

In addition, a training programme on 'Multi-tier Cropping, Intercropping, and Multispecies Cropping' was organized by the Department of Agriculture in the field of Shri Kunjalal Hawlader at Kadamtala village, in the presence of Shri Bikash Paramanik, PRI Member, who encouraged farmers to adopt modern agricultural practices.
