BJP led NDA secures absolute majority in Lok Sabha Elections by winning 292 seats; BJP emerges as single largest Party with 240 seats

New Delhi, June 5

The BJP- led NDA has secured absolute majority in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections by winning 292 seats. Results of all 543 Lok Sabha seats have been declared. The BJP alone has won 240 seats. Telugu Desam Party has secured 16 seats and JD (U) 12. The I.N.D.I.A bloc has bagged 233 seats. Others have won 18 seats in the lower house of Parliament. The Congress secured 99 seats. Samajwadi Party got 37 seats while Trinamool Congress 29. DMK managed to win 22 seats.

Prominent candidates who have won include Prime Minister and BJP leader Shri Narendra Modi from Varanasi, Union Ministers Shri Amit Shah from Gandhinagar, Shri Om Birla from Kota, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal from Bikaner, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat from Jodhpur and Shri Jyotiraditya M. blood pressure and sugar, the most arduous was to operate upon a 14 year old child who had no vision in one eye since birth due to cataract. After a series of pre operative tele-consultations from All India Institute Port Blair, June 5 of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) and Guru Nanak Eye Centre (GNEC), Lok Nayak Hospital (LNH), Delhi, the patient was operated in GBPH by the team of efficient doctors in ANIIMS. With utmost difficulty and after an intensive medical treatment of the child, the surgery was done in coordination with GNEC.

All the patients recovered completely and have been sent back to their native villages with the entire expenditure borne by National Project, Ferrargunj, ICDS Programme for Control of Blindness (NPCB) under National Health Mission. The logistic challenges were comprehensively addressed, with A&N Administration taking care of travel arrangements, accommodation and meals not only for the patients, but also their attendants.

The primary objective of this endeavour was to treat preventable blindness along with improving the quality of life for the tribal population in safe and most comfortable settings. Besides, this initiative also aimed at building confidence of the patients in the Islands to seek quality health care services in time, available in GBPH under ANIIMS. All the patients benefited from this camp are expected to create social movement by becoming 'Community Champions' for their respective areas, inspiring and motivating others to seek timely care not only for cataract but also for other health problems.

The Ophthalmology Department at ANIIMS has all the necessary facilities for patients and is continuously upgrading for new challenges. More such collaborative efforts are envisioned to serve as initial impetus in long-term strategy to make healthcare services more accessible to the tribal patients. The success of this initiative underscores the commitment, value of collaboration and community engagement in achieving healthcare goals in the Islands, a press release from ANIIMS said.






