## Chief Secretary inaugurates 2<sup>nd</sup> Andaman Tourism Road Show in Isles Administration is committed towards promoting A&N Islands' tourism by showcasing its uniqueness: CS Isles' rich flora & fauna offer unique experience to visitors

The four day long 2<sup>nd</sup> Andaman Tourism Road Show being organized by Andaman Association of Tour Operators (AATO), in association with Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India got underway with its inauguration by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, as the chief guest at Hotel Mansha Regency here this evening. The inaugural program was also attended among others by the Director, Tourism, A&N Administration, Shri Azharuddin Zahiruddin Quazi, IAS, Assistant Director, India Tourism, Port Blair, Shri S. Ramakrishnan, Chapter Chairman, IATO, A&N Islands, Shri Mohd. Jadwet, President, ANCCI, Shri Surendra Prahladka and local entrepreneurs.

50 prominent enlisted tour operators of Ministry of Tourism, IATO, TAAI, ATOAI, ADTOI and delegates from Maharashtra, Delhi, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh besides social media influencers, travel bloggers/ travel journalists are participating in the Andaman Tourism Road Show, supported by all tourism stakeholders of A&N Islands.

## Competent Surgeons of ANIIMS operate on first case of Breast Cancer in GB Pant Hospital GBPH now has a new mammography machine

Port Blair, June 13

With the recruitment of trained competent surgeons in ANIIMS, a 61 year old female, was presented with a mass with ulceration of overlying skin in left breast from over one year. On local examination, the treating surgeons diagnosed it to be breast cancer. The patient was admitted in GB Pant Hospital under Department of General Surgery, where investigations

like Ultrasonography, CT Chest and biopsy were done to arrive at a final diagnosis. The surgeon trained for operating upon cancer patients conducted complete removal of affected breast along with adjoining lymphatic and other tissues. The patient recovered well in the post operative period and was discharged with no sequelae/ complications thereafter. Further investigations on the dissected breast and

other tissue showed an aggressive and malignant type of cancer that was sensitive and amenable to medical treatment.

Since ANIIMS has recently set up a comprehensive Immunotherapy Unit for medical management of Cancers, the patient has been put on chemotherapy treatment and 1st cycle of chemotherapy has been started on

30th May 2024. The patient is on follow up for further management.

It is further to inform the general public that GBPH now has a new mammography machine where the women should get

themselves screened regularly (once an year or as advised by the doctor) for any lump or mass in the breast for timely detection and early management of such cases.

All the mechanized fishing boat owners are informed that as per Rule 5 (a) i & ii of the A&N Islands Marine Fishing Rules 2004, all the Fishing vessels fitted with inboard engine(s) or outboard motor(s) having engine power 30 HP and above including sport fishing vessels are permitted for fishing only in Zone B (Territorial Waters) surrounding Andaman & Nicobar Islands beyond 06 Nautical miles from the

## Stakeholders asked to take all precautionary measures for strict implementation of Animal Welfare laws

Port Blair, June 13


Animal Welfare Board of India has issued an advisory to take all precautionary measures for strict implementation of the Animal Welfare laws to prevent cruelty towards animals, especially with regard to transportation and illegal killings. As per Rule 3 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Slaughter House) Rules, 2001, no person shall

slaughter any animal within a Municipal area except in a slaughter house recognized or licensed by the concerned authority empowered under the law for the time being in force to do so. No animal shall be slaughtered, which is pregnant or has an offspring less than 3 months old or is under 3 months of age or which has not been certified by a Veterinary Doctor that it is in a fit

condition to be slaughtered. Violation of the Animal Welfare Rules can attract stringent action against the offenders under the animal laws viz. PCA Act, 1960, Transport of Animals Rules 1978 (amended in 2001 & 2009), Transport of Animals on Foot Rule, 2001, Slaughter House Rules, 2001 (amended in 2010), Municipal laws Act & Regulations of Food

Governor (Administrator), A & N Islands hereby proposes to make the following amendment in "Port Blair Municipal Council Building Bye-Laws, 1999" published in the A & N Gazette vide Notification No. 161/99 F. no. 3-53/97-LSG dated 13.10.1999 and subsequently amended vide notification No. 50/2019/F. No 3-53/2018-UD dated 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2019 namely:-  
"Common Telecom Infrastructure (CTI) facility in the building enclosures"  
Suggestion/Objection, if any, on this amendment to the Bye Laws may be submitted to the Secretary, Port Blair Municipal Council within a period of 30 days of its publication in the Daily Telegrams and the Dweep Samachar in addition to its publication in the PBMC and A&N Administration's website for consideration.

1. SHORT TITLE COMMENCEMENT:-  
i. These Bye-Laws be called the Port Blair Municipal Council Building (Amendment for Common Telecom Infrastructure) Bye-Laws, 2024,  
ii. They shall come into force with immediate effect.  
iii. This is applicable to all residential buildings, all other Commercial, Industrial & public buildings and public places.

2. After clause 4.9(6) of the PBMC Building Bye-Laws 1999, the following clause shall be added:-  
"4.10. Common Telecom Infrastructure (CTI):-  
A (i) Common Telecom Infrastructure (CTI) shall be mandatory for all public places like Airports, commercial complexes and residential complexes.  
(ii) Every person/applicant while submitting the application for approval of Building Plan shall mandatorily demarcate sections within buildings and on rooftops for housing of Broadband digital connectivity infrastructure/antenna. These areas shall have continuous power supply for reliable and always-on services.  
(iii) The Owner/RWA shall make available the required access to Common Telecom Infrastructure (CTI) facilities inside the building to all Service Providers on a fair, transparent and non- discriminatory manner.  
(iv) The Owner /RWA shall not consider the CTI facilities as a source of revenue generation but as a means for facilitating penetration broadband access and thereby helping in socio-economic growth of all the residents.  
(v) The Charges like rentals/power etc. to be levied upon the TSPS/ IP-1s shall be fair, transparent and non-discriminatory.  
B.(i) The minimum requirement of Common Telecom Infrastructure space to be provided in the buildings with Built-Up Area range shall be as below:-

1	Upto 93.0 Sqm	0.6x 1.0m In the form of wall cabinet with shutters.
2	93.0 Sqm to 250.0 Sqm	0.6x 2.0 m
3	250.0 Sqm to 465.0 Sqm	1.2 x 2.0m In the form of rooms
4	465.0 Sqm to 930.0 Sqm	1.5 x 2.5m
5	> 930 Sqm	3.0 x 3.4m

C. The CTI facilities at the Layout Level, Gated Buildings, In Building Solutions to (IBS)/ Fibre Networks shall be provided as per the Addendum to Model Building Bye-Laws, 2016 published by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi.



