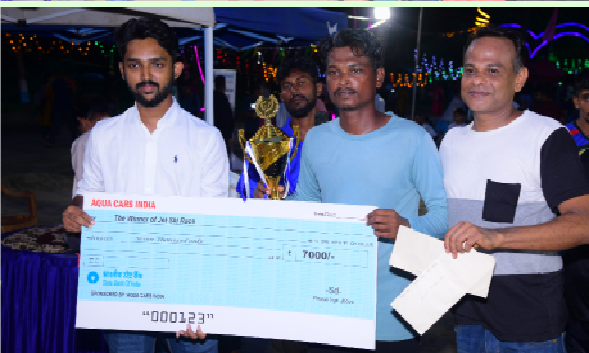

Anti-Narcotics Police Station seizes 655 grams of ganja; one accused arrested

Port Blair, July 14 In a continued and determined effort to combat drug-related activities, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station executed a successful Anti-Narcotics operation on July 12, 2024. Acting on specific intelligence inputs, a dedicated Police Team from the Anti-Narcotics Police Station, led by SI Mohd Rahil Islam, Anti-Narcotics Police Station carried out this operation which included PC Ratan Das, PC M. Raja Rao, PC Vishal and IPC Nandita Mistry. The operation was conducted under the overall leadership of Shri Vishesh Dhatteval, Dy.SP, Narcotics.

The team intercepted Smti Bhagabati Mistry, W/o Shri Prohlad Mistry, 45, R/o Kumirmari Kachani Para, Kumimari Narendrapur Basanli, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743378, currently residing at Hutbay No. 22, South Andaman. Bhagabati Mistry had arrived in Port Blair from Kolkata on July 12, 2024, via an Air India flight. She was found in possession of 655 grams of Ganja, which was clandestinely concealed in her trolley bag. The contraband was seized, and the accused lady was arrested on the spot after observing all codal formalities as per Bharatiya Nagarik

Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. She was later released on bail.

A case under relevant sections of the NDPS Act, 1985 has been registered at the Anti-Narcotics Police Station and further investigation is currently under progress. The raid took place under the overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID), A&N Islands, a press release from SP (CID) said.

Nicobar Chess Association (ANCA). Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman), was the chief guest at the closing ceremony while Shri. Harminder Singh, Director, Tribal Welfare and Shri Ch. Venkatesh, Principal, ITI, Dollygunj, were the guests of honour. They gave away the prizes to the winners.

A record-breaking turnout of 330 chess players in the age group of 4 to 68 years participated with great enthusiasm. This is by far the largest chess tournament in the history

of A&N Islands, including the participation from all the three districts of A & N Islands.

The championship was played over two days in 9 rounds in Swiss format with a time control of 25 minutes + 10 seconds increment per player from the first move, from which R Kashthuri Bhai emerged as the A & N State Chess Champion for the year 2024, scoring 8.5 points from 9 rounds and remained unbeaten in the championship. Comdnt. A K S Srimananaryana, who scored 8 points from 9 rounds, secured the

runners-up trophy. ACM Dinakar M A secured the third place with 7.5 points from nine rounds, while AFM Yashwant V and D Shrestha Vijay finished fourth and fifth respectively with 7.5 points.

The top 4 players will represent the A & N Islands in the 61st National Chess Championship 2024 to be held in Haryana in August 2024.

A&N Police issues public advisories on Fraudsters sending Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime

Port Blair, July 14 A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters send Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime. Fraudsters place online advertisements claiming that they can give jobs where one can make large amount of money working from home with little time and effort. A job scam occurs when a fraudster poses as an employer or recruiter, and offers attractive employment opportunities, which require job seekers to pay some money in advance. The SMSs sent by fraudsters offer high-paying part-time

jobs to siphon off victims' money and their personal information.


In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard oneself:

- Avoid tempting job offers sent via text messages or emails by unknown senders.
- Scrutinize the job offering company online (use words like "scam," "fraud," or "complaint" with company name to online search 8s verify if similar scams are happening).
- Avoid making any payment


without authenticating the employer for registration or other purposes.

- Securitize the SMS-Headers to confirm the authenticity of a job offer.
- Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize properly, if a request seems too urgent.
