

Senior citizens aged 70 years & above to get cashless treatment worth Rs 5 lakh under AB-PMJAY

Elderly people enrolled under the scheme to be provided Ayushman Vay Vandana Card

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan.12 Ayushman Bharat -Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is a flagship scheme of Government of India noted as the world's largest health assurance programme. The scheme has now been extended to include all senior citizens across the country into the scheme.

This extended policy aims to provide a cashless treatment worth Rs 5 lakh to all senior citizens, with only eligibility criterion, that the individual must be aged 70 years and above, as determined by the age recorded in their Aadhaar Card, regardless of economic status. The elderly people enrolled under the scheme will be provided Ayushman Vay Vandana Card.

Further, the PMJAY, will be eligible for coverage. Government has clarified


