Andaman & Nicobar set to invite bids for 21 MW solar projects with battery storage

New Delhi, July 5

In a push to green the islands, the UT administration is preparing to float a SECI-backed tender for 21 MW of grid-connected solar power with battery storage, pending final technical and regulatory approvals.

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands may soon invite bids to develop 21 MW of grid-connected solar power plants with battery storage capacity, people aware of the development said.

The move is a part of the greening of the



islands. The tender is likely to be floated by the Union Territory administration and the approval of the lowest discovered

rate could be obtained from the joint electricity regulatory commission.

The UT has asked

the Central Electricity Authority to examine and convey the technical approval prior to obtaining approval

of the competent authority before floating the tender, one of the persons said.

The draft tender document and power purchase agreement were prepared and overseen by Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI), according to the person. SECI, National Institute of Wind Energy in coordination with local authorities carried out a joint feasibility study. (This news article was published in ET Energyworld. Com July 5, 2025)

India ranks among top world's most equal societies: World Bank

New Delhi, July 5

World Bank has placed India among world's Most Equal Societies. According to the World Bank, India's Gini Index stands at 25.5, making it the fourth most equal country in the world, after the Slovak Republic, Slovenia and Belarus. The Gini Index is a simple yet powerful way to understand how income, wealth or consumption is equally distributed across households or individuals in a country.

India falls into the "moderately low" inequality category, which includes Gini



scores between 25 and 30. India is only a fraction away from joining the "low inequality" group, which includes countries like the Slovak Republic with a score of 24.1, Slovenia at 24.3, and Belarus at 24.4. Apart from these three, India has a better score than all the other 167

countries for which the World Bank has released data.

India's score is much lower than China's 35.7 and far lower than the United States, which stands at 41.8.

India's journey towards a more equal society is reflected in its Gini Index over the

Centre urges consumers to use only BIS certified helmets for safety

New Delhi, July 5 (PIB)

The Department of Consumer Affairs, Government of India, and the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) appeal to consumers across the country to use only BIS-certified helmets. Additionally, the Department has called for strict enforcement against the manufacture or sale of helmets without BIS certification.

With over 21 crore two-wheelers on Indian roads, rider safety is paramount. While wearing a helmet is mandatory under the Motor



Vehicles Act, 1988, its effectiveness depends on quality. Sub-standard helmets compromise protection and defeat their purpose. To address this, a Quality Control

Order has been in force since 2021, mandating ISI-marked helmets certified under BIS standards (IS 4151:2015) for all two-wheeler riders.

As of June 2025,

there are 176 manufacturers across India holding valid BIS licenses for protective helmets. The Department has observed that many helmets sold on roadsides lack the mandatory BIS certification, posing significant risks to consumers and numerous fatalities in road accidents. Therefore, there is an urgent need to tackle this issue head-on.

To enforce quality standards, BIS conducts regular factory and market surveillance. In the last

General public requested to support this initiative by remaining vigilant and reporting any violations at District Control Room over Ph. No. 03192-240127 / 238881 / 1070 or send WhatsApp message to 9531888844. The identity of informants will be kept confidential

The Revenue Officials have been instructed to clearly demarcate a yellow line at a distance of 100 yards from the outer boundary of all educational institutions, marking the designated no-tobacco zone as per

COTPA guidelines. They have also been directed to conduct regular field inspections and take strict action against violators operating within the prohibited area.

Furthermore, the District

Administration has categorically prohibited the presence of any shops or vendors selling cigarettes or other tobacco products within the demarcated 100-yard radius of educational institutions.

These measures are a part of the Administration's wider campaign to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco, particularly among the youth, and

financial year, over 500 helmet samples were tested and more than 30 search-and-seizure operations were carried out for misuse of the BIS Standard Mark.

In a bid to enhance road safety and protect consumers from substandard helmets, the Department of Consumer Affairs had written to District Collectors (DCs) and District Magistrates (DMs) to launch a nationwide campaign targeting manufacturers and retailers who sell non-compliant helmets for two-wheeler riders. This initiative was a response to the growing concerns over the quality of helmets available in the market and their critical role in safeguarding lives on the road.

The Department of Consumer Affairs underscores the Government's commitment to consumer protection and road safety. By removing sub-standard helmets from the market, the Department aims to prevent avoidable road accident fatalities and promote high-quality safety gear.
