## DoT allots separate numbering series exclusively for service and transactional voice calls

### New 160xxxxxxx number series will help in curbing unsolicited voice calls from telemarketers using 10 Digit mobile numbers

New Delhi, June 2 (PIB)

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has introduced a new numbering series, 160xxxxxxx for making service/transactional calls. This initiative is a step towards providing citizens with a way to easily identify such legitimate calls.

Currently 140xxxxxxx series has been allocated to telemarketers for making promotional/service/transactional voice calls. As 140xx series is being used extensively for promotional calls, consumers normally do not respond to such calls and many important service/transactional calls are missed. This has resulted in wide use of regular 10-digit numbers by genuine entities for making service/transactional calls. This also gave opportunity to fraudsters to deceive consumers using 10-digit numbers.

Hence, in order to create confidence among the consumers and to enable them to distinguish between the spam calls originating from 10-digit unknown numbers and the genuine service/transactional calls from genuine Principle Entities, there was a need of separate number series to cater service/transactional voice calls.

To fulfil this need, the DoT has allocated a new numbering series, i.e., 160xxxxxxx which will exclusively be used for service/transactional voice calls by the Principle Entities. This clear differentiation between service/transactional calls versus other types of calls will make it easier for citizens to manage their communication. Now, for example, the service/transactional calls originating from Financial Entities like RBI, SEBI, PFRDA, IRDA, etc shall start from 1601.

Telecom Service Providers (TSP) shall be ensuring adequate verification of every

## National Lok Adalat to be held at Port Blair, Mayabunder & Diglipur on June 15

Port Blair, June 2

The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court Complex at Mayabunder and Circuit Court at Diglipur on June 15.

Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consent of the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138, Money recovery cases, Labour dispute cases, Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non compoundable), Maintenance cases Civil disputes and disputes under the Consumer Protection Act.

The general public having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before 07.06.2024, so that their disputes may be processed and made ready for hearing before the National Lok Adalat on June 15, a press release from DLSA said.

## Landlords, owners, and managers of residential and commercial establishments urged to mandatorily submit details of tenant, paying guest and servant/ house help to local Police Stations

In accordance with an Order issued under Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC) by the District Magistrate of South Andaman District, it is mandated that all landlords, owners, and managers of residential and commercial establishments must submit the particulars of any tenants/paying guests/ servants or house helps employed at their premises to the local Police Station.

As per the above order, the South Andaman District Police have issued a 'Form' that all landlords, owners, tenants, and managers of residential and commercial establishments must use to submit the particulars of any tenants,

paying guests, servants, or house helps employed at their premises to the local Police Station.

## Deptt. of AH&VS issues advisory for dairy farmers on preparatory actions to be taken during monsoon season

Port Blair, June 2

To minimize the impact of monsoon and to prevent serious ailment or death, the Department of AH&VS has issued the following advisory for dairy farmers on preparatory actions to be taken during monsoon season:

Do's

- Keep update on local weather forecast.
- Adequate availability of feed and fodder and establishment of fodder banks and must be stored in moisture-proof stores.
- Ensure mixing of salt mixture/ electrolytes with feed and water and provide balance feed especially to dairy animals.
- The drinking troughs should be kept clean and animals should be provided clean and fresh water.
- Pregnant animal (more than 6 months) should be given additional feed.
- Materials like corrugated iron or timber, aluminium or galvanized steel should be used for animal's shelters and roofs.
- The dead animal burial areas should be away from water bodies, public area and must be well protected with display board.
- Use of social media X handle of Deptt. of AH&VS i.e @dirahvsandaman for regular update of news related to Animal Husbandry.
- Need to ensure proper preservations of green fodder through hay and silages techniques to feed in scarcity in monsoon.

Cyber fraudsters are misusing people's interest in work from home (WFH) opportunities and sending the fake job offers related messages on WhatsApp. Through these fake messages, they try to victimize the users by sending them malicious phishing links and attempt to commit financial frauds.

In this regard, the Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens against fake job offers:

- Ignore the messages received from unknown numbers.
- Avoid clicking on unfamiliar links received through messages on any online platforms.
- Only visit authorized company/ organization website for valid job-related information.
- Install updated anti-virus on your digital devices for security and protection.
- Immediately block the number and report against such fake offers.
- Keep yourself updated about the Cyber frauds and scams.
- Enable 2 factor authentication and fingerprint options provided by the

## Norway Chess tournament : R Praggnanandhaa beats World No. 2 Fabiano Caruana

New Delhi, June 2

Indian Grandmaster R Praggnanandhaa scored a massive victory over world number two Fabiano Caruana of United States and made his way to the top 10 of world rankings after the end of fifth round of Norway Chess tournament in Stavanger. Hikaru Nakamura of the United States got the better of off-colour world champion Ding Liren of China to stretch his lead to a full point over Magnus Carlsen of Norway. With 10 points in his bag, Nakamura has a full point lead over Carlsen at the half



way stage of this 161,000 US Dollars prize money tournament. Carlsen outwitted Firouzja Alireza of France from a drawn rook and pawns endgame.

