Relentless fight against narcotics: twin operations yield major seizures

Mayabunder, July 20

In a continued effort to combat the menace of drug trafficking and ensure a drug-free society, the North & Middle Andaman District Police have achieved significant success through two separate anti-narcotics operations conducted on July 14 & 15, 2025.

On July 14, during routine patrolling in Shantipur, Ward No. 02, Police Station Billiground team noticed a suspicious individual attempting to evade police presence. The individual was immediately intercepted and upon checking the bag in his possession, the team recovered approximately 01 Kg

of illegal ganja. The accused, identified as Ravi Das, 40 years, S/o Late Bhagaban Das, resident of Shantipur, Billiground was arrested on the spot. All legal procedures were duly followed and a case under the relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985 was registered against him.

In another operation, acting on credible intelligence, Police Station Diglipur carried out a targeted raid in the Laxmipur area on 15/07/2025, which led to the recovery of approx. 100 grams of illicit ganja. Following further leads, a swift and coordinated follow-up raid was conducted in Harinagar,

Billiground, resulting in the seizure of an additional approx. 500 grams of ganja. An NDPS case has been registered against the accused Sowrab Das, 26 years, S/o Shri Sudip Das, ex-employee of Campbell Engineering, Haddo and resident of Sri Vijaya Puram, Harinagar (RV), Ward No. 05, Billiground.

These successful operations reflect the firm commitment of the North & Middle Andaman District Police to adopt a zero-tolerance approach towards drugs and narcotics. The fight against illegal substances continues with full force across the district, a press release from SP, N&M said.

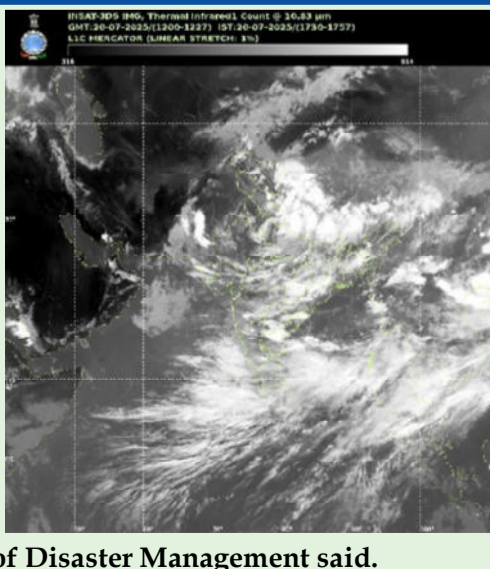

A&N Traffic Police issues advisory on child safety in vehicles: Rs.1,000 fine for violations

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 20

The Andaman & Nicobar Traffic Police has urged all motorists, particularly parents and guardians, to prioritize the safety of children while travelling in vehicles. As per Section 194B (2) of the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2019, any person who drives or permits a motor vehicle to be driven with a child below 14 years of age not secured by a safety belt or child restraint system (CRS) shall be liable to a fine of Rs.1,000.

It has been observed that many parents allow highly unsafe practices, such as letting children stand through the sunroof, sit on the driver's lap while driving, or move freely inside the car without any restraint. These

practices are extremely dangerous. Even during low-speed collisions or sudden braking, such unrestrained children are at high risk of being seriously injured or fatally thrown forward or out of the vehicle.

In view of these risks, the Traffic Police has advised that all children under 14 years of age must be secured either with a seat belt (wherever applicable) or an appropriate child restraint system, depending on the child's age and size.

While seat belts may be used for older children, it is recognized that small children cannot be safely fastened with seat belts alone. For them, child restraint systems such as booster seats or car seats are necessary. However, understanding that not

all parents may immediately have access to these systems, a grace period of one month is granted for parents to procure and begin using appropriate CRS. This grace period is advisory in nature, with an appeal to parents to voluntarily comply in the best interest of their children's safety.

Parents have been strongly advised, wherever possible, to seat children in the rear seat of the vehicle and ensure they are appropriately restrained.

No act of carelessness is worth the risk to a child's life. The Traffic Police has appealed to all vehicle users to act responsibly and follow safety guidelines strictly, a press release from A&N Traffic Police said.
