India first country to launch a Traditional Knowledge Digital Library: WHO

New Delhi, July 12 (PIB) In a significant milestone for global healthcare innovation, the World Health Organization (WHO) has released a technical brief titled "Mapping the Application of Artificial Intelligence in Traditional Medicine", acknowledging India's pioneering efforts in integrating Artificial Intelligence (AI) with traditional medicine systems, particularly Ayush systems. The release follows India's proposal on the subject, leading to the

development of WHO's first-ever roadmap for applying AI in traditional medicine. India's efforts to harness the potential of Artificial Intelligence (AI) to advance and amplify the strengths of its Ayush systems reflect the broader vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, who seeks to position the country as a global leader in digital health innovation and the integration of traditional medicine. Speaking at the inauguration of the

Global Partnership on Artificial Intelligence (GPAI) Summit in 2023, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Modi remarked, "We have developed government policies and programmes inspired by the spirit of 'AI for all'. Ayush systems and through pioneering digital platforms such as the SAHI portal, NAMASTE portal, and the Ayush Research Portal-India is not only safeguarding its centuries-old medical wisdom but also leading the way in shaping a future of personalised, evidence-based, and globally accessible healthcare." concepts of good touch and bad touch, and explained the working mechanisms and implementation of the POSH Act to ensure a safe and dignified workplace for women.

Shri Rashid Alam, Member Secretary of A&N SLSA, also addressed the gathering and explained the objectives and key provisions of POCSO Act, which provides for stringent punishment for sexual offences against children and mandates child-friendly procedures during investigation and trial. He further highlighted the POSH Act, emphasizing the legal obligations of every workplace to constitute Internal Complaints Committees, provide a safe environment free from harassment, and take prompt action on complaints. He stressed that awareness and timely reporting are essential to protect the rights of victims and uphold the rule of law.

Ms. Tasneem Abid, Learned Special Public Prosecutor, spoke in detail about the sensitive handling of POCSO victims, emphasizing the importance of creating a supportive environment, maintaining empathy, and ensuring that girl children are kept in safe custody and protective care. She highlighted the responsibilities of all stakeholders-including police officers, medical professionals, and welfare authorities-to protect the rights and dignity of minor victims at every stage of the process.

Shri Niyaz Alam, Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge and Special Judge for POCSO cases, explained the special procedures prescribed under the POCSO Act to maintain the privacy and confidentiality of victims, including in-camera proceedings, restrictions on media reporting, and strict prohibitions on disclosing the identity of the child victim. He underscored the importance of a victim-centric approach to investigation and trial and the need to create a safe space to reduce trauma and ensure access to justice.

Shri Samrat Roy, Secretary, DLSA, also highlighted the various initiatives of the Legal Services Authorities, including free legal aid services, victim compensation schemes, and the NALSA SAATHI campaign, which focuses on Aadhaar registration, legal identity, and the empowerment of destitute children through access to welfare entitlements and protection under child welfare laws.

The programme concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Shri R. Someswar Rao, Councillor, Haddo Ward No. 2, who appreciated the efforts of the Legal Services Authorities in spreading legal awareness and strengthening community welfare, a press release from Member Secretary, A&N State Legal Services Authority said.

Dr. Anwar Moosa, District TB Officer and TB programme lead in the district, provided detailed guidance on screening strategies, case identification and Nikshay enrolment. The session focused on both Passive Case Finding (PCF) at the health facility level and Active Case Finding (ACF) through community outreach. Participants were trained on identifying high-risk individuals such as TB contacts, PLHIV, malnourished children, diabetics, elderly, and immunocompromised persons, and on the proper use of diagnostic tools like Chest X-ray and NAAT. Emphasis was placed on follow-up mechanisms, repeat screening every six months, and alternate plans for remote populations.

All Assistant Commissioners (ACs) of the three blocks participated in the training and assured supportive supervision and coordination at the block level. They committed to mobilizing resources and facilitating the smooth conduct of the TB elimination campaign, even in the district's most remote areas, a press release from District TB Centre (NTEP), BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar said.


