megapode, crocodile, etc. for a period of 30 years and tribal welfare plans for a period of 50 years. Officers / Representatives of implementing agencies viz. Wildlife Institute of India, Zoological Survey of India, Botanical Survey of India, Salim

Ornithology and Natural History and Indian Institute of Forest Management were also present during the presentation. Biodiversity conservation including species diversity and endemism in the Island and the region have been given due consideration and all efforts will be made for

its protection, conservation and management. The UT Administration is also fully committed to ensure that the interests of the tribal communities living in Great Nicobar Island are safeguarded in the wake of holistic development project, a press release received here said.

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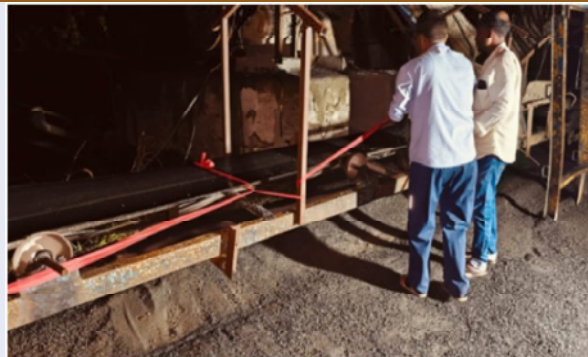
DHS issues guidelines for protection and prevention of winter season related viral respiratory diseases including HMPV

District Administration, SA seals Crusher Unit for violation of legal provisions



Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 9
Acting decisively against unlawful mining activities, the District Administration, South Andaman, has sealed a Stone Crusher Unit in Bimblitan village following the discovery of illegal extraction and transportation of stone boulders.



Previously, a penalty of Rs. 4,90,000/- was imposed under Section 201 (6) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation, 1966, and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Mines and Minerals Rules, 2012, for the illegal extraction and transportation of boulders. However,

the individual has failed to remit the penalty and continues to disregard legal provisions. Further investigations revealed multiple irregularities in the Stone Crusher Unit, prompting its immediate sealing.

The general public have been strongly cautioned against participating in or supporting any illegal mining activities. The

District Administration remains vigilant and resolute in taking strict action against violators to preserve the Islands' natural resources and environment. Hodi Craft: Weaving Nicobar's Heritage into a National Treasure

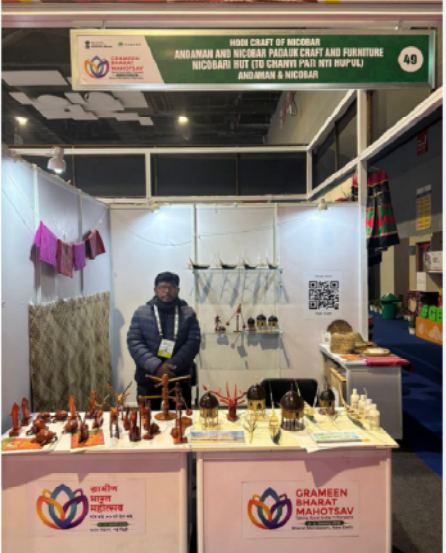

Nazeer wishes to expand Hodi Craft throughout India to spread the artistry and heritage of Nicobar to a wider populace.

This GI registered user is participating in the national Grameen Bharat Mahotsav organized at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi, by NABARD and Department of Financial Services (M/o Finance) from 4th to 9th January, 2025. The Mahotsav, through various discussions, workshops and master classes, aims to enhance rural infrastructure, create self-reliant economies, and foster innovation within rural communities. Its objectives include promoting economic stability and financial security among rural populations, with a special focus on North-East India, by addressing financial inclusion and supporting sustainable agricultural practices.

transmission of various respiratory system-related diseases such as seasonal influenza (H1N1, H3N2) and Influenza-like illness (ILI) and Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) also increases. Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV) comes with the symptoms of a common cold and gets cured automatically within 03 to 05 days, due to which, there is no need for any kind of panic or fear and it is not a new virus or an imminent pandemic threat, seasonal surges are typical. HMPV spreads from person to person through, droplets from coughing or sneezing, close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands, touching contaminated surfaces and then touching the mouth, nose, or eyes etc.

However, as a precaution, it is mandatory to follow the following guidelines for the protection and prevention of all winter season related viral respiratory diseases including Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV): -

Do's	Don't's
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Do not panic: rely on the media reports issued by Govt. Agencies only.Special care should be taken for children, elderly persons and those suffering from any other serious disease.Use a handkerchief/tissue to cover the nose and mouth while sneezing or coughing.Avoid going to crowded places.Keep hands clean with soap and water.Drink plenty of water/fluids and eat nutritious food.If you have symptoms like cold, cough, fever etc., seek medical advice and take medication.If you have symptoms, maintain a safe distance (01 meter at least) from healthy people.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Do not reuse used tissue paper/handkerchief.Avoid shaking hands.Avoid close contact with people with symptoms.Do not take medicine without medical consultation.Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth frequently.Avoid spitting in public places.

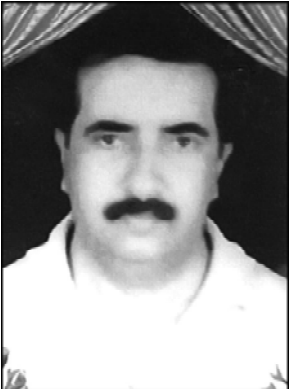
