children cannot be safely fastened with seat belts alone. For them, child restraint systems such as booster seats or car seats are necessary. However, understanding that not all parents may immediately have access to these systems, a grace period of one month is granted for parents to procure and begin using appropriate CRS. This grace period is advisory in nature, with an appeal to parents to voluntarily comply in the best interest of their children's safety.

Parents have been strongly advised, wherever possible, to seat children in the rear seat of the vehicle and ensure they are appropriately restrained. No act of carelessness is worth the risk to a child's life. The Traffic Police has appealed to all vehicle users to act responsibly and follow safety guidelines strictly, a press release from A&N Traffic Police said.
