"India is today recognized as a reliable and responsible partner globally, especially in the Global South", exclaimed the Prime Minister. He emphasized that India operates with a spirit of development, not expansionism. On account of the tax deficiencies and violation of other provisions of the Regulation and Rules, penalty under relevant sections amounting to Rs. 4,89,93,780/- has been imposed on the said Dealers.

The UT Tax Department is committed towards safeguarding the Govt. Exchequer. No violation of the Regulation, Rules and directives shall be tolerated and stringent action under relevant provisions shall be initiated.

Therefore, the registered dealers are once again advised to adhere to the provisions of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Value Added Tax Regulation 2017 and Rules 2020 and other directives issued thereunder, to avoid being penalized, a press release from DC (SA) said.
