Indian Astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla & 3 others to embark on Axiom-4 Mission, marking Nation's return to Space after 41 Years

New Delhi, June 8

Indian astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla and three others are set to embark on Axiom Space's fourth human spaceflight from NASA's Kennedy Space Centre in Florida on Tuesday. They are likely to dock at the International Space Station on Wednesday at about 10 PM IST, after a nearly 28-hour journey.

Shukla, serving as the mission pilot of the Axiom-4 (Ax4) commercial mission to the ISS, will be accompanied by mission commander Peggy Whitson and specialists Tibor Kapu from Hungary and Slawosz Uznanski-Wisniewski from Poland. The Axiom-4

mission marks India's return to space after 41 years since Rakesh Sharma's historic spaceflight onboard Russia's Soyuz Mission in 1984. During the 14-day stay at the ISS, the Ax-4 crew is expected to interact with Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, school students, and space industry leaders among others.

Two-years duration training under Craftsman Training Scheme of NCVT

Interested candidates from fishermen community urged to submit applications latest by June 14

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 8

The Central Institute of Fisheries Nautical & Engineering Training (CIFNET), Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt. of India located at Kochi, Chennai, and Visakhapatnam, offers career training to the selected candidates on Vessel Navigator (VNC) and Marine Fitter (MFC) for the academic session 2025-2027 batch.

These two-year (24 months) duration training programs are conducted under the Craftsman Training Scheme of the National

Council for Vocational Training (NCVT), introduced by the Directorate General of Employment and Training, Ministry of Labour, Government of India. The courses are open to candidates who have passed 10th standard (SSLC) with 40% marks in Mathematics and Science separately. A monthly stipend of Rs. 1,500/- will be provided to all selected trainees and on completion of VNC/MFC, post-institutional training will also be offered based on the merit rank with stipend of

Rs.20,500/pm and one time uniform allowance with the bond duly signed by Applicant/Parent.

As per the reservation policy, 24 seats (12 each for VNC and MFC) are reserved for wards of fishermen, nominated through the Commissioner/Director of Fisheries of respective States. These seats will be filled without an entrance examination.

Andaman Nicobar Command averts potential maritime disaster

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 8

On 04 June, 2025, Andaman Nicobar Command demonstrated its unwavering commitment to maritime safety and averted a potential disaster at sea, posed by a Merchant Vessel with imminent risk of grounding at Battimalv Island.

On 01 June, 2025, Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC), Sri Vijaya Puram, received an information, intimating about Merchant Vessel Fotex with 14 crew onboard, drifting in area due to engine failure. The Vessel was enroute

from Thailand to UAE when it suffered machinery breakdown. The vessel on the South-Western side of Nicobar Group of Islands began drifting towards A&N Islands, posing a grave threat to these ecologically sensitive pristine Islands.

The Coast Guard Regional Headquarter at Sri Vijaya Puram was

directed by ANC to monitor the adrift vessel through continuous aerial surveillances and requested owner of the vessel to arrange a tug boat for ensuring safety of the vessel and marine ecosystem. However, tug boat could not be arranged by the owner, in meantime vessel was closing in towards A&N

Bambooflat Police saves lives of three minor boys

In a swift and commendable response, the team of Bambooflat Police successfully rescued three minor boys from a potential drowning incident between Bambooflat and Chatham Jetty.

On June 6, 2025, at 1250 hrs, a Tally Clerk from DSS informed Police Station Bambooflat that three individuals seen struggling in the waters between the two jetties. Responding with utmost urgency, a team was swiftly constituted led by SI Manoj Lal along with HC Zubair, PCs A. Ali, Ummer Farooque

and Mohd. Basheer (IRBn) of PS Bambooflat immediately proceeded to the location aboard a PMF boat. The police team successfully located and brought all three boys safely ashore. The minors are the residents of Shore Point, Bambooflat were promptly given medical attention and after examination, they were handed over to their respective guardians. Subsequently, it was found that the boys were school students had ventured into the sea to enjoy their vacation and they were accidentally pulled in by strong waves.

On 03/06/2025, a complaint was received from Shri Nazrul Mandal, R/o Birdline stating that his house was burglarized while he and his wife were at work. Then, they discovered their house ransacked and reported the theft of Rs. 80,000 in cash and one domestic gas cylinder.

