Infant among seven rescued safely after Helicopter makes forced landing in Sea off the coast of Mayabunder

Mayabunder, Feb. 25

A Pawan Hans helicopter made a forced landing in the sea off the coast of Mayabunder on Feb. 24, 2026. The helicopter was carrying seven persons on board, including an infant with two pilots.

As per the flight details, the helicopter took off from Sri Vijaya Puram for Rangat at 0830 hrs, landed at Rangat at 0908 hrs and departed for Mayabunder at approximately 0911 hrs (approximate flying time: 15 minutes). When the helicopter did not arrive at the Mayabunder helipad as scheduled, the helipad staff waited for about 5-10 minutes. Meanwhile, the Pradhan, Gram Panchayat Rampur, informed that the helicopter had made a forced landing in the sea near Tota Tikrey (local name), Mayabunder.

Upon receipt of the first information from the local Pradhan, Shri Sushant Padha, IAS, Deputy Commissioner,



North and Middle Andaman, immediately alerted the Station Commandant, Coast Guard and the SDPO to mobilize boats of the Coast Guard and Police Marine Force.

Demonstrating exceptional courage and presence of mind, Shri K.Karthik Kumar (IRBn Compounder HC(SG/051536) along with Shri Saw Manashy (S/o Saw Malachi), Shri Saw Thomas (S/o Saw Sakaree) and Shri Saw Sakaree (S/o Saw Alisha) posted as Daily Rated Mazdoors in Interview Wildlife Sanctuary and who were enroute to Interview Island plunged into the

sea without hesitation. Risking their own safety, they successfully rescued all passengers and pilots. Owing to their prompt and selfless efforts, all persons onboard were brought to safety.

The Deputy Commissioner (N&MA) immediately reached the site to oversee evacuation and necessary assistance. Swift joint action was launched by the District Administration, Police Marine Force, Coast Guard and Forest Department with the support of local residents and all concerned agencies rushed to the spot where the helicopter had made the forced landing.



All passengers, including the infant and both pilots, were rescued and immediately shifted to District Hospital, Mayabunder, where necessary medical examination and treatment were carried out.

The District Administration has highly commended the exemplary bravery,

dedication and humanitarian spirit displayed by the rescuers and all Departments involved in rescue operations. Their timely

Onge Tribal Home Guard Volunteers felicitated by DGP for their assistance in major drug seizure

Sri Vijaya Puram, Feb. 25

The Director General of Police, A&N Islands, felicitated Onge tribal Home Guard Volunteers Shri Raja and Shri Hraj in a special ceremony held at Police Headquarters (PHQ) yesterday.

The two volunteers were recognized for their exemplary dedication, courage and valuable assistance rendered to the police in the recovery of 6.979 kilograms of Methamphetamine in a case registered under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

On 16/01/2026, during jungle foot patrolling near Pagla Mundi under the jurisdiction of PS Hut Bay, they played a pivotal role in detecting and recovering 6.979 kilograms of Methamphetamine concealed beneath sand and dry foliage in dense forest terrain.

Notably, this marks the first instance



of members from a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG) being inducted into active field operations and contributing to a major narcotics seizure. Their familiarity with the local terrain, keen observation, and active participation significantly aided the detection and recovery of the concealed contraband.

Their timely support and involvement reflect the growing strength of inclusive and community-integrated policing in the Islands, further reinforcing the commitment of Andaman & Nicobar Police towards making the Islands drug-free.

Two demonstrations under ATMA on balanced feeding & silage making held at VK Pur & RK Pur

Earlier, on Feb. 21, two additional demonstrations were organised at Harminder Bay and Netaji Nagar in the fields of Shri Lamson and Shri Goutham Roy, respectively, on deworming and vaccination in poultry, and integrated fish pond with duck rearing. 
