Minimum Rates of Wages across Six Schedules of Employments revised; effective from July 1, 2025

The Lieutenant Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands has revised the Minimum Rates of Wages across 6(Six) Schedules of Employments in addition to Govt. Departments / Offices/Industrial Establishments as mandated under the provisions of Minimum Wages Act, 1948 in the UT of A & N Islands w.e.f. 1st July, 2025. The Revised Rates of Minimum Wages are as under:

Category of employee	Minimum wage per day
Unskilled	647.00
Semi-Skilled/Unskilled Supervisory	728.00
Skilled/Clerical	851.00
Highly Skilled	934.00

been requested to comply with the revised rates, failing which, punitive action as per the provisions of Minimum Wages Act, 1948 and its Rules made thereunder shall be initiated, a press release from Labour Commissioner & DET said.

Enhancing rural connectivity State Transport Bus service to Ganesh Nagar & Shantinagar Villages of Diglipur inaugurated

Diglipur, July 8

In a landmark step towards enhancing rural connectivity and ensuring access to essential services, the first-ever State Transport Bus Service was inaugurated today for the remote villages of Ganesh Nagar and Shantinagar in Diglipur Tehsil. The inaugural run of the service was flagged off by Shri Kamaleshwar Rao S, IAS, Assistant Commissioner, Diglipur, in the presence of Pramukh, Panchayat Samiti, Diglipur, local PRI members, and members of the



general public.

Ganesh Nagar and Shantinagar were notified as de-reserved blocks in 2002. However, for over two decades, the absence of proper road infrastructure and public transport connectivity had severely constrained mobility for the residents, particularly for school-going children enrolled in higher secondary schools in Diglipur, located approximately 40 km away. During the meeting chaired by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration on 27th June, 2025, in the presence of the Secretary (Rural Development), Secretary (Transport) and senior officials,

the issue was prominently raised by the Pradhan, GP G and h i n a g a r . Acknowledging the urgency of the matter, the Administration took swift and decisive action.

As a result, within a short span of time, the State Transport Department commenced a dedicated bus service to these villages, marking a significant milestone in bridging the connectivity gap.

Speaking at the inauguration, the Assistant Commissioner, lauded the efforts of

The resolution time for a complaint shall ordinarily be 45 days from its receipt. The Director of Health Services / State Drug Controller has been designated as the First Appellate Authority, and the Secretary (Health), A & N Administration, shall be the Second Appellate Authority for unresolved grievances.

Billiground (2 camps, 31 cattle), Diglipur (11 camps, 257 cattle), Kadamtala (1 camp, 32 cattle), Nabagram (7 camps, 135 cattle), Rangat (2 camps, 17 cattle), Sitanagar (3 camps, 61 cattle), and Webi (2 camps, 125 cattle). Veterinarians provided immediate on-site treatments to address reproductive disorders, health issues, and nutritional deficiencies, ensuring prompt care for the animals. These interventions aim to minimize production losses, enhance fertility, and improve the economic conditions of farmers reliant on livestock for their livelihoods.

The camps focused on educating farmers about effective reproduction management practices to optimize herd productivity and milk yields. Participants were informed about the critical role of timely heat detection and Artificial Insemination (AI) in achieving higher conception rates. Veterinary experts emphasized that precise timing of AI, coupled with regular monitoring, significantly improves reproductive outcomes. Farmers were also advised to provide balanced feed regimens, incorporating green fodder, mineral mixture supplements, and adequate nutrition to correct negative energy balance, a common cause of infertility in cattle. Specific recommendations were also made.

Beside immediate treatments, the camps served as a vital platform for knowledge transfer, equipping farmers with modern animal husbandry techniques. Interactive sessions were held, in which, farmers were encouraged to adopt these practices to boost productivity and reduce economic losses due to reproductive inefficiencies.

The Department plans to continue these camps to reach additional villages, ensuring that remote communities in North and Middle Andaman have access to essential veterinary services and resources, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.
