'Durbar Hall' and 'Ashok Hall' renamed as 'Ganatantra Mandap' and 'Ashok Mandap' respectively

New Delhi, July 25 (PIB)

Rashtrapati Bhavan, the Office and the Residence of the President of India, is a symbol of the nation, and an invaluable heritage of the people. Continuous efforts are being made to make it more accessible to people. There has been a consistent endeavour to make the ambience of the Rashtrapati Bhavan reflective of the Indian cultural values and ethos.

Accordingly, President, Smti Droupadi Murmu is pleased to rename two of the important halls of Rashtrapati Bhavan - namely, 'Durbar Hall' and 'Ashok Hall' - as 'Ganatantra Mandap' and 'Ashok Mandap' respectively.

'Durbar Hall' is the venue of important ceremonies and celebrations such as the presentation of National Awards. The term 'Durbar' refers to courts and assemblies of Indian rulers and the British. It lost relevance after India became a Republic, that is, 'Ganatantra'. The concept of 'Ganatantra' is deeply rooted in the Indian society since the ancient times, making 'Ganatantra Mandap' an apt name for the venue.

'Ashok Hall' was originally a ballroom. The word 'Ashok' connotes someone who is "free from all sufferings" or is "bereft of any sorrow". Also, 'Ashoka' refers to Emperor Ashok, a symbol of unity and peaceful co-existence. The National Emblem of the Republic of India is the lion capital of Ashok from Sarnath. The word also refers to the Ashok tree which has deep significance in Indian religious traditions as well as arts and culture. Renaming 'Ashok Hall' as 'Ashok Mandap' brings uniformity in language and removes the traces of anglicisation while upholding the key values associated with the word 'Ashok'.

The Kuposhan Mukh District Abhiyan and Anemia Mukh District Abhiyan were officially launched at Ayushman Arogya Mandir/PHC, Hutbay, marking a pivotal step in addressing

malnutrition and anemia among vulnerable populations. The Kuposhan Mukh District Abhiyan focuses on combating malnutrition by providing essential nutritional support to malnourished children and pregnant women and nutrient-rich diet kits will be distributed to improve overall health and combat nutritional deficiencies effectively.

Simultaneously, the Anemia Mukh District Abhiyan aims to reduce anemia prevalence among pregnant women through targeted interventions such as iron and folic acid supplementation and regular health check-ups.

These campaigns are a collaborative effort involving the District Health Society, South Andaman, the Directorate of Health Services, and a specialized Medical Team from ANIIMS, Port Blair. This partnership ensures the availability of expert healthcare professionals to provide

comprehensive medical care during the campaigns.

The inauguration of these campaigns coincided with the launch of a Reproductive Child Health (RCH) Camp at PHC Hutbay under the supervision of Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman. The camp aimed to enhance access to reproductive and child health services for women and children in the region, emphasizing

The District Administration of North and Middle Andaman has implemented a ban on the consumption and sale of Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products (COTPA) within educational institutes and their 100-yard boundaries. This decision, under the COTPA, 2003, aims to discourage tobacco use, especially among youth, and protect the overall population from the severe health risks linked with tobacco consumption.

Section 4 of the Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) prohibits smoking in public places, ensuring that spaces like educational institutions are smoke-free environments. Meanwhile, Section 6 of COTPA focuses on protecting minors and youths by regulating and restricting the tobacco business, emphasizing the importance of

compliance within educational settings. As per COTPA, all educational institutions must adhere to these provisions, thereby contributing to the broader effort to mitigate the harmful effects of tobacco and promote public health.

To ensure compliance with the law regarding the prohibition of tobacco use and sale in educational institutions within North and Middle Andaman District, the following measures must be implemented by all educational institutes and enforcement agencies:

- ◆ Display "No Smoking Area" Signage: Prominent signage indicating "No Smoking Area" must be displayed throughout the campus of both government and private educational institutions (Annexure-I).
- ◆ Display "Tobacco Free Educational Institution" Signage: Another

signage stating "Tobacco free educational Institution" must be displayed at the main gate or outer boundary, clearly indicating the prohibition of sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of the institution (Annexure-II).

- ◆ Enforce tobacco-free policy
- ◆ Prohibit sale of tobacco products
- ◆ Random checks by Police/Enforcement agencies
- ◆ Imposition of fine for tobacco use/sale

Ensuring compliance with COTPA regulations is a specific responsibility entrusted to the head or designated authority of educational institutions. This includes the mandatory display of "No Smoking Area" and "Tobacco free Educational Institution" signage, even in the absence of visible violations. By proactively implementing these measures, institutions

uphold their commitment to creating a tobacco-free environment. Leadership in enforcement and education further reinforces the message, fostering a culture of health and well-being among students, faculty, staff, and visitors alike, a press release from DC, N&M Andaman said.

Bee Keeping by human is primary for honey production, but in modern era, bee keeping is used for crop pollination and collection of it's by-products. Bees are essential for human life and planet.

The inaugural programme was held on July 23, during which, Shri Ramesh Kumar, Joint Director (Agri) emphasized on the scope and importance of bee keeping. He urged the farmers/SHG/Youth to adopt scientific bee keeping which provides dual benefits to the farmers. Besides honey, bees helps in pollination service that enhances the

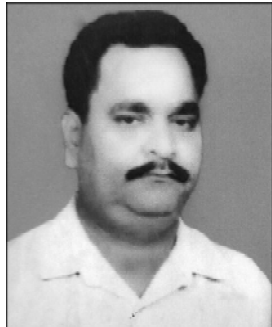