With five rounds still to come, the world number one is followed by Praggnanandhaa on 8.5 points, while a distant fourth now is Alireza who remained

on 6.5 following his loss. Caruana on five is in fifth spot while Ding Liren is clearly not enjoying the event with just 2.5 points to his credit. In the women's event being held simultaneously, R Vaishali continued her dream run and defeated Tingkie Lei of China in the Armageddon game to keep her lead on 10 points.

♦ **Misdiagnosis:** Without proper medical assessment, individuals may misdiagnose their condition and administer inappropriate treatment, leading to delays in proper diagnosis and treatment.

♦ **Adverse Drug Reactions:** Improper use of medicines without the knowledge of action, indication and dose may lead to serious adverse drug reactions which may at times be life threatening.

♦ **Drug Interactions:** Mixing medications without professional guidance can result in harmful drug interactions, with a potential for adverse effects as well as reducing effectiveness of treatment.

♦ **Masking of Disease Symptoms:** Self-medication may alleviate symptoms temporarily, masking underlying disease that may worsen and require medical attention. This can lead to progress of undiagnosed and untreated conditions.

♦ **Development of Antibiotic Resistance:** Inappropriate use of antibiotics, a common practice in self-medication not only contributes to antibiotic resistance, rendering these crucial medications ineffective against bacterial infections, but also makes a patient prone to infection with resistant organisms.

♦ **Addiction and Dependency:** Many medications, especially opioids and sedatives, carry a risk of addiction and dependency when used without medical supervision. Self-medication with these substances can lead to substance abuse disorders and other health complications.

> Maggot wound cases increase with breeding of fly in rainy seasons, so the use of camphor or turpentine oil along with manual removal of maggot with regular dressing is necessary.

> External and internal parasite cases increase in rainy season, so take care of it with consultation with local Senior Veterinary Officer.

> As green fodders are not available always during monsoon, so farmers should go for unconventional fodder like trees leaf and grasses to feed livestock.

Dont's

- > Avoid large number / overcrowding of animals in animal shade.
- > Animal movement should be avoided during rains.
- > Animals should not have to walk too far for the water and feed.
- > The carcasses of dead animals should not be discarded on the regular grazing routes of the animals and water bodies.
- > Entry of animal in water bodies should be avoided.
- > Animals should not be tied to electric poles and should be kept away from electrical instruments and area.

Consumers can have more confidence in the legitimacy of calls from the 160xxxxxxx series, reducing the risk of falling victim to scams. For any suspected fraud communications, Citizens are advised to report it on Chakshu facility at Sanchar Saathi ([www.sancharsaathi.gov.in](http://www.sancharsaathi.gov.in)).

The DoT encourages consumers to activate the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (TRAI) Do Not Disturb (DND) feature to block unwanted promotional calls, further enhancing their protection against spam.

**Service Call** means a voice call made to recipient either with his consent or using a template registered for the purpose, the primary purpose of which is to facilitate, complete, or confirm a commercial transaction that the recipient has previously consented to enter into with the sender; or to provide warranty information, product recall information, safety or security information with respect to a commercial product or service used or purchased by the recipient;

**Transactional Call** means a voice call which is not promotional in nature and is for the purpose of alerts to its own customers or account holders and information to be communicated by the voice call is time critical in the nature;

**Promotional Call** means commercial communication voice call for which the Sender has not taken any explicit consent from the Recipient to make such voice calls to him.

which validates the data of the member in the Universal Account Number (UAN).

Therefore, the consistency of the data of the member in the records of the EPFO is of paramount importance to ensure that the services are provided online seamlessly and to the correct member duly avoiding any risk of erroneous payments or frauds.

The integrity of the data in the Member Profile is thus being ensured by a Standard Operating Process (SOP) issued by the EPFO on 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2023. It has now been operationalized by EPFO in a digital online mode. The members may request for change/rectification in the Member Data like Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Parent Name, Marital Status, Nationality, Aadhaar, etc online and upload the relevant prescribed documents.

All such requests get routed to the PF offices across the country through the respective employers. Members have started filing their requests using this new facility out of which around 40,000 are already approved by the field offices of EPFO. The requests land at the employers' end, who after verification recommend it for approval. They have received around 2.75 lakh such requests till now.
