Residents urged to utilize the facility for seamless payment of taxes

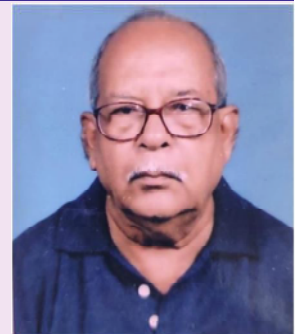
Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 2

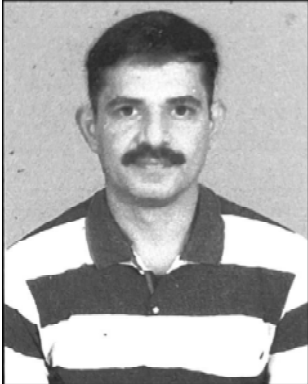

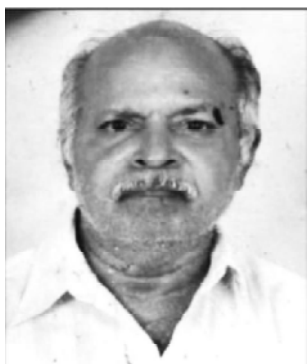
