participants experienced organic farming practices and



**Test I- Filling of Polybags with provided soil**

- The candidates will have to fill the soil in the provided polybags (up to top), as per the standard filled polybags displayed at the site of the test for the candidates
- 01 mark is assigned for filling each polybag and accordingly the total number of polybags which are properly filled will be marked for grading.
- Half/ partially filled polybags will not be accepted for marking  
(Note: Provisioning of soil polythene bags for the test will be made at the site of Trade Test to each candidate by the Department)

**Test II- Making of stick from the coconut leaves**

- The candidates will have to peel and make 20 numbers of sticks out of the 30 numbers of coconut leaves provided to them for making broom using the knife.
- The sticks should be as per the standard of coconut leaf sticks displayed at the site of the test for the candidates.
- Each stick peeled out as per the standard stick displayed will carry 01 mark.
- Half/ partially/improper split leaves will not be accepted for marking  
(Note: Provisioning of coconut leaves, knives for peeling for the test will be made at the site of trade test to each candidate by the department.)

**Test III- Making Bamboo chatai / Mat**

- The candidates will have to make one bamboo chatai/mat of size 2m X 1m with the given number of bamboos.
- The chatai/mat has to be made as per the standard chatai/mat displayed at the site of the test for the candidates.
- Marks will be assigned step-wise till completion of the task. The distribution of marks will be explained to the candidates during the briefing of the activity.  
(Note: Provisioning of bamboos and other tools required for the test will be made at the site of trade test to each candidate by the department.)

**Test IV- Identification of Wildlife Articles**

- The candidates will have to identify 15 numbers of Wildlife articles kept in the test.
- Such identification of wildlife article has to be done in the provided sheet.
- Correct identification of Wildlife article will carry 01 mark each.

**NOTE:**

- The candidates are requested to collect the admit card from the Office of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Haddo from 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 to 20<sup>th</sup> August,2025 on office hours.
- The Candidates who are unable to collect the admit card, in person, can get it through an authorized person witha letter address to the DCF, Wildlife, Haddo indicating the name,Adhaar card number and phone number of the recipient duly signed by the candidate.The authorization letter should have three (03) specimen signature of the recipient.The Adhaar card copy of the candidate and the recipient should be enclosed with the letter.
- The candidates shall make their own arrangement to reach the venue at the reporting time and no TA/DA will be paid for attending the trade test.
- Use of mobile phone or any other electronic gadgets will be strictly prohibited at the venue during the Trade Test.
- No change in the date, time and venue of trade test shall be allowed for any candidate under any circumstances. If the candidate fails to attend the trade test, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested for the test and his/her candidature will be summarily rejected/cancelled at that stage itself and no further communication will be made.
- In case the trade test of the candidate could not be held on particular day, due to some unforeseen reasons like natural calamity etc., trade test of the candidates fixed on that particular date will be held on a different date and the candidate will be informed separately.
- The candidates will be responsible for their own safety during the trade test and are advised to use the tools provided during the trade test carefully. The Department will not be responsible for any mishap/accident, if any, occur during the course of the trade test. The candidate should make themselves satisfied with their health condition/physical fitness before attending the trade test.
- As per the prescribed Test i.e., Test -I, II, III & IV are to be completed by the candidates as prescribed in the schedule of the trade test..
- In case of tie of marks, candidates with higher age will be given preference.
- Mere participation in trade test does not bestow any claim of the candidate for the appointment to the post of mazdoor.
- All candidates appearing in the trade test will be required to sign an undertaking/declaration prior to participating in the test, which will be provided by the division on the day of test at the venue. Without signing no candidate will be allowed to participate in the trade test.
- Final selection for appointment of candidates to the post of mazdoor in the Industrial Establishment of Wildlife Division, Haddo under the Department of Environment & Forests, Andaman & Nicobar Administration will be based upon the merit secured in the trade test, verification of certificates/testimonials, character and antecedents as well as medical examination from the appropriate authorities.
- Without prejudice in any criminal action, the Wildlife division, Department of Environment & Forests shall take away the candidature of any candidate found indulging in malpractices and his /her candidature shall be summarily cancelled.
- In the Recruitment Rules of Mazdoor vide A &N Gazette Notification No.209 dated 30/04/2010, any dispute, arising out of the said exercise of trade test is subject to the jurisdiction of Dispute Resolution Committee. If any candidate is unsatisfied with the orders of Dispute resolution Committee, he/she may prefer an appeal to Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Haddo whose orders shall be final and binding.
