India hits 20% ethanol blending in petrol 5 years ahead of target: Minister

New Delhi, July 24

The Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri has said that India has successfully achieved 20 per cent ethanol blending in petrol in 2025, five years ahead of its original target set for 2030. Highlighting the country's clean energy progress, the Minister noted that ethanol blending in petrol has risen from just 1.5% in 2014 to 20% in 2025, a nearly 13-fold increase over 11 years.

The Minister emphasised that the shift towards ethanol-blended fuel has not only bolstered energy security but also led to significant economic and environmental benefits.

Ethanol production has surged from 38 crore litres in 2014 to 661.1 crore litres by June 2025. As a result, India has saved approximately 1.36 lakh crore rupees in foreign exchange by

reducing its dependency on imported crude oil. At the same time, 1.96 lakh crore rupees have been paid to distilleries, fueling the growth of the domestic biofuel industry. Additionally,

1.18 lakh crore rupees have been disbursed to farmers, thereby enhancing rural incomes and supporting the agricultural economy. The environmental impact has been equally significant. The increased use of ethanol-blended petrol has helped reduce carbon dioxide emissions by 698 lakh tonnes, contributing to India's climate goals.

The ethanol used in blending is primarily derived from crops such as sugarcane, reinforcing the initiative's role in supporting Indian agriculture. Recently, the Union Cabinet approved a price hike for ethanol produced from molasses for the current marketing season. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

ANPCC extends deadline for industrial units to obtain direct CTO till Oct. 31, 2025

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 24

The Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) has extended the deadline for industrial units that were established without prior pollution clearance to regularize their operations. In its XXXIV meeting held in May 2025, the committee decided to allow such units to apply for Consent to Operate (CTO) directly-without obtaining prior Consent to Establish (CTE)-till 31st October, 2025.

As per the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, no industry is permitted to be established or

operated without obtaining CTE and CTO from the State Board. Furthermore, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, compliance with these regulations is mandatory.

The ANPCC has observed that several industrial units in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been set up and are operational without acquiring the necessary pollution consents. This constitutes a violation of the aforementioned Acts. While a previous compliance window was provided to such units, the committee continues to receive CTO applications without prior CTE, prompting the

extension. The CTO will be issued only if the industrial unit meets all applicable environmental norms. The ANPCC emphasized that no CTO applications will be entertained after 31st October, 2025 from units that failed to obtain CTE prior to establishment.

All stakeholders and industrial entrepreneurs are reminded that it is a statutory requirement to obtain CTE before establishing an industry and CTO before commencing operations. Applications for both consents must be submitted online via

Shifting of gravity main pipeline from Dhanikhari Dam to Lamba Line Treatment Plant in progress

Supply of raw water to be affected in few areas

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 24

The shifting of 2 Nos. gravity main line from Dhanikhari Dam to Lamba Line Treatment Plant is under progress. Interconnection of existing gravity main line with newly laid 500 mm gravity main is planned to be taken up on 26.07.2025 and 27.07.2025. Therefore, raw water supply to Lamba Line

Treatment Plant is likely to be affected during this period.

It may also affect water supply in municipal area served by command tanks of Buniyadabad, All India Radio, Ranchi Tekri and Police Line during this period. All efforts are being made to limit public hardship to minimum. Officials of

SVPWC has been requested to plan distribution during this period accordingly. General public have also been advised to conserve water and use drinking water judiciously. Tanker water supply will be available from Jawahar Sarovar during this period, a press release from APWD said.

year-old man lying unconscious with blood flowing out from his mouth. The man,

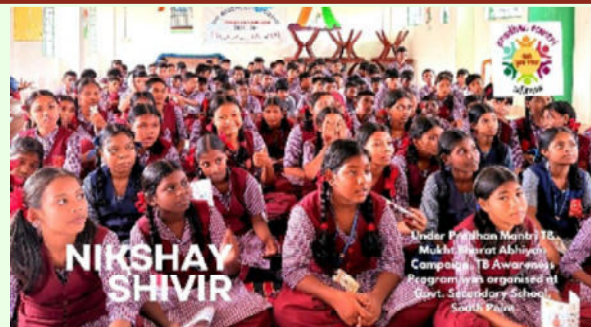

PS Ograbraj cracks BSNL theft case within a day

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 24

The staff of Police Station Ograbraj have demonstrated exceptional professionalism and efficiency in solving a theft case reported at the BSNL Telephone Exchange, Namunagar, within 24 hours. Their prompt and coordinated efforts led to the arrest of two accused persons and the recovery of stolen property valued approximately Rs. 75,000.

On 17/07/2025, the Telecom Technician of BSNL reported that the server system had abruptly shut down at 0356 hrs. Upon inspection, he

discovered that the main entrance and an internal wooden door of the exchange had been forcefully broken. Further, a Godrej Air conditioner unit (indoor and outdoor) along with an inverter and battery belonging to M/s Mehak Cable Network were found missing from the switch room.

Acting promptly, a team was swiftly constituted and they meticulously examined the crime scene, collected vital forensic evidence and reviewed CCTV footages of the surrounding areas. The team also gathered intelligence from the picketing staff deployed at PS

Ograbraj junction. During checking, they identified a suspicious black Swift Dzire (Reg. No. AN01 J 7170) transporting an AC unit, allegedly heading towards Baratang. The team immediately traced the vehicle and summoned the owner for interrogation. Upon interrogation, the owner Kishori Lal, a resident of Teylerabad and his brother-in-law Divesh Ram admitted to their involvement in the theft. The vehicle used in the commission of the crime was seized and all the stolen properties were recovered, a press release from SSP (SA)

Whereas as per the section 25(RESTRICTIONS ON NEW OUTLETS AND NEW DISCHARGES) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, No person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

Whereas as per the section 21(RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL PLANTS) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent To Establish(CTE) from Andaman Nicobar Pollution Control Committee(ANPCC) before establishment of industry and also obtain Consent to Operate(CTO) after establishment of unit. Non compliance of this is the violation of the provisions made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of ANPCC that the many of Industrial Units have been established without obtaining CTE and also started operating without CTO under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, which is a violation of the aforesaid rules.

Whereas, ANPCC has given an opportunity to such units by giving window to all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment for obtaining CTO from ANPCC. Even after the lapse of such period, ANPCC is still receiving applications for issue of CTO without having prior CTE.

Now, therefore the ANPCC in its XXXIV meeting held during May 2025 has decided to extend the window for further period up to 31st October 2025, to regulate all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment, to apply for getting direct CTO from ANPCC. However the CTO will be issued subject to fulfillment of environmental norms applicable to the industry.

Therefore, it is informed to all the stakeholders and general public that it is the statutory responsibility of all the industries to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry & CTO after establishment in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE & CTO using the URL: www.anocmms.nic.in for the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Any industrial unit which fails to obtain CTO from ANPCC within the stipulated time shall be liable for action as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

No Consent to Operate will be issued to any industry after 31st October 2025, who have not obtained CTE before its establishment.
