## Senior BJP Leader Shri Narendra Modi to take oath as Prime Minister for 3<sup>rd</sup> time on Sunday

New Delhi, June 7

Senior BJP leader Shri Narendra Modi will take oath as the Prime Minister for the third time on Sunday. The oath taking ceremony will be held at 6 PM in Rashtrapati Bhawan. Union Minister Shri Pralhad Joshi informed this during the NDA Parliamentary Party meeting in New Delhi on Friday. President Smti Droupadi Murmu will administer the oath to Shri Narendra Modi and his new cabinet.

The NDA leaders today met the President and staked a claim to form the new government. Earlier in the day, NDA Parliamentary Party unanimously elected Shri Narendra Modi as its leader. During the NDA Parliamentary party meeting at the Central hall



of the old Parliament building in New Delhi, Senior BJP Leader and Union Minister Shri Rajnath Singh moved a proposal to elect Shri Modi as NDA leader and it was supported by the leaders of all NDA allies. Shri Modi has also been elected as the leader of BJP in Lok Sabha, and BJP parliamentary party.

Supporting the proposal, Union Ministers Shri Amit Shah and Shri Nitin Gadkari seconded the proposal. TDP Chief Shri Chandrababu Naidu said, NDA government under the visionary leadership of Shri Narendra Modi has taken significant

initiatives in the last ten years. He said, the country has witnessed remarkable progress and transformation. Shri Naidu said, India is having a right leader at the right time that is Shri Narendra Modi.

Extending his support to Prime Minister Shri Modi, Bihar Chief Minister and JD (U) President Shri Nitish Kumar said that they will work together under Shri Modi's leadership. Shri Kumar said, Shri Modi has served the country and whatever is left he will fulfil in the new term.

## District Administration takes action against illegal earth cutting activities

### People urged to desist from indulging in such acts

Port Blair, June 7

A truck bearing Registration No. AN 01 P 1476 and two excavators, one of make TATA were seized by the Revenue Officials which indulged in illegal earth cutting and transportation in violation of A & N Islands Minor Mineral Rules, 2012. Around 100 Cbm (approx) of earth from land classified as Hilly situated at Sippighat Village recorded in favour of Kunal Kumar Paul, S/o Amarnath Paul and 25 Others was extracted and have been transported and dumped upon another land situated at Sippighat Village recorded in favour of Gulab Devi, W/o Puran Lall.

Under the sections of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation 1966, fine amount calculated at Rs. 1,10,000/- have been imposed upon the violators.

In yet another case, one Shri Sashank Puria, S/o Late M. K. Puria, R/o Minie Bay has extracted approximately 100 Cbm without permission of

Competent Authority from the land classified as hilly situated at Village Namunaghar.

Under the sections of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation 1966, fine amount calculated at Rs. 40,000/- has been imposed upon the violator.

The Deputy Commissioner, South

Andaman has warned unscrupulous elements involved in illegal extraction and violation of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation 1966 to desist from indulging in such acts in future, failing which, stern action would be taken against them, a press release from DC (SA) said.

## Anti-Narcotics Police strike big; 12.485 kgs of ganja seized in major operation, kingpin with fake identity nabbed

Demonstrating an unwavering commitment to combating drug-related activities, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station executed a highly successful Anti-Narcotics operation on June 06, 2024. Acting on specific intelligence inputs, a dedicated Police team from the Anti-Narcotics Police Station led by Inspector S. Kannan, SHO Anti-Narcotics Police Station including HC Abdul Salam, HC Kumar Bandana, PC Ratan Das, PC M. Raja Rao, and LPC R. Kavita, along with the Dog Squad team, including PC Ashim Ray, Dog Handler, and Sniffer Dog 'Oran' carried out the operation. The

operation was conducted under the overall leadership of Shri Vishesh Dhatteval, Dy.SP, Narcotics.

## Private Hospitals/Clinics urged to segregate bio medical wastes before sending to GB Pant Hospital for disposal

Port Blair, June 7

All the private hospitals and clinics have been informed that the Bio Medical Waste sent to GB Pant Hospital for disposal should be properly segregated at source level as per the latest Bio Medical Waste Management guidelines. The segregated waste should also be

certified regarding its content. Since, the Red, Blue and White bags are being sent to PBMC for disposal, all the contents of these bags should also be sterilised using Sodium Hypochlorite solution/autoclave/ hydroclave/ microwave and adequately labelled. The dry and wet waste also needs to be

sent separately to ensure adequate disposal.

This is for strict compliance, failing which, no Bio Medical Waste will henceforth be received by GBPH for disposal. A letter in this regard has already been sent to all private clinics and hospitals, a press release from MS, GBPH said.

Maa Anapurna villa, 2nd Floor, 16 Vivekananda Sarani, Dum Dum(m), North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-700028, currently residing at Chanditala, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal. Bimal Mondal had arrived in Port Blair from Kolkata on June 06, 2024, via Air India flight. He was found in possession of 12.485 kilograms of Ganja, which was clandestinely concealed in his trolley bag. The contraband was seized, and the accused was arrested on the spot after observing all codal formalities.

