MP meets Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs; submits memorandum pertaining to Islands development

A&N Islands once again achieves remarkable milestone Secures No.1 position fourth time since July, 2023 among UTs in CCTNS PRAGATI Dashboard for May-2024

Port Blair, July 4
In a remarkable feat, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has once again achieved a significant milestone by securing the top position (96.67%) amongst the Union Territories in the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems (CCTNS) PRAGATI Dashboard in the month of May, 2024 for the fourth time since



July, 2023. This system is administered by the National Crime Records Bureau in New Delhi.

The CCTNS is a flagship project of the Ministry of Home Affairs, regularly monitored by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and the Ministry of Home Affairs through the PRAGATI Dashboard on a monthly basis. The CCTNS PRAGATI Dashboard plays a pivotal role in tracking and managing

A distinguished test pilot, he was the induction crew of MiG29K and subsequently commanded INAS303. He has flown from aircraft carriers INS Viraat, INS

Vikramaditya, INS Vikrant and commanded INS Savitri and INS Teg. He was awarded the Vishisht Seva Medal in 2018 for operationalizing MiG29K on Vikramaditya. Subsequently, he tested MiG29K and achieved initial operational clearance of the aircraft on newly inducted carrier INS Vikrant. Coastal Security Stakeholders sensitized on New Criminal Laws

Briefed on significant changes and major amendments introduced by these laws

Port Blair, July 4

The Police Marine Force, A&N Police under the supervision of Smti Varsha Sharma, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police (PMF), along with Ms. Shweta K Sugathan, IPS, SP (PMF) and Shri Ajay Rai, DySP (PMF), organized a special awareness programme on the implementation of new criminal laws. This event, attended by Coastal Security Stakeholders including the Coast Guard, Forest Department, Fisheries Department, and local fishermen was held at Khaitan Kalyan Mandapam on July 1.

The three new Criminal Laws- Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam (BSA) were officially implemented on July 1 in A&N Islands. During the programme, stakeholders were briefed on the significant changes and major amendments



introduced by these laws.

Key changes include: The introduction of Zero FIR, provision for electronic submission of information, mandated free copies of FIRs to both victims and accused individuals.

The programme also highlighted the stricter penalties for sexual offenses, particularly against minors, with increased minimum sentences and enhanced punishments for repeat offenders.

In addition to the informative sessions, a Nukkad Natak was performed by the Police Entertainment Team. This street play effectively conveyed the essence of the new laws and their impact,

making the information more accessible and engaging for all participants.

The awareness programme aimed to strengthen and improve coordination among Coastal Security Stakeholders and the Fishermen Community, emphasizing the crucial role of information sharing.

During the event, the DIGP (PMF) handed over Commendation Certificates to two fishermen, Shri Ch. Veera Swamy and Shri S.U. Maheshwar Rao, for their valuable information provided to the Marine Police Control Room regarding the sighting of foreign poachers, a press release from SP (PMF) said.
