Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah chairs 7th meeting of the Islands Development Agency (IDA) in New Delhi

New Delhi, Jan. 3 (PIB)

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, chaired the 7th meeting of the Islands Development Agency (IDA) in New Delhi today. The meeting was attended by Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri Praful Patel, Administrator of Lakshadweep, Union Home Secretary, Shri Govind Mohan and Secretaries from various Union Ministries, along with other senior officials.

During the meeting, Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah reviewed the progress of ongoing development initiatives in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep. The Ministry of Home Affairs, Andaman and Nicobar Islands Administration and Lakshadweep Administration made comprehensive presentation on various development projects, including enhancements in digital connectivity, air



connectivity, and port development. Union Home Minister underscored the importance of advancing solar and wind energy initiatives in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and

Lakshadweep. He emphasized achieving the goal of 100% renewable energy generation through solar panels and windmills in these regions. Shri Shah also directed the Union Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) to implement the 'PM Surya Ghar' scheme by installing solar panels in all households across both Island groups.

Shri Amit Shah said that even though these Islands are far from Delhi, they are close to our hearts, development of infrastructure and increasing tourism facilities here is the priority of the Government. Modi Government is preserving the culture and heritage of these Islands and accelerating the development works. He emphasized the need for a holistic approach to infrastructure projects in both Island groups and called on all concerned Central Ministries to collaborate on initiatives related to tourism, trade, and other key sectors. Shri Shah also issued clear directives to address pending issues and expedite the completion of ongoing projects.

'Drill to Thrill': Synchronized musical artistry by Tri-Service Band & Drill Display by Air Warrior Drill Team captivates spectators at Marina
General Public invited to witness spectacular performance at Marina today

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 3 A spectacular performance of synchronized musical artistry by the Tri-Service Band of the Andaman & Nicobar Command and a drill display featuring precision, discipline, and grandeur by Air Warrior Drill Team of the Air Force is being organized at Marine Esplanade (Marina) as part of Island Tourism Festival. The Air Warrior Drill Team displayed rifle handling skills, much to the delight of the gathering present at the Marina. The spectators were awestruck by the rifle drill manoeuvres of the team.

The IAF today is the fourth largest Air Force in the world and a force to reckon with. Operating with state of the art aircraft & equipment, the IAF is



well prepared and eager to meet any challenge that this millennium might offer.

Since drill is an integral part of the military ethos, the formation of an Air Warrior Drill Team (AWDT) to project a dynamic and vibrant image of the IAF was conceived.

Air Warrior Drill Team (AWDT) was formed on 05th Nov, 2004 at Air Force Station, Tambaram in Chennai. AWDT is the

first of its kind among all Military and Para-Military Forces in India as it performs unique advanced drill movements with rifles fixed with live bayonets. AIR Warrior Drill Team performs unique advance drill with 303" rifle with fixed bayonet which weighs about 9 lbs 10 ozs [5.5 kg) and 44.75" in length. Performing with the 5 & half kg 303 rifles with live bayonets demands strict physical regime, hard

work, co-ordination between minds and body.

"There is no Glory in-practice, But without practice, there is no glory".

At present, Indian Air Force has two (30 members each) Air Warrior Drill team namely 'Team Subroto' and 'Team Arjan' which are placed at AFND.

AWDT has come a long way since its first demonstration to the Chief of the Air Staff at C o m m a n d e r s

Conference at Head Quarter Training Command (HQTC) on 27th Nov, 2004.

Till date, AWDT has given more than 282 performances across the span of the county. AWDT has also given its performances in the countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Bhutan and Mauritius.

In a short span of time AWDT has emerged as the pride of the Indian Air Force and has been complimented as the "Ground Ambassador of IAF". The motto of the team is 'Drill to Thrill'.

The general public may visit the Marine Esplanade (Marina) in large numbers to witness these s p e c t a c u l a r performances which begins at 4 pm and continue upto 4.30 pm tomorrow (Jan. 4).
