Cabinet approves modification/addition of features/ provisions in the ongoing Central Sector Scheme of PMFBY & RWBCIS for its implementation

New Delhi, Jan. 1(PIB)

The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today approved continuation of the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana and Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme till 2025-26 with an overall outlay of Rs.69,515.71 Crore from 2021-22 to 2025-26. The decision will help in risk coverage of crops from non-preventable natural calamities for farmers across the country till 2025-26.

In addition to the same, for large scale technology infusion in implementation of the scheme leading to i n c r e a s i n g transparency and claim calculation and settlement, the Union Cabinet has also approved creation of Fund for Innovation and Technology (FIAT) with a corpus of Rs.824.77 Crore.

The fund will be utilised towards f u n d i n g t e c h n o l o g i c a l initiatives under the scheme namely, YES-TECH, WINDS, etc as well as Research and Development studies.

Yield Estimation System using Technology (YES-TECH) uses Remote Sensing Technology for yield estimation with minimum 30% weightage to Technology based yield estimates. 9 Major States are c u r r e n t l y i m p l e m e n t i n g (namely AP, Assam, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, MP, Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu & Karnataka). Other States are also being o n - b o a r d e d expeditiously. With w i d e r implementation of YES-TECH, Crop Cutting Experiments and related issues will be gradually phased out. Under YES-TECH Claim calculation and settlement has been done for 2023-24. Madhya Pradesh has adopted 100% technology based yield estimation.

Weather Information and Network Data Systems (WINDS) envisages setting up Automatic Weather Stations (AWS) at block level and Automatic Rain Gauges (ARGs) at panchayat level. Under WINDS, 5 times increase in current network density is envisaged to develop hyper local weather data. Under the initiative, only data rental costs are payable by Central and State Governments. 9 Major States are in the process of i m p l e m e n t i n g WINDS (namely Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Puducherry, Assam, Odisha, Karnataka, Uttarakhand & Rajasthan are in progress), while other States have also expressed willingness to implement.

WINDS could not be implemented by States during 2023-24 (1st year as per EFC)

Indian Navy to commission three indigenously built warships on Jan. 15

New Delhi, Jan. 1

Indian Navy is set to commission three indigenously built warships Nilgiri, Surat and Vaghsheer on 15th of this month at Naval Dockyard, Mumbai. Commissioning of these three Combatant platforms will provide a significant boost to the Indian Navy's combat r e a d i n e s s , demonstrating the country's unparalleled progress in defense self-reliance and indigenous shipbuilding.

The warship Nilgiri is equipped with stealth features and state-of-the-art technologies. The Surat features s u b s t a n t i a l improvements in design and capabilities. Equipped with modern aviation facilities, Nilgiri and Surat can operate a range of helicopters, during both day and night operations.

Vaghsheer, is one of the most silent and versatile diesel-electric submarines in the world. It is designed to undertake a wide range of missions, including anti-surface warfare, anti-submarine warfare, intelligence gathering, area surveillance, and special operations. Vaghsheer is armed with wire-guided torpedoes, anti-ship missiles, and advanced sonar systems.



According to the Indian Navy, all three platforms have been designed and constructed entirely at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited in Mumbai which is a testament to the country's growing self-reliance.

It also shows the rapid progress made in warship design and construction, cementing the country's position as a global leader in d e f e n s e manufacturing.(Source: newsonair.gov.in)