During the course of an ongoing investigation, it has been revealed that Bimal Mondal @Haru Das, is also wanted in connection with an NDPS case registered at PS Rangat in 2023. In that case, Subhir Gain, a resident near the vegetable market in Rangat, was apprehended with 4.5 kilograms of ganja where the source was traced back to Haru Das. Further, investigation revealed that the accused is an ex-employee of CISF who was dismissed from the service for violation of service rules. Additionally, it was discovered that Haru Das used a forged Aadhaar Card to purchase air tickets for transporting ganja to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The accused has been presented before the Hon'ble Court and has been granted a three-day Police Custody remand. The Police are diligently working to dismantle the entire supply chain involved in this case while also investigating the forged Aadhaar Card and associated individuals.

A case under relevant sections of the NDPS Act, 1985 and IPC has been registered at the Anti-Narcotics Police Station and further investigation is currently in progress. The raid took place under the overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID), A & N Islands.

This operation marks a significant achievement in the ongoing battle against narcotics, showcasing the Anti-Narcotics Police Station's dedication and effectiveness in protecting the community from the scourge of drug trafficking.

The Andaman and Nicobar Police are working tirelessly round the clock to combat and raise awareness about the drug menace in the region. This year alone, 31 NDPS cases have been registered, leading to the arrest of 46 individuals and the seizure of approximately 28 kilograms of ganja, 17 cannabis plants, 1.5 kilograms of methamphetamine, 16 kilograms of heroin, and 1140 alprazolam tablets, so far.

The Andaman and Nicobar Police have urged the general public to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities related to drug trafficking or substance abuse to the Police immediately. They have been requested to report any such activities on the telephone numbers: 112/100, 232586, 233307, 9434299028, and 9531856080, a press release from SP (CID) said.

Indian-American Astronaut Sunita Williams becomes First Woman to Pilot New Spacecraft on maiden Crewed Test Flight



New Delhi, June 7

Indian-Origin NASA astronaut, Sunita Williams, along with Butch Wilmore, have become the first to fly to space aboard the Boeing Starliner's in the first-ever crewed mission. The 59-year-old Williams created history by becoming the first woman to fly on the maiden mission of a new human-rated spacecraft.

The crew was launched on June 5 to fly aboard the United Launch Alliance's Atlas V rocket from the Space Launch Complex-41 at the Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida. The flight comes after several delays over the years.

The first human flight was slated on May 7, but was delayed over a helium leak and later due to an issue with the ground power supply at the ULA. This was the third attempt and the weather was 90 per cent favourable for the launch. Butch, 61, was commanding the flight, and Williams, was piloting the flight.

The duo will stay at the International Space Station for about a week before returning to Earth aboard the reusable crew capsule. The Starliner mission aims to carry astronauts and cargo for future NASA missions to low Earth orbit, and beyond.

Kashthuri scores 4.5 points; remains unbeaten in ongoing World Girls' Chess Championship

Port Blair, June 7

Kashthuri's game on day 6 of the ongoing World Girls' Chess Championship ended in a draw today. In the sixth round, she faced a tough opponent, International Women Master (WIM) Balabayeva Xeniya, from Kazakhstan with an international rating of 2246. Kashthuri, who has an international rating of over 1700, played tactfully against her Kazakhstan opponent and managed to draw the game with the black pieces and scored half a point against WIM. This is already her second draw against WIM in this tournament. Earlier, she drew against WIM from Armenia in the fifth round.

At the end of the six



rounds, she has scored 4.5 points and has so far remained unbeaten in the championship, with a Performance Rating of over 2300 (which means that she is playing as if she is a player of 2300 rating, although she is just over 1700 Rating).

The competition will get

more intense as each round progresses, with five rounds remaining before a rest day on June 8, 2024. The Championship will culminate on June 13, 2024 with a prize giving ceremony. The top ten players of the Championship will be awarded, a press release from ANCA said.

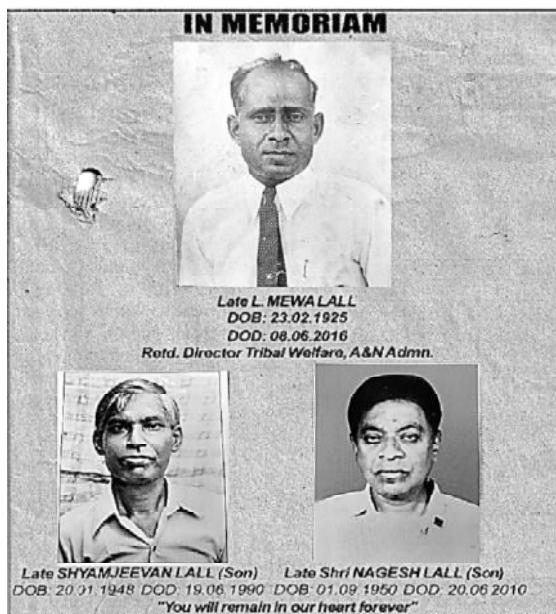
