Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency today inaugurated the first batch of Sub Officer Training Course to be held at State Training Centre, Sri Vijaya Puram, recognized by the National Fire Service College (NFSC), Nagpur.

This event marks a significant achievement for the Union Territory of A&N Islands, as the training centre has received its first-ever official recognition from National Fire Service College (NFSC), Nagpur. With this accreditation, the State Training Centre (STC) has become the

ANPCC calls for Strict Compliance with E-Waste Rules to Protect A&N Islands' Fragile Ecosystem

Residents, Institutions, and Businesses urged to follow E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2022

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 15
The Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) has issued an advisory to all residents, institutions, and commercial establishments regarding the proper handling and disposal of electronic waste (e-waste) in accordance with the provisions of the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2022, notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India.



Consequently, all e-waste generated in the territory needs to be collected through approved channels and transported to authorized treatment, storage, and disposal facilities located in the mainland. This process shall be regulated under the manifest system as prescribed in E - W a s t e

(Management) Rules, 2022 to ensure transparency and traceability. In light of this, bulk consumers, Government departments and businesses operating in A&N Islands must ensure they engage only with EPR-compliant producers



and collection agencies, and should not rely on unregistered service providers or unauthorized handlers for disposal of electronic waste. The public is encouraged to actively support enforcement by reporting any instances of illegal e-waste collection. (Contd. on last page)

The program was graced by Smti. Padmawati, Pramukh, Panchayat Samiti, Ferrargunj, as the chief guest, with Shri. A. Rajan, Panchayat Samiti member, and other Panchayat Raj Institution (PRI) members of Gram Panchayat Ferrargunj in attendance.

Dr. Satish Kumar, Senior Veterinary Officer (SVO), explained the principles of natural farming and detailed the preparation procedures for Jeevamrut and Neemastra. Dr. Sunita Roy, SVO, highlighted the Department's initiatives to promote natural farming. Dr. Subhash B. Palve, SVO, urged farmers to rear at least one cow or buffalo to meet household milk needs. Shri. Ravi Sutradhar, Agriculture Officer, elaborated on the ingredients and methods for preparing Neemastra and Jeevamrut.

The program concluded with a demonstration on the preparation of Jeevamrut and Neemastra. Each farmer received 2 litres of Jeevamrut prepared at the Livestock Farm Complex, Dollygunj, and the Agriculture Department distributed Neemastra to all participants. Farmers actively engaged, raising queries that were addressed during the session. Smti. Padmawati commended the joint effort of the Departments, noting its relevance, and encouraged participants to adopt natural farming practices. She also requested more such training programs in other Panchayats, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

Indian Astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla, Axiom-4 crew safely return to Earth from Space Station

New Delhi, July 15

Indian astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla and three other crew members of Axiom-4 mission safely returned to Earth after their 18-day historic mission aboard the International Space Station. The SpaceX Dragon spacecraft splashed down in the Pacific Ocean off the coast of San Diego in California this afternoon. The crew will now undergo a seven-day rehabilitation program to adjust to Earth's gravity.

Axiom-4 mission's space odyssey began on 25th of last month when the Falcon-9 rocket carrying the Dragon space capsule blasted off from Florida towards the



International Space Station.

Group Captain Shukla is the first Indian to visit the International Space Station (ISS) and the second Indian astronaut after Wing Commander Rakesh Sharma, who went to space in 1984. During his stay aboard the ISS, Shri Shukla conducted seven India-specific microgravity experiments. These

experiments are designed to generate critical data for future planetary missions and long-duration space habitation. On Sunday, NASA's Expedition Crew organised a traditional ceremony for the Axiom-4 crew. Speaking at the farewell ceremony, Shri Shukla described his space journey as truly incredible. one of the leading causes of death among children under five.

The campaign will run from 16th July to 31st August, 2025, with a focus on community mobilization, health worker training, and distribution of key supplies such as ORS (Oral Rehydration Solution) and zinc tablets.

The initiative involves coordinated efforts from ASHAs, ANMs, Anganwadi Workers, and Community Health Officers (CHOs). They will conduct home visits, health talks, and awareness drives in rural and urban areas alike.

During the virtual orientation for field workers, Director of Health Services said that all the deaths due to diarrhoea are preventable and aims to achieve zero death due to childhood diarrhoea. "Every child's life is precious, so, simple timely interventions like ORS, safe drinking water, and handwashing can save thousands of lives." Prepositioning of ORS and zinc in all households with under five children and awareness is created on treatment with ORS and Zinc known as "Do ka dum".

The focus areas of the campaign include strengthening health infrastructure, improving access to clean water and sanitation, enhancing nutritional programs, and promoting hygiene education. The campaign aims to create a holistic approach to managing and preventing diarrhoea, ultimately reducing child mortality and improving overall public health, a press release from DHS said.

waste processing, dismantling or refurbishing to the ANPCC. Informal collection, dismantling, refurbishing or recycling of e-waste is strictly prohibited and constitutes a violation of environmental regulations. Additionally, manufacturers, producers, refurbishers, and recyclers are required to register on the Central Pollution Control Board EPR Portal and fulfill their annual targets for e-waste collection and environmentally sound recycling.

The ANPCC has urged all stakeholders to strictly adhere to the prescribed e-waste guidelines-emphasizing that improper handling can lead to soil contamination, air pollution, and damage to aquatic ecosystems. Community vigilance, alongside consistent compliance by bulk consumers and producers, is essential for effective and sustainable e-waste management. Such collective action is vital to safeguard the fragile and irreplaceable environmental heritage of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from ANPCC said.

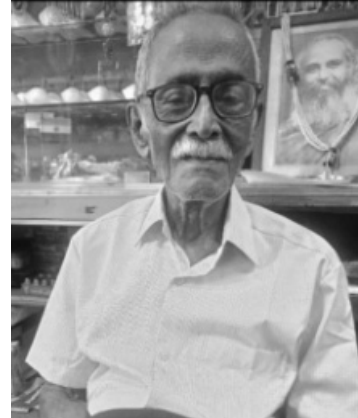
