCESS PASS**

In case of queries, notification will be referred to Director for Marine Resource Management.

Approval Process: Vessel Owner/Operator → Application → Issuance of Access Pass → Issuance of Health Certificate → Issuance of EIC → Issuance of Fish Catch Certificate.

Access Pass will be issued within 24 working days.

Pugal Selva Mani from Tamil Nadu representing the Tharuvaikulam Fishermen Cooperative Society; Sanjeeb Babu from Kerala linked to the Boat Owners' Association, Kollam; Siddhartha Dsouza and Ivor Domic Dsouza from Goa of the Mandavi Fishermen Marketing Cooperative Society Ltd.; Jagdish Nathu Charaniya and Sejal Varjangu from Daman & Diu associated with Shri Mahasagar Fisheries Coop Society, Vanakbara and Shri Mahakaleshwar Fisheries Coop Society, Saudwadi; Subodh Kandar and Radha Krishna Manna from West Bengal; Ummer Farook E.P from Lakshadweep; Durai Selvam and T. Devaraju from Andaman & Nicobar Islands, representing the Andaman Mechanized Vessels Welfare Association and the Sree Sai Jyothi Fisheries Cooperative Youth Society Ltd.; and Mukesh Premji Panjari along with other fishermen from Gujarat, belonging to Porbandar Machhimar Boat Association, Shree Rameshwar Matsyodyog Sahakari Mandali Ltd., and Shree Veraval Samast Kharwa Samaj, among others. The Minister highlighted that the initiative marks a major step toward safer, more transparent, and better-regulated marine fishing operations across India.

Under the EEZ Rules, an Access Pass is required for mechanized and large-sized motorized vessels, which can be obtained free of cost through the online Registration and Licensing of Fishing Craft (ReALCRaft) portal. The ReALCRaft portal, developed as a national online platform by the NIC and Department of Fisheries,

provides web-based, citizen-centric services to marine fishers and coastal States/UTs for the registration and licensing of fishing vessels, transfer of ownership, and related processes, thereby promoting ease of doing business. ReALCRaft is also integrated with Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) and the Export Inspection Council (EIC) for issuance of Fish Catch and Health Certificates, which are key requirements for exporting seafood to premium international markets. This integrated digital system ensures end-to-end traceability, sanitary compliance, and eco-labelling, thereby enhancing the global competitiveness of Indian marine products.

Further, the Department of Fisheries plan to roll out structured training and capacity building programmes through CIFNET, FSI and in partnership with coastal States/UTs to equip fishers with deep sea fishing skills, safety awareness and export grade handling practices.

A Joint Working Group of Department of Fisheries with Ministry of Cooperation has also been constituted to actively promote the participation of small-scale fishermen and strengthen fisheries cooperatives in deep-sea fishing, post-harvest management, processing and export value chains.

**Salient Features of the Access Pass**

1. Protection for Small and Artisanal Fishers

Traditional non-motorized fishing crafts are exempted from the requirement of an Access Pass. Only mechanised fishing vessels (approx. 64,000) and large motorised vessels above 24 metres are required to obtain the Pass. This ensures that small and artisanal fishers remain protected and their livelihoods safeguarded.

2. Upgraded ReALCRaft Digital Platform

The ReALCRaft platform has been upgraded to support a seamless and user friendly Access Pass process. ReALCRaft is already widely used by States/UTs and fishers for vessel registration and licensing.

3. Zero-Fee, Fully Online Access Pass

The Access Pass is issued free of cost, entirely through the ReALCRaft portal in a time bound and transparent manner. Once approved, the Pass is delivered digitally to the fisher's registered mobile number or email, ensuring transparency and ease of access.

4. Single Window System for Global Exports

The ReALCRaft portal is integrated with the MPEDA portal for Catch Certificates and with EIC for Health Certificates, creating a unified single window digital ecosystem. This integration enhances traceability, reduces procedural delays and facilitates access to premium international seafood markets.


