Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands expresses concern over scarcity of agricultural land in Andaman

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 2 Andaman and Nicobar Lieutenant Governor Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) on Tuesday expressed concern over the scarcity of land, which is impacting core sectors like agriculture, dairy and animal husbandry in the archipelago.

Speaking at the National Conference on International Year of

Cooperatives-2025 in New Delhi, presided over by the Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, he highlighted the i n d i s c r i m i n a t e conversion of agricultural land in the archipelago to commercial land, resulting in a decrease of 40 per cent of agricultural land.

"The land conversion is adversely impacting agriculture,

agro products, dairy, poultry and animal husbandry sectors that are core segments for cooperatives," he said. Admiral Joshi said that currently, only 2.5 per cent of the land area is left as agricultural land in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

While commending Tribal Development Cooperative Society (TDCS) in ANI, he said,

"It gives me immense pleasure to share a success story of TDCS in Nicobar Islands wherein Virgin Coconut Oil produced by the Nicobarese community was recently granted a G e o g r a p h i c a l Indication (GI) tagging."

Apart from the oil, six other products got the GI tag in the archipelago and "this is

the perfect example of an economic empowerment of people through Cooperation", the Lieutenant Governor said.

He also thanked Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi for including this accomplishment (GI tagging of Virgin Coconut Oil) in his talk show 'Mann Ki Baat'. (This story was published in THE WEEK quoting PTI)

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 2 In a significant step towards eliminating Tuberculosis (TB) from the South Andaman district under the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan, the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, convened a crucial meeting with private medical practitioners today. The meeting aimed to mobilize greater participation from the private healthcare sector in TB notification, patient support and awareness generation.

The DC(SA) emphasized the importance of collaborative action between public and

private stakeholders in eradicating TB and asked to identify the vulnerable populace followed by screening and treatment as per protocol, as envisioned under the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP). The District TB Officer (DTO) briefed the participants about the current TB burden, the targets under the

campaign and the critical role of private practitioners in early detection and reporting

of TB cases.

All private practitioners were urged to enrol on the Ni-kshay portal (<https://nikshay.in>), the Government platform for TB case notification and management. They were also requested to submit daily reports in the prescribed format to the District Control Room. The key

by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE), an organization based in Denmark. It is an eco-label awarded to beaches that meet high standards of cleanliness, environmental sustainability, safety, and accessibility. Currently, India has 12 beaches with this prestigious certification, and the expansion of Blue Flag beaches in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands further aligns with the country's efforts to improve the sustainability of its beach tourism.

Infrastructure Upgrades and Future Growth

As part of its commitment to eco-tourism, the administration is also focused on infrastructure upgrades to enhance the overall visitor experience. The construction of a 500-passenger terminal jetty at Swaraj Dweep is nearing completion. This new facility will not only improve the transport infrastructure but will also contribute to making Swaraj Dweep more accessible to tourists.

Dr. Kumar highlighted, "This new terminal will significantly boost connectivity, allowing more tourists to visit this picturesque island, while simultaneously keeping sustainability and environmental considerations at the forefront of our development plans."

With eco-friendly infrastructure and Blue Flag beaches, Andaman and Nicobar Islands is quickly becoming a standout destination for travelers who value sustainability and natural beauty.

Promoting Cultural Tourism and New Attractions

While eco-tourism remains a core focus, the administration is also working to diversify the region's tourism offerings by promoting cultural tourism. Signature events like the Island Tourism Festival held in December attract thousands of visitors every year. This year, the region is introducing new attractions, including the Coconut Festival and a Book Fair, organized in collaboration with the National Book Trust of India.

Dr. Kumar explained, "We want to offer our visitors more than just the scenic beauty of our beaches. By showcasing our rich cultural heritage, local cuisine, and traditions, we hope to create a more holistic tourism experience that highlights all aspects of life in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands."

These new events will expand the region's cultural tourism appeal, offering visitors a chance to experience everything from indigenous crafts to local food, and immerse themselves in the unique cultural diversity of the islands.

Enhancing Connectivity and Infrastructure

In addition to Swaraj Dweep's new terminal, the Diglipur Airport in North Andaman is expected to open in the coming months. This will allow tourists to access the northern parts of the islands more conveniently. Dr. Kumar further revealed, "We aim to make the airport operational by the next tourist season. This will help facilitate better access to Great Nicobar, the southernmost part of the territory, which has been largely inaccessible to tourists due to its remoteness."

The improved connectivity, along with new airports, will help bolster tourism in previously less-visited regions, ensuring a more equitable distribution of tourism benefits across the islands. As more areas open to visitors, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands are poised to become a more attractive destination for both domestic and international tourists.

Sustainability Measures and Environmental Protection

Sustainability is a key priority for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands administration, with efforts being made to ensure that tourism growth does not come at the expense of the environment. As part of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Clean India Mission), solid waste collection and management have been enhanced in collaboration with local panchayats. The government has also implemented a ban on small plastic bottles (below 2 liters) to reduce plastic waste, a significant contributor to pollution on the islands.

