

## 29<sup>th</sup> round of Foot and Mouth Disease vaccination concludes 8116 animals vaccinated and 1591 buffaloes & cattle tagged in South Andaman

Port Blair, July 15

Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) is a highly contagious and infectious disease of cloven hoofed animals such as cattle, buffaloes, sheep, goats and pigs etc.. Clinical & Visible signs includes high fever (104-106 degree Fahrenheit), loss of appetite and dullness, excessive salivation, vesicles in the mouth especially in the gums and tongue that result in ulcers and wound in the hoof in the inter-digital space, blisters on teats, etc. FMD leads to reduction in milk-yield, decreased growth rate, infertility, etc.

It is mainly transmitted by excretions and secretions from infected animals and mechanically by the movement of animals, persons, vehicles and other things which have been contaminated by the virus. Though the territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands is relatively free from major infectious and contagious disease of Livestock, there had been two outbreaks of FMD in South Andaman i.e. in 2005 and in 2018. There is no treatment for the disease and control is only through vaccination.

The Department of

Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, implements the Centrally Sector Scheme, Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP) under which mass vaccination of cattle and buffaloes are conducted in every six months in a year in order to control the disease in the country. The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, A&N Islands has been conducting vaccination against Foot and Mouth Disease since 2005 onwards. The 29<sup>th</sup> round of Foot and Mouth Disease vaccination among cattle and buffaloes of

South Andaman was carried out during the month of June 2024. A total of 10 vaccination team were formed comprising of Senior Veterinary Officers as Team Leader and Vaccinators and Helpers.

The vaccination teams have to identify the animals by ear tagging and the details of the animals and its owner were uploaded in the Bharat Pashudhan Portal. The vaccination programme was concluded on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 and it was successful in vaccinating 8116 no. of animals and 1591 no. of buffaloes and cattle

Doctors condemn harassment by so called 'media personnel' in Office

Port Blair, July 15

The doctors from DHS, ANIIMS and NHM working in GBPH stand together for the quality of care to all the patients coming to hospital for treatment. Further, they strongly condemn the unauthorized trespassing by some anti social elements, claiming to be media personnel, in the Office of the Director ANIIMS, wherein the DHS and MS GBPH were also present to discuss some treatment and patient care related issues.

On Saturday i.e. 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2024, some anti social elements, claiming to be media personnel came to the

Office of the Director without prior appointment, when the Director was busy in a meeting with DHS and MS i/c for improvisation of health care services in GBPH. The Director's personal staff requested them to refrain from shooting within the Office of the Director, while they refused to cooperate. As the three Officers left the premises of the Office to attend a meeting scheduled in DHS conference Hall at 1.30 PM with the Medical Officers, he along with his camera team tried to stop them and force the camera on their face, repeatedly provoking them to respond,

however the two Directors and MS Incharge GBPH left the Office premises quietly. Further, the Student Council of ANIIMS has also raised concerns about their future and career of their teachers and senior colleagues are allowed to be harassed by the so called media personnel within their Office premises, during duty hours. The Police support had to be sought by the Officers to leave the Office peacefully.

Swift action of PS Ograbraj leads to resolution of murder case in short span of time

Port Blair, July 15

Police Station Ograbraj received a phone call on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2024, at approximately 1855 hours, reporting a murder at Bachra Pahad, Chouldari. The caller indicated that a son had killed his father. Acting swiftly, Police team comprising of SI Devanand Pathak, SHO PS Ograbraj, SIs K.V. Abdul Salam, Agnes Barthloma, HCs Vijay Kumar, Ashok Kr. Roy, PCs Jayanto Biswas, Martin & Abdul Rehman were formed and instantly rushed to the spot. Upon arrival, they encountered the complainant Shri Manas Chakraborty near the location. Manas identified the deceased inside the house as his father-in-law Narayan Ch. Mondal. Manas stated that his father-in-law regularly visited his brother-in-law Pawan Ch. Mondal, who lived alone at Bachra Pahad to bring him food. On 14/07/2024, Narayan Ch. Mondal left with food at around 1000 to 1030 hrs but did not return home by 1600

hrs. Subsequently, he searched for his father-in-law and eventually returning to Pawan's house with a friend around 1830 hrs. They found that the door was closed and when Pawan didn't respond to calls Manas pushed the door and saw Narayan was found inside and blood was oozing around his face and blood-stained stick is lying nearby his body.

Subsequently, case has been registered at PS Ograbraj vide FIR No. 43/24 dated 14/07/2024, U/s 103(1) BNS 2023. On 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2024, the investigation was intensified with the involvement of the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) team and the Executive Magistrate. A thorough examination and inquest were conducted at the scene, and key evidence was meticulously collected.

During the investigation, Pawan Ch. Mondal was interrogated and confessed to the crime. He was subsequently arrested, displaying

swift and effective action by the police team of PS Ograbraj. This highlights their dedication to duty and professional competence.

Further investigation is ongoing to ascertain the full details of the incident. The meticulous operation exemplifies the commitment of the South Andaman Police in addressing serious crimes. The entire operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Vishesh Dhatterwal, SDPO Bambooflat (In-charge), and the overall supervision of Smti. Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District.
