Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005, earlier known as the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (NREGA), aims to provide at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment in a financial year to adult members of any rural household willing to do unskilled manual work related to public projects. She stressed on the implementation structure of MGNREGA, eligibility criteria to avail the benefits of the Act, the procedure to apply, and the fixation of wages under MGNREGA.

Smti Vijaylaxmi, Ombudsman, South Andaman, briefed the participants on the ten entitlements under MGNREGA, such as the right to get a job card, the right to demand work and get it, the right to an unemployment allowance, the right to plan, the right to obtain work within a 5 km radius of the village, the right to work facilities, the right to receive wages within 15 days, the right to compensation for delayed wage payment, the right to time-bound redressal of grievances, and the right to conduct concurrent social audits.

At the end of the session, Smti Santhi Murugesan, Central Administrator, OSC, briefed the participants on the objectives of the One Stop Centre scheme. The scheme provides emergency and non-emergency services under one roof to combat all forms of violence against women. Through phased counselling, the One Stop Centre offers strategies to deal with various problems and helps women establish favorable relationships with their families. The program was attended by homemakers, SHG members and the public, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area. It is the responsibility of the Industrial Unit to obtain Consent to Establish (CTE) from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) before establishment of the industry and also to obtain Consent to Operate (CTO) after establishment of Unit. Non-compliance of this, is the violation of the provisions made under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Therefore, all the stakeholders and general public have been informed that it is statutory responsibility of all the Industries or Units to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry & CTO after establishment in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The Industrial Unit/ Entrepreneur shall apply for CTE & CTO using the URL: www.anocmms.nic.in for the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Any Industrial Unit which are operating the activity without obtaining CTE and CTO from ANPCC are liable for strict action against the industrial units/firms as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, a press release from ANPCC said.

Crime & Economic Offence Police Station raid shatters Methamphetamine network; nine arrested

Port Blair, July 16

A significant breakthrough was achieved by the Crime & Economic Offence Police Station on 27th April 2024, with the registration of FIR No. 62/2024 under Sections 22 (b), 22 (c), 27 (A), and 29 of the NDPS Act 1985. The case marks a pivotal moment in the fight against narcotics trafficking in the region.

During the initial stages of investigation, a total of 8 accused persons were arrested, out of which, 4 were arrested from Hut Bay, Little Andaman. This operation led to the seizure of 508.36 grams of Methamphetamine, a dangerous psychotropic

substance known for its severe health and societal impacts.

In a subsequent development, the investigation uncovered the involvement of Dibakar Mondal, S/o Shri Chandra Sekhar Mondal, 22 yrs, R/o Ramkrishnapur, Little Andaman, who had been evading authorities since registration of FIR, was apprehended on July 15, 2024. He stands accused of financing the purchase of Methamphetamine, thus playing a crucial role in the illicit drug trade network. Further investigation is under progress. The entire operation was

conducted under the command of Shri Lakshya Pandey, Dy.SP (CID) and overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID).

Meanwhile, citizens have been urged to continue their cooperation in reporting any suspicious activities or credible information pertaining to sale or possession of contrabands or any other illegal activity on telephone numbers- 100, 232586, 233307, 9933242204 & 9434280100. The identity of the informer will be kept secret, a press release from SP (CID) said.

Police Station Aberdeen seizes large quantity of IMFL bottles worth over Rs. 4 Lakhs

Port Blair, July 16

Aberdeen Police team conducted a major operation against illegal alcohol sales, seizing a significant quantity of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) bottles valued at over Rs. 4 lakhs from a local Bar & Restaurant on July 9, 2024. The restaurant's Manager was caught selling IMFL after the expiration of their license, thus breaching r e g u l a t o r y requirements.

Based on a credible information, a team led by Inspector Vishal Ram, SHO of PS Aberdeen, along with Inspector Mithun Kirtoniya, Head Constable Nakul Halder, and Police Constables K. Jagdish Babu, Surender Singh

Yadav, P. Mohd. Rafique, Jayraj, and HG(R) Jai Prakash (Police Photo/ V i d e o g r a p h e r) , conducted a raid at Hotel AR Honey Hub located at Gandhi Market. The operation resulted in the seizure of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) bottles valued at over Rs. 4 lakhs, which were being illegally sold to patrons without complying with legal requirements.

Legal proceedings have been initiated against the Manager K a n n a p p a n Arumugam, S/o Shri Arumugam, 50 yrs, R/o Aberdeen Bazaar under relevant sections of the A&N Excise Regulation 1876. Further investigations are underway.

The raid took place under the guidance of Shri Vikas, IPS, Sub Divisional Police Officer, South Andaman and overall supervision of Smt. Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District.

The South Andaman District Police has urged the citizens to report any suspicious activities related to illegal alcohol sales or other illicit practices at 112, 03192-232100, 03192-233077 & 03192-232400, emphasizing the importance of c o m m u n i t y cooperation in maintaining law and order. The identity of the informant will be kept secret, a press release from SP (SA) said.

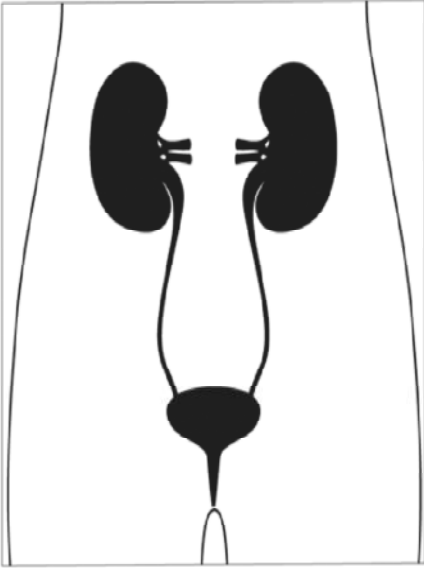