A major initiative led by the Forest Department has resulted in the collection of over 50,000 kg of marine plastic waste in a massive marine clean-up drive. The drive aims to restore the pristine condition of the islands' coastal ecosystems and raise awareness about the impact of plastic waste on marine life.

Dr. Kumar added, "We are committed to environmental stewardship. The marine clean-up drive is just one example of our efforts to protect our natural resources and ensure that tourism does not harm the islands' delicate ecosystems."

On the energy front, the administration is also focusing on sustainable energy solutions. A 50 MW LNG plant is being developed by the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC), which will help meet the growing energy needs of the islands. Additionally, a grid-based energy link between the South and North Andaman is under construction in collaboration with the Power Grid Corporation of India. This project, expected to be completed within the next two years, will improve the power supply across the archipelago and reduce its reliance on imported fuel.

Dr. Kumar concluded, "Sustainability is at the core of everything we do. We are committed to a clean, green future for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, balancing development with environmental conservation."

gov.in and through the Haj Suvidha App, likely by the second week of July 2025.

All individuals intending to perform Haj 2026 through the Haj Committee of India are advised to keep a fund of Rs.1.5 lakh ready for the first installment and to ensure the availability of a valid passport. The following passport-related guidelines must be strictly followed:

- ♦ The passport must be machine-readable.
- ♦ The passport must have validity at least until 31st December, 2026.
- ♦ As per the initial

requirements of the Nusuk Masar Portal for Haj-2026, applicants applying for fresh passports must ensure that the 'Surname/Last Name' field is duly filled and not left blank.

awareness meeting was held on 20th June, 2025 in the Conference Hall of Directorate of Health Services under the chairmanship of Dr. Suja Antony, CMO (NMSG), Director of Health Services/ State Drug Controller with the member of Andaman and Nicobar Chemists and Druggists Association and other local Retail/Wholesale Pharmacy owner regarding measures to prevent and reduce drug abuse to make our UT drug-free.

In this connection, Smti Nalni, Drug Inspector, assisting the Licensing authority in the implementation of various provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, conducted surprise narcotic inspection at private pharmacies of North and Middle Andaman along with officials of Social Welfare Department Mayabunder, PS Rangat, PS Billiground and PS Diglipur on 26th and 27th June, 2025.

Awareness meeting was organized with private pharmacy owners and pharmacists at PS Rangat and PS Diglipur and discussion were held in detail with the stakeholders regarding various conditions of retail drug license. They were advised to ensure proper maintenance of Schedule H & H1 Drug Register, mandatory installations of CCTV camera with backup of minimum 30 days, proper display of the Drug license issued.

The officials also emphasized on section 42(a) of Pharmacy Act, 1948 and Rules 65 of D&C rules, 1945 and advised the stakeholders not to run a pharmacy shop without Pharmacists. The meeting concluded with the 'Anti-Narcotic Pledge'. The general public have been requested, to pass the information to the Health Department over Phone Number 9434266561, if any drug abuse is noticed in and around the retail pharmacy stores, a press release from DD (Medical) said.

symptoms to watch for include fever, cough with mucus, sudden weight loss, night sweats, blood in sputum, chest pain, swelling in the neck or armpits, feeling weak or tired, chronic illness, sudden physical changes, failure to gain weight in children, and decreased activity or playfulness in children.

Additionally, private practitioners were encouraged to register as Ni-kshay Mitras under the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan, adopting TB patients on a voluntary basis to provide comprehensive support. This voluntary support not only strengthens the medical care provided to TB patients but also helps address social and economic challenges, ultimately contributing to better treatment outcomes and the shared goal of a TB-free District.

Furthermore, the DC (SA) urged all clinical establishments to display Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials provided by the District Health Society (DHS). This step is intended to create greater public awareness about TB symptoms, treatment availability and the stigma associated with the disease.

The meeting concluded with a collective commitment from the private sector to support the District Administration's mission-mode activities towards a TB-free South Andaman, a press release from DC, SA said.

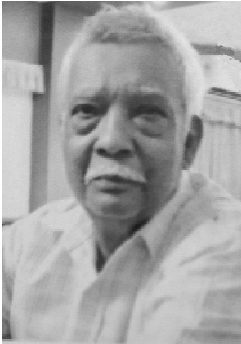

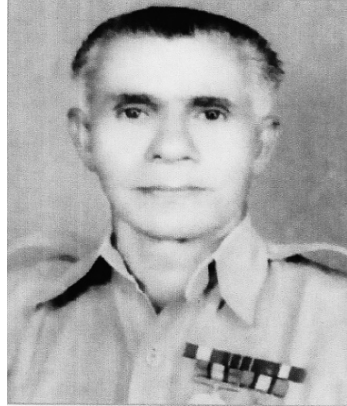
