In his address on the occasion, the ADG, ASI, Shri Janhwij Sharma spoke on ASI's role in protecting India's cultural heritage, including monuments, archaeological sites, and antiquities. The ADG emphasized the ASI's commitment to preserving India's rich cultural heritage for future generations. The ADG touched upon the ASI's conservation efforts to protect monuments from deterioration and environmental damage. He also covered topics such as World Heritage, Project Mausam and Islands of Indian Ocean from trade perspective. A visit to the Cellular Jail and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island has provided a glimpse of the potential, the Union Territory have in terms of proposing certain nomination for world heritage sites, he added.

In the technical session, Dr. Shikha Jain, the Director & Chairperson, DRONAH Foundation through a power point presentation gave an elaborate information about the preparation of World Heritage Nomination Dossier. Dr. Sonali Ghosh, IFS, enlightened the gathering on the criteria and process of listing natural heritage sites under UNESSCO World Heritage Category. Dr. Kasturi Chakraborty, Director, ER, Geological Survey of India spoke on geological significance of sites in Andaman in perspective of geological evolution of A&N Islands.

A group activity on identifying values and attributes for nominated UNESCO's sites was held. This was followed by presentations on the findings by each group and the proposal to take it forward.

In his closing remark, the Chief Secretary thanked the team of domain experts for the insightful discussions with the team from the Administration and non-official members from different communities, which will enable the team from the Administration in having better understanding of the process for nomination and for its proper and elaborate documentation. He said, the Administration is committed to take this forward and efforts will be made to take these sites in the tentative list.

Summing up the discussion, the Secretary (Art& Culture), Ms Jyoti Kumari said, from the four insightful presentations followed by an engaging group discussion, important points that have emerged pertains to the scope for nominations in the cultural category, opportunities for transnational collaboration, preparation of dossier for world heritage nomination for inclusion in tentative list by Sept. 2025, administrative framework and post listing management besides creation of Geo Board in Sri Vijaya Puram with the help of Geological Survey of India. To carry this forward, committees have been formed at District and State Level which is headed by the Chief Secretary. The Secretary also informed about importance of site visitation and detail documentation of the proposals besides exploring other cultural landscapes.

The Department of Science and Technology, A&N Administration, is celebrating World Environment Day with a series of programs, including cloth bag distribution, cleanliness drives, and poster campaigns aimed at raising awareness and promoting environmental conservation. This year's theme is 'Ending Plastic Pollution Globally', aligning the activities with the Mission LiFE initiative's theme of 'Say No to Single-Use Plastic'.

In line with the Plastic Waste Management (PWM) Rules, 2016 (as amended), the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale, and use of various single-use plastic items - including polystyrene products, plastic ear buds, sticks for balloons, disposable cutlery, plates, cups, straws, and plastic packaging films - are prohibited.

Additionally, the A&N Administration has banned several single-use plastic products under Notification No. 186 dated 05.09.2019, including PET bottles under 2 liters, plastic-bodied cigarette lighters, small sachets for personal care and food items, disposable plastic pens, and plastic packaging materials such as bubble wraps. The use, manufacture, and sale of plastic carry bags, regardless of size or thickness, are also banned as per Notification No. 225 dated 24.09.2019. The sale and advertisement of single-use plastics on e-commerce platforms are prohibited as well.

Authorities urged the public to refrain from using banned single-use plastic items and to support these efforts by adopting the following environmentally friendly habits:

- Use cloth bag for shopping instead of plastic bags.
- Carry your own water bottle whenever possible.
- Reuse glass containers/packing plastic items as storage boxes.
- Participate and mobilize people for clean-up drives of cities and water bodies.
- Prefer using non-plastic eco-friendly cutlery during gatherings and events.
- Use menstrual cups instead of sanitary napkins.
- Use recycled plastic over virgin plastic, whenever possible.
- Use steel/recyclable plastic lunch boxes and water bottles.
- Cut the packaging bags used for milk, buttermilk, etc. only partially to avoid plastic bits from mixing into biodegradable waste.
- Opt for bamboo toothbrushes and neem combs, a press release from Deptt. of S&T said.
