Department has provided essential items viz Medicine Balls (help for rehabilitation and strength training), Leg Massagers (help for alleviating leg pain and discomfort), Yoga Mats (cushioning and support for painful joints, give stability and balance, reduce the risk of strain or injury), and Air



Mattresses (help avoid skin breakdown by promoting blood flow and stimulating circulation in the body).

Additionally, a music system has been provided for listening to devotional songs, entertainment, and yoga classes, and a projector for watching movies twice a week and for educational purpose has also been provided. These provisions are designed to address a variety of health concerns and foster an overall sense of well-being among the residents.

Shri Dilli Rao, an inmate of the Old Age Home at Ferrargunj, excitedly shared his experience stating that "I live at Ferrargunj's Old Age Home. I'm happy to share that my body feels much better ever since we received the leg massage facility. I don't have any trouble walking now, and I sleep exceptionally well after using the leg massager. I use it twice a day and it has significantly reduced my leg pain, leaving me feeling very relaxed." He extended his gratitude to the Directorate of Social Welfare for providing these essential pieces of equipment.

improved rural infrastructure and empowered marginalized communities. It has significantly contributed to livelihood security and reducing poverty in rural areas.

Smt. M. Janagi Savuriyammal, Case Worker, One Stop Centre, briefed the participants on the genesis of MGNREGA and its objectives. The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005, earlier known as the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (NREGA), aims to provide at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment in a financial year to adult members of any rural household willing to do unskilled manual work related to public projects. She stressed on the implementation structure of MGNREGA, eligibility criteria to avail the benefits of the Act, the procedure to apply, and the fixation of wages under MGNREGA.

Smt. Vijaylaxmi, Ombudsman, South Andaman, briefed the participants on the ten entitlements under MGNREGA, such as the right to get a job card, the right to demand work and get it, the right to an unemployment allowance, the right to plan, the right to obtain work within a 5 km radius of the village, the right to work facilities, the right to said. receive wages within 15 days, the right to compensation for delayed wage payment, the right to time-bound redressal of grievances, and the right to conduct concurrent social audits.

Administrator, OSC, briefed the participants on the objectives of the One Stop Centre Scheme. The Scheme provides emergency and nonemergency services under one roof to combat all forms of violence against women. Through phased counseling, the One Stop Centre offers strategies to deal with various problems and helps women establish favorable relationships with their families. The program was attended by homemakers, SHG members, and the public, a press release from Director Deputy Education Officer, Rangat, Assistant Director, Agriculture and (SW) said.

Federation of India (NAFED) and Consumer Cooperative Institutions will also procure 4 types of Pulses at 100 per cent MSP. He said that we should promote 'Cooperation among Cooperative' institutions. He said that if we Port Blair, July 6 do all the economic transactions of the cooperative sector within the cooperative sector itself, then we will not need to bring a single penny from outside the cooperative sector. The Minister of Cooperation urged National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) and all the State Cooperative Banks across the country that every Primary Agriculture Credit Society (PACS) and other Cooperative Institutions should open their account in the District Cooperative Bank or State Cooperative informed to attend Bank, which will not only strengthen the cooperative sector but will also increase capital and confidence.

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation said that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has given the slogan of 'Sahkar se Samriddhi' to the cooperative sector of the country. He said that in the last 10 years, Prime Minister Modi emancipated 30 crore people from poverty and freed them of their worries of daily needs. He said that PM Modi has Pool, Near Netaji Assistant Secretary provided facilities like house, electricity, toilet, drinking water, 5 kg free food grains and gas cylinder to crores of poor people of the country. Shri Shah said that now these crores of poor people want to contribute to the development of the country but they do not have capital. He said that the only way to contribute to the development of the country and to develop oneself without capital is cooperation. Shri Shah said that the only objective Port Blair, July 6 behind the mantra of 'Sahkar se Samriddhi' given by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is to bring confidence, happiness and prosperity in the lives of these 30-crore people who are backward even after 75 years of independence.

Shri Amit Shah said that the Union Ministry of Cooperation has taken many important steps for the cooperative sector. He said that the Government has set a target that there should not be any State or district in the country where there is not a viable district cooperative bank and a viable district milk producer union. He said that only by doing this we will be able to expand the cooperative sector and make every rural and poor person prosperous. Shri Shah said that for this we have envisioned a Cooperative Panchayat. He said that even today there are 2 lakh Panchayats in the country where there is not a single cooperative institution. He said that we have set a target that in the next 5 years we will work to create multipurpose PACS in these two lakh Panchayats. Shri Shah said that the Government has also made model bylaws for PACS and despite PACS being a state subject, every State from Kashmir to Kanyakumari and Assam to Dwarka has accepted these model bylaws. Shri Shah said that the Government has also worked towards making PACS multi-purpose and today, out of 65,000 functional PACS in the country, 48,000 have taken initiatives towards becoming viable by adding some new activity to

Shri Amit Shah called upon the workers of the cooperative sector concluding remarks and experience stating that that we must have a common across the country and asked them to make cooperatives a strong pillar of the country's economy. He said that we not only have to make cooperatives a strong pillar but also work to instil facilities, prosperity and selfconfidence in the lives of crores of poor people of the country through this sector. Shri Shah expressed confidence that on the day when International Day of Cooperatives will be celebrated in 2029, there will not be a single Panchayat in the country where there will not be a PACS. He said that we all have to come together to make Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's dream come true and take cooperatives forward to serve the poor.
