message to promote global health and wellness through the practice of yoga. On the occasion, Prime Minister will address

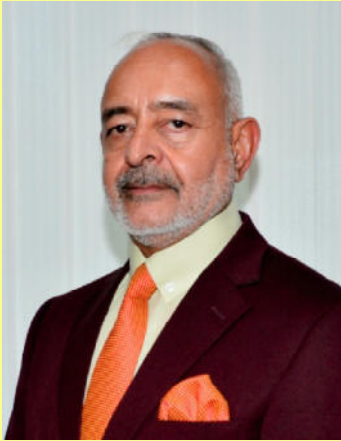
