Vice President calls for responsible journalism that addresses double standards and unethical conduct

Expresses concern over growing trend of disruptions & sensationalism in Parliamentary proceedings

New Delhi, July 18 (PIB)

The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today expressed concern over the disproportionate coverage given by media to incidents of limited impact, which overshadow substantive and long-term initiatives.

Interacting with the students at the Parliament led by a Hindi daily, the Vice President called for introspection within the media and appealed to the media to take note of the growth story of India.

Lamenting over commercialization and control of media for motivated narratives, Shri Dhankhar acknowledged journalism's crucial role in sustaining democracy. Shri Dhankhar called on the media to rise above partisan views and avoid aligning with political agendas or forces against national interests.

"It is time for soul searching. I appeal to the media in all humility and earnestness to be partners in growth. They can do this by highlighting good works and being critical of wrong situations and deficiencies", he added.

Drawing parallels with the solemnity of the Constituent Assembly, where democratic ideals were revered and disruptions unheard of, the Vice President expressed concern over the growing



trend of disruptions and sensationalism in parliamentary proceedings. "The Constituent Assembly was a temple of democracy, where every session contributed to the foundation of our nationhood without any disruptions or disturbances," he remarked. He noted that disruption and disturbance have regrettably

become political tools rather than exceptions.

Highlighting concerns over Media's tendency to glorify disruption, Shri Dhankhar called upon the media to reassess their priorities in covering parliamentary proceedings. He expressed that when disruptions become headlines and disruptors are hailed as heroes, journalism fails in its duty to uphold democratic values.

The Vice President urged the media to uphold its responsibility in portraying an accurate image of India to the world. "People from outside cannot judge India. They do it from their own perspective. There are many people, less in the country and more outside, who are unable to digest our unexpected and unimaginable progress, that we are becoming a superpower", he added.

The Vice President eloquently explored India's profound cultural heritage spanning 5000 years and underscored the strength of its democratic institutions. Reflecting on recent elections, he emphasized the ease with which India transitions Governments, showcasing the vibrancy of its electoral process. The Vice President called for responsible journalism that addresses double standards and unethical conduct.

further stated that during his interaction, it was found that few learners are taking the NIOS exams for class 10 and higher examinations. He asked the authorities to device separate strategies for these students for which the schools in their respective areas need to take initiatives. He also urged for on boarding of Teacher Education Institutes completely to ensure that each teacher trainee covers at least 5 learners. He further stated that it must be ensured that in the coming September examinations, all are motivated to take the exam for the achievement/success of 100 percent literacy in A&N Islands.

The chief guest and other distinguished guests also interacted with the participants i.e. 'neo-literates and 'Volunteer Teachers' came from various parts of the Islands and appreciated the efforts of all stakeholders of this mission. The Secretary (Education) and the Director of Education also planted saplings under 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' mission in the Girls School Campus.

In his address, the Director, Education stated that ULLAS is an acronym of Understanding of Lifelong Learning for All in Society, which is a centrally sponsored scheme towards 'Adult Literacy' initiated by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India to literate above 15-years of aged people who have never gone to schools or discontinued their schooling due to some or other reasons. He further stated that the UT of A&N Islands has registered about 12,800 'non-literates' under this Scheme during 2023-24 through household survey and their classes are being run in almost all the 38-CRCs (Cluster Resource Centres), across 9-Blocks and 3-Districts of this UT.

Welcoming the chief guest and others present on the occasion, the State Nodal Officer-ULLAS, Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram & Dy. Director (Edn. For All), Shri R. K. Singh informed that the Ministry of Education, Deptt. of School Education & Literacy, Govt. of India has approved a Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'ULLAS-Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram' for 05-years from 1st April-2022 to 31st March-2027. The Scheme has five Components namely; (i) Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (ii) Critical Life Skills (iii) Basic Education (iv) Vocational Skills (v) Continuing Education / Lifelong Learning, he said.

Earlier, the Band Troop welcomed the chief guest followed by a welcome song from GSSS School Line, Port Blair. Altogether, 170 persons including 60 learners, 40 volunteers and 40 Master Trainers and 30 Officials are participating in this two- day ULLAS-Mela from different parts of this UT, right from Diglipur to Campbell Bay. The inaugural programme concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Programme Coordinator-ULLAS, Nav Bharat Saaksharta Karyakram, Shri Raja Ram. The International flight operations from Kuala Lumpur to Port Blair is expected to commence from November, 2024. Operationalization of In-line Baggage Handling System is in pipeline which will further streamline the passengers processing at terminal building and enhance overall efficiency and passenger experience.

VSI Airport Port Blair has been designated for implementation of Digi Yatra, an advance technology-based passenger processing solution that provides contactless, seamless movement of passengers at various check points at airports based on Facial Recognition Technology (FRT). Soon Digi Yatra solution will be implemented at VSI Airport Port Blair.

Meanwhile, Airports Authority of India in collaboration with Srishti Communication and Narayana Health City (Narayana Hrudayalaya), Bengaluru is organising a three-day Heart Health Screening Camp from July 18 and will continue up to July 20, 2024 at the old terminal building of Veer Savarkar International Airport. The cardiac screening at the camp will be free of cost and is open to the general public. The timing of the camp is from 10.30 am to 4.30 pm, with a plan to screen 150 persons daily. The common systems for heart related ailments are chest pain, shortness of breath, irregular heartbeat, chest tightness, radiating pain from shoulders, weakness, dizziness, sweating, nausea etc.

The cardiac check-up will include BMI, BP, RBS, ECG (Cardiac Consultation), ECHO and Consultation. The check-up will be done in the order of registration and time slot of the check-up will be intimated via phone call on the contact number mentioned in the registration. 
