

- 3. Correct identification of Wildlife article will carry 01 mark each.

- 1. The candidates are requested to collect the admit card from the Office of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Haddo from 20th July, 2025 to 20th August,2025 on office hours.
- 2. The Candidates who are unable to collect the admit card, in person, can get it through an authorized person witha letter address to the DCF, Wildlife, Haddo indicating the name, Adhaar card number and phone number of the recipient duly signed by the candidate. The authorization letter should have three (03) specimen signature of the recipient. The Adhaar card copy of the candidate and the recipient should be enclosed with the
- 3. The candidates shall make their own arrangement to reach the venue at the reporting time and no TA/DA will be paid for attending the trade test.
- 4. Use of mobile phone or any other electronic gadgets will be strictly prohibited at the venue during the Trade Test.
- 5. No change in the date, time and venue of trade test shall be allowed for any candidate under any circumstances. If the candidate fails to attend the trade test, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested for the test and his/her candidature will be summarily rejected/cancelled at that stage itself and no further communication will be made.
