New Delhi, July 17 (PIB)
 The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu, presented Swachh Survekshan awards at a function organized by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs in New Delhi today. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that Swachh Survekshan has proven to be a successful experiment in assessing and encouraging the efforts made by our cities towards cleanliness. She was pleased to note that the world's largest cleanliness survey was conducted by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2024, with participation from various stakeholders, state governments, urban bodies, and approximately 14 crore citizens.

The President said that our cultural and spiritual consciousness has



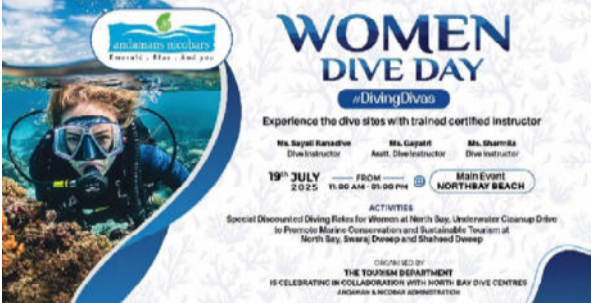
emphasized cleanliness since ancient times. The tradition of keeping our homes, places of worship, and the surroundings clean was an integral part of our lifestyle. Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi used to say, "Cleanliness is next to godliness". He considered cleanliness as the cornerstone of religion, spirituality, and civic life. She said that she had started her journey of public service with work related to cleanliness. As the Vice President of the Notified

Area Council, she used to visit wards every day and supervise the cleanliness work.

The President said that minimizing wastage by using minimum resources and re-using them for same purpose or other purpose, has always been the part of our lifestyle. The basic principles of circular economy and systems of reduce-reuse-recycle are modern and widespread forms of our ancient lifestyle. For example, the traditional lifestyle of tribal communities is simple. They use less resources and stay in harmony with the weather and environment, and in partnership with other community members. They do not waste natural resources. The modern systems of circularity could be strengthened by adopting such behaviour and traditions.

first and most important step in the waste management value chain is source segregation. All stakeholders and every household need to pay utmost attention to this step. Zero-waste colonies are setting good examples.

The President appreciated the School Level Assessment initiative, started with the objective that students adopt cleanliness as a life value. She said that it would have very beneficial and far-reaching results.

The President said that controlling plastic and electronic waste and preventing pollution caused by them is a big challenge. With proper efforts, we can reduce the country's plastic emissions significantly. The Central Government banned some items containing single-use plastic in the year 2022. In the same year, the Government issued guidelines for Extended Producer Responsibility for plastic packaging. It is the responsibility of all stakeholders, including producers, brand owners, and importers, to ensure that these guidelines are fully followed.

The President said that efforts related to cleanliness have economic aspects, cultural dimensions, and geographical aspects. She expressed confidence that all citizens would participate in the Swachh Bharat Mission with full dedication. She said that with well-thought-out and strong resolutions, the developed India by the year 2047 will be one of the cleanest countries in the world.

During the award ceremony, 23 Super Swachh League Cities received felicitations in the presence of Union Minister, Shri Manohar Lal and MoS, MoHUA, Shri Tokhan Sahu. The new generation of clean cities of India have arrived with Ahmedabad, Bhopal and Lucknow emerging as top Swachh Shehar. 43 National awards have been announced, with a special recognition for Mahakumbh.

This year's Swachh Survekshan not only refined and streamlined the framework for big cities, but also simplified it for small cities, encouraging them to compete and climb the ladder of swachhata. environmental awareness activities to be shared with the Education Department allowing schools to systematically integrate biodiversity related topics throughout the academic year. The Chief Secretary further suggested engaging senior school students (Classes IX & XI) in these initiatives, and this age group is particularly receptive to environmental values and empowering them to lead change within their communities. He also shared the story of a transformative environmental experiment from Maharashtra, where barren land was transformed into a forest ecosystem through sustained individual effort.

The Chief Secretary encouraged the creation of micro learning



content, such as small videos and information booklets, which can be accessed via smartphones to ensure wider knowledge dissemination. He concluded by stressing the importance of recognizing local ecological shifts, such as changes in fruiting patterns of mango trees, as indicators of climate change. He called on institutions to collaborate with the Education Department, adopt modern tools, and ensure that environmental learning reaches every corner of the Islands.

The session commenced with a welcome address by Dr. C. Sivaperuman, Officer-in-Charge and Course Director, who outlined the structure and objectives of the workshop. The workshop includes expert lectures and a field visit to intertidal habitats of Burmanallah and Chidiyatappu Biological Park to expose the marine biodiversity, endemic and terrestrial fauna of this island ecosystem.

on India's significant progress in TB reduction as per the Global TB Report 2024, the TB epidemiological status in the A&N Islands, presumptive TB examination procedures, district-wise TB notification and Drug-Resistant TB (DR-TB) percentage for 2024, block-wise analysis of ongoing TB patient treatments, the process flow for screening of presumptive TB cases, details of TB patients currently on treatment and the support extended through the Nikshay Mitras initiative, the TB Notification Rate for all three districts (Jan to May 2025), and the status of declared TB Mukta Panchayats for 2023 & 2024.

To further intensify TB awareness and community participation, it was requested to the Pradhans that the following IEC (Information, Education & Communication) activities may be carried out in all Panchayats:

- > Regular organization of Gram Sabha meetings and community dialogues to spread awareness on TB symptoms, prevention, free diagnostic services, and treatment availability.
- > Wall paintings and display of TB awareness hoardings at prominent public places.
- > Distribution of IEC leaflets and brochures in local languages to households through ASHAs and Anganwadi Workers.
- > Street plays (Nukkad Nataks) and cultural programmes highlighting TB symptoms and the importance of completing treatment.
- > Involvement of Nikshay Mitras, community volunteers, and local influencers for identification and motivation of presumptive TB cases for timely screening.

At the conclusion of the session, all Pradhans were requested to ensure their active involvement in implementing the TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan in their respective Panchayats and to extend their full cooperation for achieving the target of a TB-Free Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The Health Department has appealed to all residents to actively participate in the fight against TB by supporting local health workers, spreading awareness, and encouraging anyone with TB symptoms to seek timely medical advice and treatment, a press release from Joint Secretary (NTEP) A&N Islands said.
