## PM pays homage to bravehearts on Kargil Vijay Diwas and attends Shradhanjali Samaroh in Ladakh

### Kargil Vijay Diwas reminds us that the sacrifices made for the nation are immortal: PM

New Delhi, July 26 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi paid homage to the bravehearts who made the supreme sacrifice in the line of duty on the occasion of 25<sup>th</sup> Kargil Vijay Diwas in Ladakh today. He also attended the Shradddhanjali Samaroh. The Prime Minister heard the Gaurav Gatha: Briefing on Kargil War by NCOs and visited Amar Sansmaran: Hut of Remembrance. He also visited the Veer Bhoomi.

The Prime Minister also witnessed the first blast of the Shinkun La Tunnel Project in Ladakh, virtually today. Shinkun La Tunnel Project consists of a 4.1 km long Twin-Tube tunnel to be constructed at around 15,800 feet on the Nimu - Padum - Darcha Road to provide all-weather connectivity to Leh.

Addressing the Shrdddhanjali Samaroh,



the Prime Minister said that the glorious land of Ladakh is witness to the 25<sup>th</sup> year anniversary of Kargil Vijay Diwas. "Kargil Vijay Diwas reminds us that the sacrifices made for the nation are immortal", PM Modi remarked. Even though months,

years, decades and centuries pass by, the Prime Minister underlined that the lives laid down to protect the nation's borders cannot be erased. "The nation is forever indebted and deeply grateful to the mighty superheroes of our armed forces", PM

Shri Modi added.

Recalling the days of Kargil war, the Prime Minister said he was fortunate to be amidst the soldiers back then, adding that he still remembers how our soldiers carried out a difficult operation at such a height. "I salute

the brave sons of the country who made the supreme sacrifice to protect the motherland," Shri Modi said.

"In Kargil, we not only won the war, we presented an incredible example of 'truth, restraint and strength', Prime Minister Modi remarked. The Prime Minister threw light on Pakistan's deceit at the time when India was making all efforts to maintain peace. " Falsehood and terror were brought down to their knees by truth", he added.

Condemning terrorism, the Prime Minister said that Pakistan has always faced defeat in the past. "Pakistan has not learnt anything from its past and has continued to wage war in the garb of terrorism and proxy wars to stay relevant," Shri Modi continued. The Prime Minister asserted that the

## MP meets Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation; urges for Categorisation of SEBC and conduct of Socio - Economic Survey in Isles



Port Blair, July 26

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A & N Islands yesterday met Shri Amit Shah, Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, GoI, New Delhi and submitted a letter with prayers for SEBC categorization, conduct of Socio and Economic Survey in the Isles, for inclusion of left out category people in OBC category and for population based representation in reservation, so that all groups within the OBC are provided equal opportunity for upliftment.

Shri Ray has pointed in the letter that various categories of persons / groups permanently residing in the Islands have been identified

and notified in the mid-2000. This category of people essentially comes within the meaning and definition of 'Socially and Economically Backward Classes' (SEBC) living in the Isles, which is commonly referred to as OBC category.

Ever since the time of composition of OBCs in the Islands, demands have emerged for inclusion of more groups in the Islands under the said category such as ex-servicemen settlers/ Sri Lankan Tamil settlers/ Malayali settlers/ Ranchi Settlers etc.

Moreover, there have been demands for population based representation in reservation including that in jobs, so that all

groups within the OBC are provided equal opportunity for upliftment.

In addition, as per the Census of 2011, only 1.6% or so population in Urban area and 24 % population in rural area (mostly under Nicobar District) i.e. total approx. 16 % of population of Islands are covered under Food Security (i.e. only 12000 odd families or 60000 odd persons).

As a result, only miniscule population of the Islands are getting benefitted under the free ration scheme announced by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narandra Modi ji. Similarly, this survey stands as stumbling block in identifying beneficiaries for a large number of schemes announced by the Modi

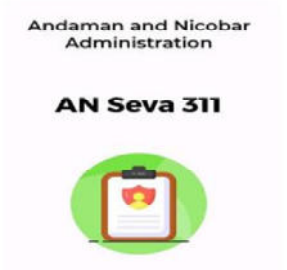

nefarious intentions of terrorists will never be fulfilled. "Our bravehearts will trample all the terror attempts," he added.

"India will overcome all challenges that come in the way of development, be it Ladakh or Jammu & Kashmir", the Prime Minister reiterated. He reminded that in a few days from now on 5<sup>th</sup> of August, the abrogation of Article 370 will complete 5 years and the Jammu & Kashmir of today is talking about a new future full of dreams. The Prime Minister gave examples of progress and mentioned holding G20 meetings in the UT, Government's focus on infrastructure development and tourism, cinema halls opening up, and tazia procession being initiated after three and a half decades. "This heaven on earth is swiftly moving in the direction of peace and prosperity", the Prime Minister added.

