Traffic diversion in view of Annual Pooja at Austinabad Temple

In exercise of the powers conferred under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act No. 59 of 1988), read with the Administration's Notification No. /2008/F.No.32-95/2008-TR dated 10th March, 2008 and in view of the ongoing Annual Pooja-2026 of Goddess Devi Sree Muthumariamman at Austinabad Temple from 15th to 25th February, 2026 and in view of the sacred fire walk on 23.02.2026 followed by Maha Annadanam on 24.02.2026, the District Magistrate, South Andaman District, has issued the following notification to ensure smooth regulation of vehicular movement and to prevent traffic congestion in and around the temple area:

Training on Hydroponic Fodder Production & Azolla conducted at VSD Maccapahad

Training Prog. and Exposure Visit on Spices benefits Island Farm Women

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 22
ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Sri Vijaya Puram conducted a training programme on 'Scientific Cultivation of Spices as Intercrops in the Plantation Based Cropping Systems' on February 18, 2026 under CSS-MIDH (NHM) Project on Spices and AICRP on Plantation Crops.

During the inaugural session, Dr. Jai Sunder, Director (A), interacted with participants and expressed satisfaction at their enthusiastic participation. He encouraged them to seek guidance from scientists to resolve challenges in crop, livestock, and fishery sectors. Dr. Ajit Arun Waman, Senior Scientist and Course Director, delivered a presentation on scientific spice cultivation and demonstrated cinnamon harvesting using the Dweep CinnRub tool developed by ICAR-CIARI. Participants also viewed educational films on the harvesting and post-harvest handling of spices.

During the field visits, participants were taken to the Field Distillation Unit wherein essential oil extraction was demonstrated. Further, participants visited Horticultural Plants Propagation Unit wherein they witnessed nursery raising of perennial spices. Protected cultivation of woody pepper was shown to them wherein possibilities of promotion of this novel spice were discussed. Cultivation of Malabar tamarind using grafts of improved varieties viz. Dweep Agrim and Dweep Vishal, gravity fed drip irrigation and adoption of weed mat were showcased.

At the Horticulture Research Farm, Sippighat, Dr. Pooja Bohra, Senior Scientist and Course Coordinator, highlighted the importance of intercropping under coconut and arecanut plantations.

To give impetus for this, planting material of various spices including cinnamon, woody pepper, lemongrass, arecanut 'Samrudhi' were distributed to the participants, a press release from CIARI said.

applicant must have at least 120 square feet of space (owned or rented), employ a registered pharmacist with a B. Pharma or D. Pharma degree, and hold a drug sale license from the State Drug Control Authority. Only one Kendra will be allowed per revenue block, with priority given to areas with large livestock populations.

The Government is providing strong financial support. Store operators will get a 20% margin on the selling price (excluding tax) of each medicine. A one-time incentive of Rs. 1.5 lakh is available for Kendras opened in aspirational districts, hilly areas, islands, and north-eastern States. In addition, a monthly incentive of up to Rs. 20,000 will be given based on how much stock the Kendra maintains and how many medicines it purchases and sells.

Only medicines supplied by the Pharmaceutical and Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI) can be sold at these centres. Billing must be done using the official Point-of-Sale (PoS) system. Ethno-veterinary products and certified animal feeds can also be sold. The scheme is jointly implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Cooperation, and PMBI. Applicants must apply online through the DAHD portal and pay a fee of Rs. 5,000, which is waived for stores in aspirational areas.

This initiative not only helps farmers by cutting veterinary costs but also supports employment and entrepreneurship through cooperative societies and rural retail outlets. Those running or associated with PM-KSKs or cooperatives are encouraged to apply and take part in improving animal health in their communities, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.




