# Shubhanshu Shukla working to develop brain-computer interface in space

New Delhi, July 3  
Indian Air Force Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla, the first Indian astronaut on the International Space Station, is working to develop a brain-computer interface in the orbital lab. US space agency NASA shared in a blog post that Shukla, who is part of the Axiom Space Mission-4, along with fellow astronaut Slawosz Uznanski-Wisniewski from Poland, partnered together in the Columbus laboratory and studied using near-



infrared technology to record brain activity for constructing brain-computer interfaces.

The experiment called the "Thoughts over Gravity" explored how astronauts can use their

brains to control or communicate with computers in space, even in challenging low-

gravity conditions. Earlier, Shukla worked in the Destiny laboratory module on ISS to understand how tiny aquatic animals survive numerous harsh climates, including microgravity. He also looked at muscle cell stem cultures through a microscope to understand the muscle repair process in weightlessness. Lucknow-born Shukla is on a 14-day scientific expedition on the ISS as part of the Axiom-4 mission, along with three other astronauts from the US, Poland, and Hungary. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

## Legal Metrology Wing conducts special drive against use of tampered weights Fish vendors advised to use only duly verified & stamped weights

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 3  
The Legal Metrology Wing of the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has been actively working towards safeguarding the interest of the consumers against any unfair trade practices. On the early morning of 28.06.2025, the Enforcement Team of the Directorate of CS & CA conducted special enforcement drive in fish markets situated at Junglighat, Mohanpura and Dignabad and

other prominent places around municipal region of Sri Vijaya Puram against the use of tampered & unverified weights by the fish vendors with the intent to deceive the public. During the inspection, certain fish vendors were found using iron weights which were unverified or underweight. Accordingly, the weights and weighing scale were seized on the spot and cases have

been booked against 15 fish vendors for use of such weights which is under process as per the provisions of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and the Rules framed thereunder. All the traders, especially fish vendors have been advised to use only the duly verified & stamped weights and refrain from any unfair practices which may lead to exploitation of consumers failing which, stringent legal

action as deemed fit will be initiated against them as per the provision of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009. Consumers have been requested that any information regarding traders involved in any kind of illegal trade practice may be brought to the notice of the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs in writing or over Toll Free No 18003453197, a press release from Legal Metrology Wing said.

## Traffic Police issues advisory on prohibition on use of pressure horns, multi-tone horns and modified musical horns

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 3  
A & N Traffic Police has appealed to the general public to refrain from the use of pressure horns, multi-tone horns and modified musical horns, which are strictly prohibited under law. The use of such horns is not only illegal but also contributes significantly to noise pollution and public inconvenience. As per Rule 119 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, every motor vehicle

must be fitted with an electric horn or other device that does not produce unduly harsh, shrill, loud, or alarming noise. The use of pressure horns and multi-tone musical horns clearly violates this rule. Vehicles found in violation may also be detained and illegal horns may be seized on the spot with appropriate fines as per law. Pressure and multi-

Her life changed when she attended the Tribal Council meeting, where she learned about the DDU-GKY scheme. After that, she went to Birdline Centre for Unemployment Youth Development Trust (CUYDT) Center in Sri Vijaya Puram, gathered detailed information about the DDU-GKY scheme. She decided to enroll in the General Duty Assistant - Advance training course conducted by the DDU-GKY Project Implementing Agency (PIA) in Namakkal, Tamil Nadu. The training was provided free of cost with boarding and lodging which helped her gain in both technical to know-how soft skills are a required for a career in the healthcare sector. Throughout her journey, the DDU-GKY team at the Directorate of Rural Development played a pivotal role-right from mobilization and counselling to coordinating with training partners, ensuring her smooth transition from the Islands to the mainland training center. Regular monitoring, follow-ups, and mentoring provided by the team ensured that she completed her course and internship successfully. Following her three-month on job training, Ms. Sandhya was placed at Athulya Senior Care, a leading healthcare facility in Bengaluru, where she now earns Rs. 23,800 per month.
