## Two-day National Reverse Buyer Seller Meet concludes

### Event witnessed enthusiastic participation from buyers across mainland India and sellers from the Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 24

The two-day National Reverse Buyer Seller Meet (NRBSM) organized by the Departments of Agriculture, Fisheries and Industries, A&N Administration, in association with the Indian Chamber of Commerce, concluded successfully today at Megapode Resort, Sri Vijaya Puram. The event, held from Feb. 23 to 24 at Haddo, witnessed enthusiastic participation from buyers across mainland India and sellers from the Islands representing seafood, coconut and coconut-based products, indigenous spices, exotic tropical flowers, and other value-added food products.

The second day of the meet was dedicated to structured B2B interactions between buyers and sellers, enabling direct trade discussions and market



linkages. A comprehensive interaction and feedback session were also convened between the A&N Administration and the visiting buyers and local entrepreneurs. During the session, buyers expressed strong interest in initiating and expanding trade in seafood, spices and coconut-based products from the Islands. Several buyers indicated their readiness to commence procurement on a regular basis.

Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary

(Fisheries, Agriculture and Industries), and Ms. Jagtap Kalyani Rajendra, Director of Fisheries, participated in the interaction session. They assured the buyers and sellers of the Administration's continued support in strengthening infrastructure, facilitating certifications, improving cold chain logistics, and resolving trade bottlenecks to promote sustained mainland-Island trade partnerships.

As part of the programme, visiting buyers were taken on



field visits to key production and marketing hubs including the Fish Landing Centre at Junglighat, the Spice Garden at Beodnabad, a fish processing unit at Dollygunj Industrial Estate, and the Government Emporium "Sagarika," showcasing local handicrafts and value-added products. The exposure visits provided firsthand insight into the production practices, hygiene standards, raw material availability, and processing potential of the Islands. Officials from the

Marine Products Export Development Authority also inspected the proposed land identified for the development of a Seafood Processing Cluster/Aquapark, marking a significant step towards strengthening export-oriented infrastructure in the Islands. The field visit witnessed active trade negotiations of Buyers and Sellers which is expected to pave the foundation for future trade development of the Islands.

## Deputy Commissioner (N&MA) reviews developmental issues during visit to Baratang

Baratang, Feb. 24

During his visit to Baratang on Feb. 20 & 21, under the ongoing initiative 'Sampark se Samadhan - Prashasan Gaon ki Ore,' the Deputy Commissioner, North & Middle Andaman, Shri Sushant Padha, IAS held a series of meetings with members of the Fibre Boat Association, Panchayati Raj Institution (PRI) representatives and officials/contractors of NHIDCL to review various developmental issues concerning tourism, infrastructure and public amenities.

In order to boost tourism in Baratang, the Deputy Commissioner held detailed interactions with members of the Fibre Boat Association and



representatives of the Panchayati Raj Institutions. During the discussions, key proposals viz; improvement of jetty and cave area infrastructure, strengthening of safety and visitor amenities, better regulation and facilitation of boat services, and the development of Baludera Beach as an emerging tourist destination were put forth. The stakeholders also emphasized the need for improved sea

connectivity, particularly the proposed Baludera-Swaraj Dweep route with linkage to Long Island, which is expected to significantly increase tourist footfall. The Deputy Commissioner appreciated the proactive inputs and assured that the suggestions would be examined in consultation with the concerned Departments for feasible implementation.

The Deputy Commissioner also reviewed the progress of ongoing road and bridge works with NHIDCL officials, including the status of piling works and project timelines. Directions were issued to expedite pending works, address local concerns at Sundergarh, Adazig, Nilambur Jetty and Kadamtala and ensure installation of appropriate safety measures near educational and health institutions.

A separate meeting was convened with the Divisional Forest Officer and Revenue officials to deliberate on long-pending forest and revenue land disputes affecting


## GB Pant Hospital achieves major Oncological milestone in A&N Islands

### Keyhole Surgery saves woman with rare Appendix Cancer

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 24

In a major medical achievement for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, doctors at GB Pant Hospital successfully performed a complex laparoscopic (keyhole) cancer surgery on a 67-year-old woman diagnosed with a very rare cancer of the appendix, called mucinous adenocarcinoma of the appendix.

The patient came to the hospital with complaints of



abdominal pain. After careful evaluation using CT scan and colonoscopy, the surgical team found a problem in her appendix and advised surgery. During the operation, doctors discovered a tumor arising from the appendix, a condition seen only rarely.

The surgery performed was a Laparoscopic Right Hemicolectomy, an advanced minimally invasive procedure in which the diseased portion of the intestine was removed using small cuts instead of a large open incision. The operation was successfully carried out by Dr. Saji Vargheese

and Dr. Anis Akhtarkhavari, with excellent support from the anesthesia team led by Dr. Narayan.

Following the surgery, the patient made steady progress.

She was given oral feeds after four days and recovered well. She has now been discharged from the hospital and will receive additional (adjuvant) chemotherapy as part of her cancer treatment.

Doctors highlighted that this surgery is one of the advanced oncological minimal access surgeries recently performed at GB Pant Hospital. Such high-end cancer surgeries being done locally mean that patients from the islands no longer need to travel to mainland India for complex treatment.


