Andamans Govt sets sights on underwater Guinness World Records

Port Blair, June 16

The Tourism Department of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands is gearing up to take a shot at the underwater Guinness World Records in a bid to showcase the archipelago as a top diving destination, officials said.

Lt Governor Admiral (Retired) D K Joshi has initiated discussions with officials concerned and other stakeholders to materialise the plan, they said.

"This place is surrounded with beautiful beaches, tropical rainforest and mountains and I think it's a perfect destination to trigger the adrenaline rush," said Vishwendra, Secretary, Directorate of Information, Publicity and Tourism Office (IP&T), Port Blair.

"The objective of this exercise is to put Andaman and Nicobar Islands

on the global diving destination list and promote tourism. In addition to the waterfront and beach activities, endeavour will be made to popularise the diving terrain and highlight the unparalleled opportunities for diving and adventure tourism in this Indian Ocean rim," he said.

The IP&T is studying all the previous Guinness World Records in this domain to finalise the categories before applying, the official said.

The applicant will be the local administration, which will be supported by the Andaman Nicobar Command, Andaman Chamber of Commerce, certifying agencies like the Professional Association of Diving Instructors (PADI), Scuba Schools International (SSI) and National Institute of Watersports (NIWS), among others, he said.

The entire exercise will be monitored

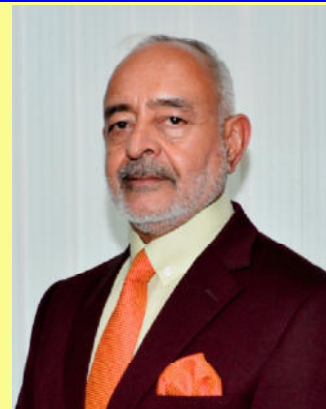

ANIIMS initiates 'Policy Dialogue' on 'Developing Implementation Model for Suicide Prevention in Schools & Colleges of Andaman' supported by ICMR

Port Blair, June 16

The inaugural ceremony & 'Policy Dialogue' on 'Developing Implementation Model for Suicide Prevention in Schools & Colleges of A&NI' was held here on June 14, 2024, under the chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), Smt Nandini Paliwal, IAS. The meeting was attended by representatives from the Health Department, Education Department, A&N Police & NGOs. As per NCRB, 2022, the suicide rate in India is 12 per 100,000 of the population in 2021, reflecting a 6.2% increase from the previous year.

To address the



challenge of increasing mental health issues and preventable tragedy of suicide, Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI has launched a Multi-State project in 8 States/UT including A&N Islands. The project aims to develop and test the scalability of a package of interventions in a



sample of schools and colleges across Assam, ANI, Arunachal Pradesh, Delhi, Kerala, Karnataka, Maharashtra and Rajasthan to improve the mental health of children in schools and colleges. The goal is to reduce the unfortunate events of suicide in the country by scaling the model, once its implementation mechanisms and effectiveness is established, after submission of report for this crucial initiative. The suicide rate in A&NI is almost four times the National average. This program intends to develop implementable strategies to prevent such avoidable and unfortunate happenings. It is a national health research priority, since it can have long-lasting effect on individuals, families, and communities. (Contd. on last page)

South Andaman District Police swiftly solves murder case within 03 hours

Port Blair, June 16

On June 15, 2024, Police Station Humfrygunj received a call reporting a murder at Dhanikhari. The Humfrygunj Police swiftly responded to the complaint and formed a dedicated team comprising of SI G. Mohan Rao, SHO PS Humfrygunj along with ASI R.C. Singh and other Police Station staff. They rushed to the scene and found the lifeless body of a resident of Chouldari. An eye witness identified the



accused who attacked with a 'Dah' after a confrontation. The accused fled from the scene and made extensive efforts to hide but was apprehended within three hours by the dedicated police team of the South Andaman District.

An FIR was registered under relevant sections of law at Police Station Humfrygunj and the crime scene was documented. Additionally, 04 individuals who harboured the accused and attempted to

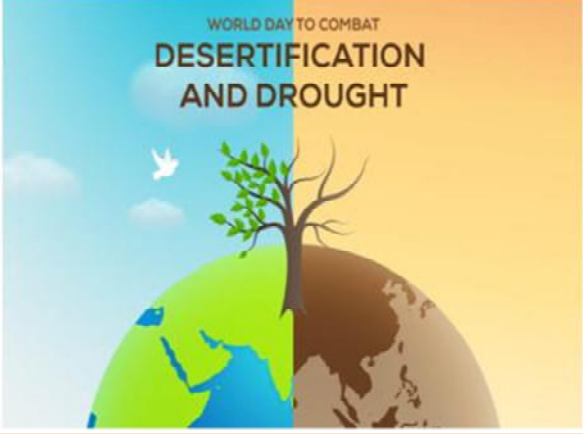
World Day to Combat Desertification & Drought

Some facts on the occasion of World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought

- ♦ Land is degrading due to desertification, posing a significant threat to food security and livelihoods.
- ♦ Desertification and land degradation costs the global economy due to loss of productivity.



- ♦ By 2030, it is projected that nearly half of the world's population will be living in areas highly vulnerable to water stress and scarcity.
- ♦ Sustainable land management practices, such as agro forestry and soil conservation, have the potential to increase crop yields by up to 60 %, helping to alleviate food insecurity in drought-prone regions.
- ♦ Restoring just 12% of degraded agricultural land worldwide could help feed an additional 200 million people.
- ♦ Climate change is exacerbating desertification and drought by altering rainfall patterns, increasing temperatures, and intensifying extreme weather events, highlighting the urgent need for global action.

These facts underscore the importance of addressing desertification and drought through sustainable land management practices and collective efforts to mitigate climate change.

Do's

- Conserve water by fixing leaks and using water -efficient appliances.
- Implement rainwater harvesting systems

to capture and store water and also to raise water table for present and future use.

- Support local initiatives focused on sustainable land management and reforestation.

- Practice responsible land use by avoiding soil erosion and deforestation.

- Refrain from burning waste or engaging in activities that contribute to air pollution, which can exacerbate drought conditions.
