

PM Shri Narendra Modi releases 17th instalment of PM- Kisan Samman Nidhi

New Delhi, June 10

Shri Narendra Modi today took charge as Prime Minister for the third time. After assuming the charge, Shri Modi signed the first file authorising release of 17th instalment of PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi. This will benefit nine crore 30 lakh farmers by distributing around twenty thousand crore rupees. Shri Modi said, his first decision of the new government shows commitment of government to farmer welfare. Prime Minister Shri Modi said, his government will keep working even more for the farmers and the agriculture sector in the times to come.

The PM-KISAN Scheme was launched in 2019 with an aim to provide income support to all landholder farmer families across the country. Under the scheme, the financial benefit of six thousand rupees per year is provided to the eligible family of farmers. The scheme is being implemented as Central Sector Scheme with 100 per cent financial support by the Central Government. The amount

Tennis: India's Sumit Nagal clinches Heilbronn Neckarcup Challenger in Germany

Berlin, June 10

In tennis, India's Sumit Nagal clinched the Heilbronn Neckarcup Challenger in Germany yesterday. He defeated Alexander Ritschard of Switzerland, 6-1, 6-7, 6-3 in the men's singles title clash. This is his 6th ATP Challenger title.



With this victory, Sumit virtually qualified for the upcoming Paris Olympics. He also achieved an all time high World Ranking of 77 in the Live ATP ranking.

French Open Tennis: Spain's Carlos Alcaraz Garfia grabbed Men's Singles Title at Roland Garros in Paris

Paris, June 10

In Tennis, Spain's Carlos Alcaraz Garfia grabbed his first-ever French Open Men's singles title at the Roland Garros in Paris last night. Alcaraz triumphed over Alexander Zverev of Germany in the final, 6-3, 2-6, 5-7, 6-1, and 6-2. Alcaraz has now won more Grand Slams at the age of just 21, than every man born in the 1990s combined. The Spaniard also became the second youngest player in



the Open era to claim a major title on all three surfaces. Alcaraz entered the final beating Jannik Sinner, while Zverev secured his place in

ICC Men's T20 Cricket World Cup: India beat Pakistan by 6 runs in New York

New York, June 10

In the ICC Men's T20 Cricket World Cup, India defeated Pakistan by 6 runs in a thrilling match at Nassau County Cricket International Stadium in New York. Put in to bat first, India posted a total of 119 runs in 19 overs, after being bowled out by the Pakistani pacers last night. Rishabh Pant, with 42 runs from 31 balls and Axar Patel, with 20 runs from 18



balls helped the Men in Blue to set a decent target on board. For Pakistan, Haris Rauf and Naseem Shah claimed three wickets each while Mohammad Amir bagged two wickets.

The Indian bowling unit, led by Jasprit Bumrah valiantly restricted Pakistan to fall just 6 runs short of their target. While chasing a paltry target of 120, Pakistan could score only 113 runs for seven in the stipulated 20 overs. Bumrah scalped three wickets, conceding just 14 runs in his four overs. Hardik Pandya got two wickets, while Axar Patel and Arshdeep Singh bagged one wicket each. Bumrah was adjudged the Player of the Match. This is also the lowest target, India successfully defended in T20 internationals.