Underlining the developments taking place in Ladakh, the Prime Minister said through Shinkun La Tunnel, the union territory will remain connected with the whole country throughout the year, in every season. "This tunnel will open doors of new possibilities for the development and better future of Ladakh." Referring to the ambitious targets for the border areas, the Prime Minister informed that the Border Road Organization (BRO) has completed more than 330 projects including Sela Tunnel, showcasing New India's capabilities and direction.

Emphasizing the importance of upgrading military technologies, the Prime Minister said in the changing global scenarios, our defence force needs the latest weapons and equipment along with a modern working style and arrangements.

Lauding the defence forces for the reforms in the defence sector, the Prime Minister dwelled at length on Agnipath Scheme as one of the crucial reforms. Referring to the long pending concern for the average age of the Indian focus being above the global average, the Prime Minister said that in the past there was no willpower to deal with this critical concern which is being addressed now through the Agnipath Scheme. "Purpose of Agnipath is to keep forces young and continuously battle-ready", the Prime Minister asserted, lamenting the blatant politicization of this sensitive subject. "The truth is that the Agnipath scheme will increase the strength of the country and the country will also get capable youth. Announcements have been made to give priority to Agniveers in the private sector and paramilitary forces as well", he said.

Rejecting the propaganda about the intention of saving pension burden as the main reason behind Agnipath Scheme, the Prime Minister reminded that pension burden of the soldiers being recruited today will come up after 30 years, therefore, this cannot be the reason behind the scheme. "We have respected this decision taken by the armed forces because for us the security of the country is more important than politics", he added.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister said, "The victory of Kargil was not the victory of any Government or any party. This victory belongs to the country, this victory is the heritage of the country. This is a festival of pride and self-respect of the country." He saluted the brave soldiers on behalf of the entire country and conveyed his best wishes to all the countrymen on 25 years of Kargil victory.

Electricity Deptt. to exercise rotational load shedding in South Andaman area  
Consumers & general public urged to conserve electricity

Port Blair, July 26

The Electricity Department is currently facing a shortfall of 6 MW power generation. This shortfall is due to the shutdown of the 5 MW power plant operated by M/s. Sudhir Reddy Gen Set Consortium in order to start new contract, as well as a reduction in power supply from M/s. Express Genset Consortium Pvt. Ltd. (NVVN) hiring power plant from 10 MW to 9 MW. To manage this power deficit through the available power generation, the Electricity Department will exercise rotational load shedding of forty five minutes (45), if required, on a daily basis as per the schedule given below in Port Blair and South Andaman area.

The below mentioned load shedding schedule is purely tentative and the duration & timing may vary, depending on available power generation and other technical reasons. The schedule will be enforced for next 10 days or till further intimation.

Implementing Tobacco free School Policy under COTPA 2003

The Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act (COTPA), 2003 was enacted in May, 2003 essentially to discourage the consumption of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products and to protect youth and the general population from the harmful effects of tobacco use.

Section-4 of COTPA prohibits smoking in public places and Section 6 of COTPA protects minors and youths from tobacco by regulating and restricting the tobacco business. All Educational Institutions as defined under COTPA should abide by the law to comply with the provisions of Section 4 and Section 6 of COTPA.

In order to ensure the compliance to the law, the following must be ensured by all Educational Institutes / Enforcement Agencies.

1. Display of “No Smoking Area” signage at Prominent places in the Institution campus of Educational Institutions both Govt. & Public Institutions in the jurisdiction of South Andaman District (Annexure-1).

2. Display of another signage “Tobacco free Educational Institution” at main gate / outer boundary informing about prohibition of sale of tobacco products within 100 yards distance. (Annexure-2)

3. Ensure that nobody (faculties, staff, students, patients and visitors) use any form of tobacco (smoking and smokeless) in the entire Educational Institution campus including canteens and hostels.

4. Ensure that no tobacco products are being sold or offered in the whole campus including at the canteen, hostel mess and within 100 yards of the outer boundary / main gate of the Institution.

5. Police / Enforcement Agencies to ensure random checking at the probable points of violation especially during the peak hours.

It is further added that under the law (copies attached for references)


1. The Head of Institution or Designated Officer is authorized to impose fine on a person amounting to Rs. 200/- who used tobacco products in the Institute's campus including the canteen.

2. The Head of Institution or Designated Officer is authorized to impose fine on tobacco vendors Rs. 200/- who sell tobacco products within 100 yards of the Institute's main gate / boundary.

It is essential that all necessary steps are taken to implement Section 4 and Section 6 of COTPA, 2003. Further, it must be ensured that the display of specified signage under COTPA is done, even if there is no visible violation in the campus. Eliminating the violations, complying with the law and making an Institute – a “**Tobacco free Educational Institute**” is a specific responsibility of a Head / In-charge of Institution.

Status of the action may kindly be shared with the District Administration.
