New Delhi, June 9

Shri Narendra Modi was today sworn in as Prime Minister of India for the third consecutive term. President Smt. Droupadi Murmu administered the Oath of Office and Secrecy to Shri Modi along with the members of the new Council of Ministers at a function held at Rashtrapati Bhawan. During the Swearing-in Ceremony, 30 Cabinet Ministers, five Ministers of State (Independent Charge) and thirty-six Ministers of State took oath.

Senior BJP leaders Shri Rajnath Singh, Shri Amit Shah, Shri Nitin Gadkari, Dr S Jaishankar, Shri Piyush Goyal, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman and BJP President Shri J P Nadda took oath as Cabinet Ministers. Senior Party leaders Shri Kiren Rijju, Shri Pralhad Joshi, Shri Giriraj Singh, Shri Ashwini Vaishnav, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia, Shri Bhupender Yadav, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Smt. Annpurna Devi, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Dr Mansukh Mandaviya, Shri G Kishen Reddy and Shri C R Patil, Dr Virendra Kumar and Shri Jual Oram also took oath as Cabinet Ministers. Former Chief Ministers Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Shri Manohar Lal and Shri Sarbanand Sonowal were also administered oath as Cabinet Ministers. Besides, former Karnataka Chief Minister and JD(S) MP Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy, former Bihar Chief Minister and HAM party chief Shri Jiten Ram Manjhi, JD(U) MP Shri Rajiv Ranjan Singh, TDP MP Shri Kinjarapu Ram Mohan Naidu and LJP (Ramvilas) Chief Shri Chirag Paswan,

**RBI proposes to bring auto-replenishment facility for UPI lite wallet**

New Delhi, June 9

The Reserve Bank has proposed to bring an auto-replenishment facility for UPI Lite wallet. As per an official statement, RBI plans to bring UPI Lite within the e-mandate framework. Accordingly, if the balance in the UPI wallet goes below a threshold amount set by the customer, the fund will move from his/her account to the wallet without additional authentication or pre-debit notification. RBI has said the move will enable customers to use the UPI Lite

seamlessly, adding that the change in rules is based on the feedback received from various stakeholders.

The UPI Lite facility currently allows a customer to load his UPI Lite wallet up to Rs 2,000 and make payments up to Rs 5,000. UPI Lite was introduced in September 2022 to enable small value payments in a quick and seamless manner through an on-device wallet. RBI has said that related guidelines in this regard will be issued shortly. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)
