Port Blair, July 24

The District Administration of South Andaman has implemented a ban on the consumption and sale of Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products (COTPA) within educational institutes and their 100-yard boundaries. This decision, under the COTPA, 2003, aims to discourage tobacco use, especially among youth, and protect the overall population from the severe health risks linked with tobacco consumption.

Section 4 of the

Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) prohibits smoking in public places, ensuring that spaces like educational institutions are smoke-free environments. Meanwhile, Section 6 of COTPA focuses on protecting minors and youths by regulating and restricting the tobacco business, emphasizing the importance of compliance within educational settings. As per COTPA, all educational institutions must adhere to these provisions, thereby contributing to the

broader effort to mitigate the harmful effects of tobacco and promote public health.

To ensure compliance with the law regarding the prohibition of tobacco use and sale in educational institutions within South Andaman District, the following measures must be implemented by all educational institutes and enforcement agencies:

> **Display "No Smoking Area" Signage:** Prominent signage indicating "No Smoking Area" must be displayed throughout the campus

of both Government and private Educational Institutions (Annexure-I).

> **Display "Tobacco Free Educational Institution" Signage:** Another signage stating "Tobacco free educational Institution" must be displayed at the main gate or outer boundary, clearly indicating the prohibition of sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of the institution (Annexure-II).

> Enforce tobacco-free policy

> Prohibit sale of

tobacco products

> Random checks by Police/Enforcement agencies

> Imposition of fine for tobacco use/sale

Ensuring compliance with COTPA regulations is a specific responsibility entrusted to the Head or designated authority of educational institutions. This includes the mandatory display of "No Smoking Area" and "Tobacco free Educational Institution" signage, even in the absence of visible violations. By proactively

No landlord/owner/manager of residential/commercial establishment shall let/sublet/rent out any accommodation without furnishing particulars of Tenants or Paying Guest to local Police Station

There is an apprehension that anti-social elements may make their hideouts clandestinely in the residential/commercial areas of the South Andaman District. If suitable measures to prevent the same are not taken, the unlawful activities of these people can cause breach of peace and tranquility besides posing grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public

property. Some check/vigil is necessary on landlords/ owners/ managers of the residential/commercial establishments while renting out or subletting the premises, so that anti-social elements in the guise of ordinary tenants, domestic servants & Paying Guest may not cause harm to the citizen and that immediate action is necessary for prevention of the same.

In view of this, the District Magistrates of both South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman Districts, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by virtue of Section 163 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023, has ordered as an emergency measure that no landlord/owner/manager of the residential/commercial etc establishment shall let/

General public urged to refrain from indulging in sale & purchase of agricultural lands for housing purposes/plots

Instances have come to the notice of the District Administration that general public are being lured on the pretext of selling and purchase of landed properties by way of plotting over agricultural lands for housing purposes also.

Certain advertisements are also being published in the print and electronic media in this regard.

Further, general public have also been misinformed about construction of houses in agricultural/hilly revenue areas by unscrupulous agents

who have been misguiding / misinforming the public by publishing such advertisements in public domain.

The general public should be aware that sub-division of any land holding as well as any diversion of land use is strictly being done as per

the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue & Land Reforms Regulations, 1966.

The sale and purchase of undiverted agricultural land for housing plots is a fraudulent practice and the general public have been cautioned not to

indulge in any such activity.

It is reiterated that the general public should refrain from indulging in sale and purchase of agricultural lands for housing purposes/plots and that the District Administration has zero tolerance towards such

(Contd. from page 1) sublet/rent out any accommodation to any person unless and until he/she has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s) or Paying Guest to the local Police Station concerned. Similarly, no landlord/owner/manager or the residential/commercial etc. establishment shall employ any servants/house help/unless and until he/she has furnished the particulars of the said servants to the local Police Station. All the persons who intent to offer accommodation on rent or employ any servant/house help shall inform in writing the particulars of Tenants, Paying Guests & Servants to the Station Officers concerned in whose jurisdiction the premises falls. Any breach of this order would invite action Under Section 208 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023. This Order shall come into force w.e.f zero hours of 24/07/2024 and shall be effective for a period of sixty days and is applicable to those also who already have domestic servants/maids and has not informed the Police yet when the Order is in force, Orders to this effect issued by the District Magistrates of South Andaman District and N&M Andaman District said.

(Contd. from page 1) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) -2023 has ordered for strict compliance of following conditions by the Owners of all such establishments in the jurisdiction of South Andaman and N&M Andman Districts of Andaman & Nicobar Islands: > Only those Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. which possess valid licences, shall be allowed to function. > All such establishments shall have sufficient number of CCTV cameras which shall cover persons entering the premises and moving outside. All the cameras installed shall be in working condition, and their coverage shall be preserved for not less than 30 days. > All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall maintain a Register-having complete details of persons staying in the said premise. A copy of the valid ID proof of such persons shall be kept for record. > All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall ensure that details relating to Form-C (Arrival Report of Foreigners in Hotel) are submitted to the Registering Authorities within the prescribed period. All procedures/guidelines shall be followed in respect of any Foreign National staying in the said premise. The Order to this effect has come into force w.e.f zero hours of 24.07.24 and shall remain in force for a period of 60 days unless withdrawn earlier. All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. which contravene this Order, shall be liable to be punished in accordance with the provision of Section 208 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) 2023, Orders to this effect issued by District Magistrates of South Andaman District & N&M Andaman District said.

ICAR-CIARI registers two more Industrial Designs with Patent Office

Port Blair, July 24 ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Port Blair got two of their inventions registered as Industrial Designs with the Patent Office. The first invention- cold water circulatory system is a laboratory aid useful for condensation operation during the process of extraction of phytochemicals from spices, medicinal & aromatic plants, fruits etc. Such extraction processes involve continuous use of running tap water for condensation, which results in considerable wastage of water; while the sophisticated recirculatory chillers are too costly for most of the small laboratories. Thus, the invention would not be only affordable but also water-saving solution for the researchers and academicians dealing with various aspects such as extraction of essential oils, fixed oils, refluxing of samples etc. The second invention is cinnamon bark rubbing tool, which is a handy tool that facilitates extraction of inner bark of cinnamon from the harvested stems. Cinnamon is an ancient spice and country imports huge quantities of produce causing loss to the national exchequer. High labour requirement in various stages of harvesting is the main factor deterring cinnamon cultivation in the country. In order to facilitate the harvesting, availability of user-friendly tools are required and this invention is a timely attempt to meet this gap. The Scientific team of the invention are Dr. Ajit Arun Waman and Dr. Pooja Bohra, Senior Scientists, ICAR-CIARI, a press release from CIARI said.