Based on the complaint, a case was promptly registered at Police Station Pahargaon and a dedicated team was constituted comprising of SI Rangaswamy, HC Limbu, PC Shiv and

Rahul Kumar Maurya under the supervision of Inspector Mohd. Elias, SHO, PS Pahargaon. The team conducted CCTV analysis in and around the vicinity of the place of occurrence and simultaneously developed local intelligence. The team tracked a suspicious individual seen arriving via auto-rickshaw, proceeding towards the victim's residence and leaving with a gas cylinder. Further, immediate ground-level search operations, supported by technical surveillance and informers, led to the successful identification and location of the accused.

During sustained interrogation of accused Hafizul Mandal, S/o Shri Hakim Mandal, 33yrs, R/o Bathu Basti permanent resident of West Bengal confessed to the crime

and disclosed the location of the stolen items. The stolen properties were recovered and accused was arrested after observing all codal formalities.

The entire raid took place under the guidance of Insp. Mohd Elias, SHO PS Pahargaon under the supervision of Shri. Vikas Swami, IPS, SDPO South Andaman and overall direction & supervision of Shri Manoj Kumar Meena, IPS, Sr. Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District.

The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has issued advisory to all e-commerce platforms to take necessary steps to ensure that their platforms do not engage in deceptive and unfair trade practice which are in the nature of Dark Patterns.
In a statement, Ministry of Consumer Affairs said that all e-commerce

platforms have been advised to conduct self-audits to identify dark patterns within 3 months. CCPA has also issued notices to e-commerce platforms in some cases that have been found violating the Guidelines for Prevention and Regulation of Dark Patterns.
The Ministry said that the authority has been keeping a close watch on the violation of the

Guidelines issued for Prevention and Regulation of Dark Patterns. A dark pattern is a deceptive user interface design used by digital platforms to mislead or manipulate consumers into making choices they did not intend. These practices can amount to misleading ads, unfair trade practices, or violations of consumer rights. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Coco Gauff Clinches First French Open Title, Defeats Sabalenka in Grand Slam Final.

Paris, June 8
In Women's Single at the French Open Tennis 2025, American tennis star Coco Gauff defeated world number one Belarusian Aryna Sabalenka 6-7(5), 6-2, 6-4 in a thrilling final last night, clinching her maiden Roland Garros title and second Grand Slam crown.
With this victory, the 21-year-old became the first American woman to win the singles title in Paris since Serena Williams in 2015 and the youngest from the US to do so since Williams in 2002. Sabalenka, appearing in her third consecutive Grand Slam final but first on clay, started strong with aggressive net play and drop shots to lead 4-1 in the



opening set. Gauff's triumph also marked the first time since the 2018 Australian Open that the top two women in the world rankings met in a Grand Slam final. Having previously lifted the French Open and US Open women's singles titles since Serena Williams with Slam titles on both

hard and clay courts. The victory marks world number two Gauff's second Grand Slam title and her first major triumph on clay. Gauff also became the youngest player to win both the French Open and US Open women's singles titles since Serena Williams achieved the feat in 2002.

The essential medicines and diagnostic services listed under the notified EML and EDL will be available free of cost at the following government health institutions:

- i. District Hospitals (DHs)
- ii. Community Health Centres (CHCs)
- iii. Primary Health Centres (PHCs) / Urban PHCs (UPHCs)
- iv. Sub-Health Centres (SHCs)

Key Objectives of the Initiative:

- i. Ensure the uninterrupted availability of essential medicines and diagnostic tests.
- ii. Promote the rational use of medicines and diagnostics in line with standard treatment protocols.
- iii. Reduce out-of-pocket expenditure (OOPE) and financial burden on patients.
- iv. Improve health outcomes, access, and equity in healthcare delivery.
- v. Support national health programmes and improve service quality.

The Department of Health Services will periodically review and update the Essential Medicines and Diagnostics Lists based on the latest medical evidence, public health needs, and local disease patterns.

This initiative reflects the Administration's continued commitment to improving public health infrastructure and ensuring that quality healthcare is within reach of every citizen in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
