Leptospirosis is a bacterial disease that can increase after hurricanes or floods when people may have to wade through contaminated water or use it for drinking or bathing.

People can get leptospirosis when they have contact with:

- urine from infected animals, which include rodents, dogs, livestock, pigs and wildlife.
- floodwater, freshwater like rivers or streams, unsafe tap water, wet soil, or food contaminated with the urine of infected animals.

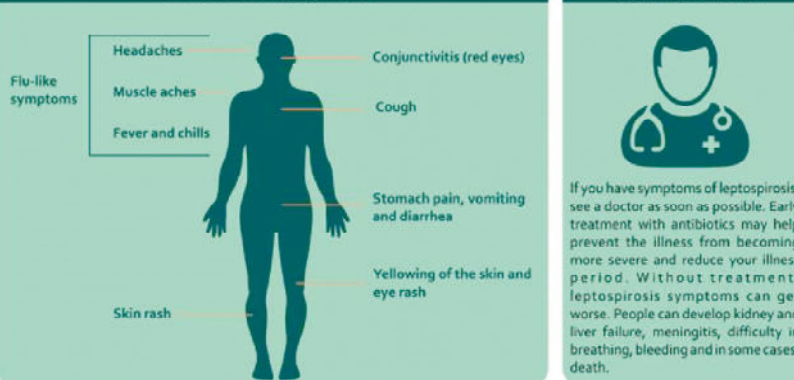

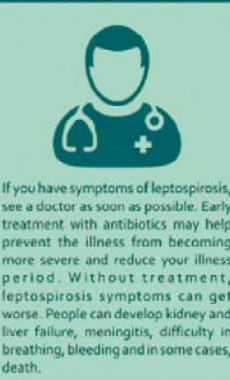

Justice served in Billiground murder case

Mayabunder, July 10

A significant verdict has been upheld by the Hon'ble High Court, bringing closure to a heinous murder case that shook the community in Billiground. On 06/03/2021, a shocking incident was reported at PS Billiground, where a caller informed the Police that Neel Ratan Mridha had brutally attacked his wife with a machete, resulting in her instant death.

The Police promptly registered an FIR vide No. 14/21 dated 06/03/2021 U/s 302 IPC and

apprehended the accused, Neel Ratan Mridha, 34, S/o Shri Niranjan Mridha, R/o Jaipur, Billiground. The case was diligently investigated by Sub-Inspector Madhab Halder, the then SHO of PS Billiground, who worked tirelessly to gather evidence and build a strong case.

The trial at the Hon'ble Court of Additional District Session, Mayabunder, resulted in the conviction of the accused, and he was sentenced to life imprisonment for the remainder of his natural life. The accused appealed

against the conviction to the Hon'ble High Court, which has now upheld the lower Court's verdict on 09/07/2024.

The unwavering commitment to justice by SI Madhab Halder has been instrumental in ensuring that the perpetrator is held accountable for his heinous crime. This verdict serves as a testament to the dedication of the law enforcement agencies in pursuit of justice and the safety of the citizens, a press release from SP N&MA said.

In compliance of section 25 of the Water (Prevention and control of pollution) Act 1974, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board/Committee, establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

As per the section 21 of the Air (Prevention and control of pollution) Act 1981, subject to provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board/Committee, establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

It is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent to Establish (CTE) from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) before establishment of the industry and also to obtain Consent to Operate (CTO) after establishment of unit. Non-compliance of this is the violation of the provisions made under the Water (Prevention and control of pollution) Act 1974, Air (Prevention and control of pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Therefore, it is informed to all the stake holders and general public that it is statutory responsibility of all the industries or units to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry & CTO after establishment in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE & CTO using the URL:www.anocmms.nic.in for the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Air(Prevention and control of pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Any industrial unit which are operating the activity without obtaining CTE and CTO from ANPCC are liable for taking strict action against the industrial units/firms as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

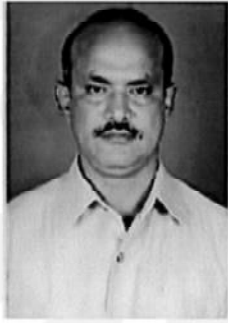

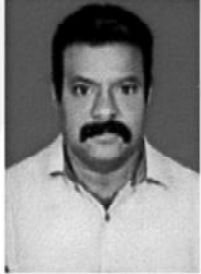
